### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Nov. 19, 2013 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta visits Miami for the first-of-four contests this season ... The teams will meet again at Miami on 12/23 and at Philips Arena on 1/20 and 4/12 ... The Heat swept the 2012-13 season series 4-0 ... The Heat currently own a seven-game winning streak against the Hawks, including three straight at home ... The Heat took the last contest in Miami 98-81 on 3/12/13 ... Atlanta's most recent victory was a 100-92 triumph in Miami on 1/2/12 ... The Heat lead the all-time series 55-40, including a 35-13 mark at Miami.



**Wednesday, Nov. 20, 2013 vs. Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Pistons in the first-of-two consecutive matchups ... The clubs will meet three more times - in Detroit on 11/22 and 2/21 and on 1/29 in Atlanta ... Last season the Hawks won the series 2-1, taking the only contest at Philips Arena 126-119 in 2OT on 12/26/12 ... Atlanta closed the season-series with a 114-103 triumph at Detroit on 2/25 ... The Hawks own a nine-game home winning streak against the Pistons... Detroit's last victory in Atlanta came in a 94-90 contest on 2/12/08 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 169-160, but the Pistons own a 51-49 road record since the Hawks moved to Atlanta in 1968-69.



**Friday, Nov. 22, 2013 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)**

The Hawks visit the Pistons for the second-of-two consecutive matchups ... The clubs will meet twice more - in Atlanta on 1/29 and in Detroit on 2/21 ... Last season the Hawks won the series 2-1, splitting two games in Detroit ... The Pistons' last home victory over the Hawks came on 1/4/13 in a 85-84 contest ... Atlanta closed the season-series with a 114-103 triumph at Detroit on 2/25 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 169-160, but the Pistons own a 65-36 edge at home since the Hawks moved to Atlanta in 1968-69.



**Saturday, Nov. 23, 2013 vs. Boston Celtics (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Boston for the first-of-four contests this season ... The clubs will meet again in Boston on 12/31 and 2/26 and at Philips Arena on 4/9... The Celtics won the 2012-13 series 3-1 ... The Hawks last defeated Boston 123-111 in 2OT at home on 1/25/12 ... Boston owns a two-game winning streak in the series ... The Celtics' last road victory was an 89-81 contest on 1/5/13 ... Boston leads the all-time series 225-133, but the Hawks have a 51-48 home record since moving to Atlanta in 1968-69.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* Sun Life Financial Inc. announced on 11/14 the Atlanta recipients of the Sun Life Rising Star Awards. The financial services organization awarded \$110,000 in grants and scholarships to two nonprofit community organizations: Raising Expectations and The Global Village Project, as well as an exemplary student nominated by each: Montavious Williams and Nura Mohammad. Hawks forward Elton Brand, along with former Hawks Steve Smith and Jerry Stackhouse, helped Sun Life representatives surprise the winning students at a private basketball clinic at Highland Athletic Club where the trio led more than 35 youth from both nonprofits in a variety of basketball drills and games.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* In three wins last week, the Hawks averaged 108.7 points on .502 FG% and .403 3FG%. Atlanta's week-closing point totals of 113 and 110 marked the first time since 11/5/10-11/7/10 the team has scored at least 110 points in back-to-back contests.

\* On 11/15 vs. Philadelphia, Jeff Teague scored a career-high 33 points (10-16 FGs, 1-3 FGs, career-best 12-13 FTs) and added 10 assists. He became the first Hawk to record at least 30 points and 10 assists in a game since Joe Johnson had 34 points and 10 assists against Charlotte on 11/14/07.

\* DeMarre Carroll set new career-highs with 21 points, eight FGM (8-14) and five 3FGM (5-8) vs. Philadelphia (11/15).

\* On 11/15, Lou Williams made his season-debut, playing in his first game since suffering a torn right ACL on 1/18/13. Williams tallied seven points, three rebounds two assists and a steal in 16 minutes off the bench against Philadelphia.

\* Gustavo Ayon made his Hawks regular-season debut on 11/15, starting at center and totaling six points, four rebounds and a block in 17 minutes versus Philadelphia.

\* On 11/16 at New York, Kyle Korver extended his streak of games with a 3FGM to 83 contests. The streak is the second-longest run in NBA history.

\* On 11/16 at New York, Shelvin Mack recorded his first career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 12 assists, while also tying a career-best with two 3FGM.

\* Jared Cunningham was assigned to the Bakersfield Jam of the NBA Development League on 11/11.

\* The 11/20 game against the Pistons will feature the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday promotion. Fans can purchase a \$25 upper level ticket and receive a \$10 food and beverage credit loaded onto the ticket.

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**November 23, 2001** – Shareef Abdur-Rahim scores 50 points against the Pistons in a 106-99 Hawks win at Philips Arena. It is tied for the eighth-highest single game scoring effort in team history and is the highest scoring game by a Hawks player at Philips Arena. Abdur-Rahim's 21 made field goals in that game is tied for fifth on the club's all-time list.
