UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Dec. 23, 2013 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Miami for the second-of-four contests this season ... The teams will meet again at Philips Arena on 1/20 and 4/12 ... The Heat took the first matchup 104-88 on 11/19 at home, led by Chris Bosh (19 points and five rebounds) ... Mike Scott led the Hawks in points (15) and rebounds (10) ... Miami currently owns an eight-game winning streak against the Hawks, including four straight at home ... Atlanta's most recent victory was a 100-92 triumph in Miami on 1/2/12 ... The Heat lead the all-time series 56-40, including a 36-13 mark at Miami.



Thursday, Dec. 26, 2013 at Cleveland Cavaliers (7:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Cleveland for the second-of-three matchups this season ... The clubs will close out the series on 4/4 at Philips Arena ... Seven Hawks scored in double-digits as Atlanta took the first game 108-89 at home on 12/6 ... Dion Waiters led the Cavs with 30 points and Andrew Bynum added 20 points and 13 rebounds ... Cleveland's last victory in the series came on 1/9/13 at home (99-83) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 112-95 (45-60 on the road).



Saturday, Dec. 28, 2013 vs. Charlotte Bobcats (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Bobcats in the second-of-four contests this season ... The clubs meet again at Charlotte on 3/17 and at Philips Arena on 4/14 ... Atlanta prevailed 103-94 on 11/11 in Charlotte led by Al Horford (24 points) and Jeff Teague (14 points and 12 assists) ... Josh McRoberts led seven Bobcats in double-figures with 19 points ... The Hawks own a nine-game winning streak against the Bobcats, including four straight at home ... Charlotte's last victory over Atlanta was a 96-85 home win on 4/13/11 and the Bobcats' last road triumph came on 2/12/11 (88-86) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 21-16 (13-5 at home).



Sunday, Dec. 29, 2013 at Orlando Magic (6:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit Orlando for the third-of-four games between the teams ... Atlanta recorded 36 assists and took Game 1, 104-94 on 11/9 ... Jeff Teague had 19 points and 13 assists for the Hawks while Arron Afflalo scored 21 for Orlando ... The Magic won the second game 109-92, led by Afflalo (26 points) and Nikola Vucevic (12 points and 15 rebounds) ... Teague and Al Horford (15 points apiece) led the Hawks in scoring ... The clubs will close the series in Orlando on 1/22 ... Atlanta owns a five-game road winning streak against the Magic, including taking the last contest 108-76 on 2/13/13 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 48-46 (17-30 on the road).

* DeMarre Carroll is paying the December natural gas bills of four personally selected families for the holidays, totaling \$1500. The families are all SCANA Energy customers and reside in Atlanta, Douglasville, Ellenwood and Roswell. Carroll has been paying the gas bills of families in need each holiday season since his first year in the league in 2009 as a tribute to his grandmother.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta is the NBA's top-ranked team in assists (25.6 per game) and on 12/18 vs. Sacramento, the Hawks recorded a season-high (and Philips Arena record) 38 assists. The total was the team's highest since 4/19/97 (39). Atlanta has registered a league-high six games with at least 30 assists (5-1 in those contests).

* Al Horford is the only player in the NBA this season averaging at least 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks per game, while shooting .500-or-better from the field. Horford is putting up 18.2 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals on .562 FG%.

* On 12/18 against Sacramento, Kyle Korver tied a career-high (and his own Philips Arena record) by converting eight 3FGs on his way to scoring his highest point total as a Hawk (28). He moved past former Hawk Antoine Walker into 24th place on the NBA's career 3FGM list (currently 1391). On 12/20 against Utah, Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG in 96 consecutive games.

* Lou Williams converted a career-high-tying six 3FGs on 12/20 vs. Utah, marking the second time in four games he scored at least 25 points and made six three-pointers.

* On 12/18 against Sacramento, Jeff Teague tied career-highs of 15 assists and eight rebounds, while scoring 18 points. Additionally, he went over the 3000 career point mark in the contest.

* Paul Millsap grabbed his 4000th career rebound and made his 1500th career free throw vs. Utah on 12/20.

* Al Horford recorded his 173rd career double-double (25 points/10 rebounds) vs. Sacramento on 12/18, tying Dominique Wilkins for 10th in franchise history.

* DeMarre Carroll swiped a career-best four steals vs. Utah on 12/20.

* Mike Scott his career-high of three assists 12/18 vs. Sacramento and 12/20 vs. Utah, while also tying his career-best of two 3FGM against the Kings.

* On 12/16, Atlanta recalled Dennis Schröder from Bakersfield of the NBA Development League and assigned Jared Cunningham to the Jam.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

December 26, 2000 – Dikembe Mutombo grabs 28 rebounds (11 offensive) in Atlanta's 81-76 win at New Jersey. Mutombo's effort is tied for the fourth highest single-game rebounding total in team history.
