UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Dec. 16, 2013 vs. Los Angeles Lakers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Lakers for the second-of-two matchups this season ... Los Angeles won the first meeting 105-103 on 11/3 at Staples Center ... Pau Gasol recorded a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds for the Lakers while Al Horford also had a double-double (12 points and 16 rebounds) for Atlanta ... The Hawks won the last meeting at Philips Arena 96-92 on 3/13/13 ... The Lakers lead the all-time series 183-135, including a 30-28 road record since the Hawks moved to Atlanta in 1968-69.



Wednesday, Dec. 18, 2013 vs. Sacramento Kings (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No Local Broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Kings to town for the second-of-two meetings this season ... Atlanta took the first matchup 105-100 on 11/5 in Sacramento as Al Horford (25 points/11 rebounds), Paul Millsap (27 points/10 rebounds) and Jeff Teague (18 points/10 assists) recorded double-doubles ... Isaiah Thomas led the Kings with 26 points and five assists ... The Hawks currently own a six-game home winning streak versus Sacramento and an 11-game winning streak overall ... The last Kings victory came in a 119-107 contest on 2/20/08 in Sacramento while their last road triumph came on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 153-152, including an 84-29 edge at home.



Friday, Dec. 20, 2013 vs. Utah Jazz (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Jazz for the first-of-two contests this season ... The clubs will finish the series on 3/10 in Utah ... The Hawks own a four-game winning streak over the Jazz, including two in a row at Philips Arena ... Utah's last victory came in a road triumph on 11/12/10 (90-86) ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 48-43, though the Hawks own a 28-16 edge at home.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks were victorious in their first overtime contest of the season on 12/13 against the Wizards. Al Horford's buzzer-beating 11-foot jumper won the game and gave Horford his second game-winning basket of the season. He scored a career-high-tying 34 points (career-high 15 FGM) and added 15 rebounds (season-high six offensive boards) in 41 minutes.

* Al Horford and Paul Millsap are the only two players in the NBA this season averaging at least 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks per game, while shooting .500-or-better from the field. Horford is putting up 17.7 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals on .552 FG%, while Millsap is averaging 16.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.6 steals and 1.0 blocks on .500 FG%.

* Shelvin Mack set career-highs in points (17), FGM (7) and 3FGM (3) on 12/10 vs. Oklahoma City.

* Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG in 93 consecutive games at New York on 12/14.

* Lou Williams scored 27 points (career-high 6-13 3FGs) in 29 minutes off the bench at New York (12/14). He is the first player in franchise history to come off the bench to score at least 27 points and make six 3FGs in 29 minutes or less. It was the 13th time since 1985-86 that a Hawk (by nine players) has scored 27 in 29-or-fewer minutes off the bench, and the first since Jamal Crawford on 2/9/10 against Memphis.

* John Jenkins was recalled from the Bakersfield Jam of the NBA Development League on 12/13. Dennis Schröder was recalled from Bakersfield on 12/16 while Jared Cunningham was assigned to the Jam the same day.

* Voting for the 2014 All-Star game is underway. The Hawks are represented on the ballot by two-time All-Star Al Horford, Paul Millsap and Jeff Teague. The 63rd NBA All-Star game takes place on 2/16/14 at New Orleans Arena in New Orleans, LA. Visit www.hawks.com to cast your votes.
