Monday, Dec. 2, 2013 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits San Antonio for the first-of-two games between the clubs this year ... The Spurs come to Philips Arena on 1/24 to finish the season series ... San Antonio currently owns a five-game winning streak against the Hawks and has taken 15 straight at home ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 119-114 home overtime triumph on 3/21/10 and the last road victory came on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 45-36, including a 29-12 record at home.



Wednesday, Dec. 4, 2013 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks welcome the Clippers to Philips Arena for their only meeting in Atlanta this season ... The clubs will square off for the second-and-final time on 3/8 in Los Angeles ... The teams split the 2012-13 series 1-1, with the Hawks winning the series finale 104-93 in Atlanta on 11/24/12 ... The Clippers' last win at Philips Arena came on 2/7/09 (121-97) ... Atlanta owns a 72-38 lead in the all-time series, including a 42-13 edge at home.



Friday, Dec. 6, 2013 vs. Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: No Local Broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Cavaliers in the first-of-three matchups this season ... The clubs will meet again on 12/26 at Cleveland and 4/4 at Philips Arena ... The 2012-13 series resulted in a 2-2 tie, with host Atlanta winning the final matchup 102-94 on 4/1/13 ... Cleveland's last victory in the series came on 1/9/13 at home (99-83) and their last road win came on 11/30/12 (113-111) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 111-95, including a 66-35 home mark.

NEWS & NOTES

* Voting for the 2014 All-Star game is underway. The Hawks are represented on the ballot by two-time All-Star Al Horford, Paul Millsap and Jeff Teague. The 63rd NBA All-Star game takes place on 2/16/14 at New Orleans Arena in New Orleans, LA. Visit www.hawks.com to cast your votes.

* On 11/29 vs. Dallas, the Hawks overcame a 17-point third quarter deficit to mount their largest comeback of the season. Al Horford connected on a 19-foot jump shot with 4.2 seconds remaining to give Atlanta an 88-87 victory.

* Kyle Korver extended his streak of games with a 3FGM to 88 contests vs. Orlando on 11/26. The streak is the second-longest of its kind in NBA history, trailing only Dana Barros' 89-game run.

* On 11/30 at Washington, Paul Millsap knocked down a career-high 4-5 3FGs on the way to 23 points (9-14 FGs), 10 rebounds, two assists, two blocks and a steal in 35 minutes. Millsap has shot 6-8 from beyond-the-arc (.750) over the last three games.

* John Jenkins tied a career-best with three 3FGM at Houston (11/27), ending the night with 13 points (5-12 FGs, 3-6 3FGs), three rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes.

* On 11/26, Lou Williams recorded his 1000th career rebound against the Magic. His next game will be the 500th contest of his career.

* Kyle Korver suffered a rib contusion on 11/23 versus Boston and has missed three games due to the injury. His status is listed as day-to-day.

* The Hawks-Clippers game on 12/4 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday promotion and includes an upper level ticket and \$10 food and beverage credit for \$25, while the Hawks-Cavs contest on 12/6 has the Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays promotion (four tickets and \$40 in Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$88).
