Monday, Nov. 11, 2013 at Charlotte Bobcats (7:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks head to Charlotte for the first-of-four matchups during the 2013-14 regular season ... The clubs meet again at Charlotte on 3/17, and at Philips Arena on 12/28 and 4/14 ... The Hawks swept the 2012-13 season series 4-0 and own an eight-game regular season winning streak against the Bobcats ... Charlotte's last victory over Atlanta was a 96-85 home win on 4/13/11 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 20-16, but the Bobcats have an 11-7 edge at home.



Wednesday, Nov. 13, 2013 vs. New York Knicks (8:00 p.m.)
TV: ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts New York for the first-of-four contests this season ... The clubs will meet in New York on 11/16 and 12/14 and will finish the series on 2/22 at Philips Arena ... The Knicks swept the 2012-13 series 3-0, winning the season-finale 98-92 at Madison Square Garden on 4/17 ... The Hawks last defeated New York 100-90 at home on 3/30/12 ... The Knicks own a four-game overall winning streak in the series as well as a four-game home winning streak ... New York leads the all-time series 184-168, but the Hawks own a 62-35 home record since moving to Atlanta in 1968-69.



Friday, Nov. 15, 2013 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks host the 76ers for the first-of-three matchups between the teams ... The clubs will also meet in Philadelphia on 1/31 and at Philips Arena on 3/31 ... Each team won a game at home and on the road in the 2012-13 series split, with the visiting Hawks taking the last contest of the series 124-101 on 4/10 ... The 76ers won the most recent game in Atlanta 101-90 on 4/5/13 ... The Hawks' last home victory was a 107-96 triumph on 3/6/13 ... The all-time series is tied 159-159, including a 63-36 edge for the Hawks at home since moving to Atlanta in 1968-69.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 11/9, The Be Greater Atlanta honoree for Saturday's Military Appreciation game was Jorge Orlandini, Atlanta Chapter Captain of Team Red, White and Blue, a veterans assistance program. Hawks & Philips Arena president Bob Williams joined SunTrust Regional Operations Manager Willie Daniely to present Orlandini with his award during an on-court presentation.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta ranks first in the NBA in assists at 28.3 per game and has dished out at least 24 helpers in every game this season (six times), including two 30-plus assist nights. The Hawks handed out an NBA season-high 36 assists vs. Orlando on 11/9. The Hawks have recorded assists on 71.4% (170-238) of their made baskets, second in the league.

* Atlanta is averaging 13.5 turnovers per game, tied for second-fewest in the NBA. The Hawks have committed 14 or fewer miscues in each of the last five games.

* The Hawks rank second in the NBA in steals at 10.5 per game and are tops in STL/TO ratio at 0.78 ... Six players are averaging better than 1.0 steals per game – Al Horford (2.0, t13th in NBA), Paul Millsap (2.0, t13th), Kyle Korver (1.67, t30th), DeMarre Carroll (1.50), Jeff Teague (1.50) and Cartier Martin (1.33)

* On 11/9, Kyle Korver extended his streak of games with a 3FGM to 79 contests. Korver broke a tie with Dennis Scott and moved into a tie with Michael Adams for the second-longest streak in NBA history.

* In three games last week, Jeff Teague recorded consecutive point/assist double-doubles, averaging 17.0 points and 11.3 assists during the run. He is the first Hawk to have at least 10 points and 10 assists in three straight games since Bob Sura (4/9-4/12) in 2004.

* Also last week, Paul Millsap recorded three straight double-doubles, putting up 24.0 ppg, 10.7 rpg, 4.3 apg, 3.3 spg and 1.3 bpg in 34.0 mpg, knocking down .587 FG%.

* On 11/9, Mike Scott scored a season-high 17 points (7-11 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) in 14 minutes. Scott converted the first three-pointer of his career in the first quarter of the contest.
