UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Nov. 26, 2013 vs. Orlando Magic (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Magic to Philips Arena for the second-of-four matchups between the teams ... Atlanta recorded an NBA-season-high 36 assists and took Game 1, 104-94 ... Jeff Teague had 19 points/13 assists for the Hawks while Arron Afflalo scored 21 for Orlando in the first contest ... The clubs will meet again in Orlando on 12/29 and 1/22 ... The Hawks own an 11-game winning streak over the Magic, including seven straight at home ... Orlando's last win was a 93-89 home victory on 11/8/10 and its last road triumph came on 11/26/09 (93-76) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 48-45, including a 31-15 home record.



Wednesday, Nov. 27, 2013 at Houston Rockets (8:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Houston for the first-of-two matchups this season ... The clubs will close the season series on 1/10 in Atlanta ... The Rockets won both games in 2012-13, winning the series-finale in Houston 123-104 on 12/31/12 ... Houston owns a five-game winning streak in the series, including three in a row at Toyota Center ... The Hawks last victory came in a 102-95 contest on 1/25/10 in Houston ... The Rockets lead the all-time series 73-69, including a 50-16 edge at home since the Hawks moved to Atlanta in 1968-69.



Friday, Nov. 29, 2013 vs. Dallas Mavericks (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host Dallas in the second-and-final game of the season-series ... The clubs opened the season in Dallas with the home team winning 118-109 ... Monta Ellis paced the Mavs with 32 points while Jeff Teague led the Hawks with 24 points/nine assists ... Dallas owns a two-game winning streak in the series, with the last Hawks victory coming on 2/11/13 in a 105-101 triumph in Dallas ... The Hawks last defeated the Mavs in Atlanta on 4/26/12 (106-89) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 33-32, including a 18-14 home mark.



Saturday, Nov. 30, 2013 at Washington Wizards (7:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Washington for the first-of-four contests this season ... The clubs will meet again at Philips Arena on 12/13 and 2/19 and in Washington on 3/29 ... The Hawks won the 2012-13 series 3-1, though the Wizards won the series-finale 93-83 at home on 1/12/13 ... Atlanta last defeated the Wizards on 12/18/12 at Washington (100-95, OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 144-134 (35-68 on road since moving to Atlanta in 1968-69.)

COMMUNITY NEWS

* The NBA, WNBA, Africare and ExxonMobil on 11/19 announced the launch of "Power Forward," a youth engagement initiative that will use basketball to develop health, leadership and life skills in Nigeria. Former Hawk Obinna Ekezie, Hakeem Olajuwon and Swin Cash joined leading Nigerian government officials in tipping off the program during a two-day launch event in Abuja.

NEWS & NOTES

* Voting for the 2014 All-Star game tipped off on 11/15. The Hawks are represented on the ballot by two-time All-Star Al Horford, Paul Millsap and Jeff Teague. The 63rd NBA All-Star game takes place on Sunday, February 16, 2014 at New Orleans Arena in New Orleans, LA.

*The Hawks rank third in the NBA in assists (25.1) and have recorded at least 20 helpers in every game this season. The 14-game run is the longest season-opening stretch since 1968-69 (17 contests).

* Six different Hawks have recorded double-doubles this season – Jeff Teague (seven), Al Horford (four), Paul Millsap (four), DeMarre Carroll (one), Shelvin Mack (one) and Mike Scott (one). Philadelphia is the only other team in the league with as many different players posting double-doubles this year.

* On 11/23, the Hawks committed a season-low nine turnovers and converted 19 Boston miscues into a season-high 29 points off turnovers.

* Kyle Korver extended his streak of games with a 3FGM to 87 contests vs. Boston on 11/23. The streak is the second-longest of its kind in NBA history, trailing only Dana Barros' 89-game run. Korver also tied Dan Majerle for 26th on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list with 1360.

* On 11/19 at Miami, Mike Scott recorded his first double-double of the season after tallying team-highs of 15 points and 10 rebounds. Scott posted averages of 11.3 points and 5.5 rebounds per game on .548 FG% and .556 3FG% in four games last week.

* On back-to-back nights (11/22 & 11/23), Scott tied a career-high with two 3FGM. John Jenkins pulled down a career high five rebounds on 11/22.

* On 11/20 vs. Detroit, DeMarre Carroll recorded his first career-double, totaling 11 points and a career-high 12 rebounds.

* On 11/20, Lou Williams recorded his 1500th career assist against the Pistons. He is three rebounds shy of 1000 career rebounds.
