Tuesday, Dec. 31, 2013 at Boston Celtics (1:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Boston for the second-of-four contests this season ... The Celtics won the first matchup 94-87 on 11/23 on the Hawks' home floor ... Boston's Jordan Crawford (12 points and 10 assists) and Atlanta's Jeff Teague (13 points and 10 assists) each recorded a double-double ... The clubs will meet again in Boston on 2/26 and at Philips Arena on 4/9 ... Boston owns a three-game winning streak in the series and has taken four straight at home ... The Hawks last defeated Boston 123-111 in 2OT at home on 1/25/12 ... Atlanta's most recent road victory came on 1/11/10 (102-96) ... Boston leads the all-time series 226-133 (119-34 in Boston).



Friday, Jan. 3, 2014 vs. Golden State Warriors (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Warriors to Philips Arena for the first-of-two matchups this season ... The clubs will close out the series on 3/7 at Golden State ... The Warriors swept the 2012-13 series 2-0 and own a three-game winning streak over the Hawks including two in a row at Philips Arena ... Atlanta last defeated Golden State on 2/25/11 (95-79) on the road, while the Hawks' last home triumph came on 12/29/10 (103-93) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 141-137, including an 83-41 edge at home.



Saturday, Jan. 4, 2014 at Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

The Hawks visit the Bulls for the first-of-four contests this season ... The clubs meet again in Chicago on 2/11 and at Philips Arena on 2/25 and 4/2 ... The Bulls won the 2012-13 series 2-1, taking the finale 93-76 in Atlanta on 2/2/13 ... Chicago has won two straight over the Hawks overall and four in a row at home ... Atlanta's last victory over the Bulls was a 92-75 home win on 12/22/12 and the Hawks' last road triumph came on 3/1/10 (116-92) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 61-47 (39-68 on the road).

NEWS & NOTES

- * From 12/23-12/28 the Hawks played in three consecutive overtime contests, the team's longest such streak since a three-game run from 1/7/97-1/11/97.
- * The Hawks have scored at least 100 points in nine consecutive games (12/13-12/29). The streak is the franchise's longest since a nine-game stretch from 1/16/92-1/31/92.
- * Atlanta attempted a franchise record 39 three-pointers in back-to-back contests (12/28-12/29). The Hawks have made at least 10 3FGM in a franchise-best eight consecutive games (12/14-12/29).
- * On 12/29 at Orlando, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG for the 100th consecutive game. The night before vs. Charlotte, Korver surpassed Josh Smith for eighth place on the Hawks' all-time 3FGM list (currently 270) and pulled down the 2000th defensive rebound of his career.
- * Lou Williams recorded season-highs of 28 points, 10 FTM (all in overtime) and five rebounds on 12/28 vs. Charlotte. His 10 FTM in the extra period are the NBA's most in a single overtime in over 10 seasons.
- * On 12/26 at Cleveland, Jeff Teague converted a buzzer-beating jump shot in double overtime to defeat the Cavaliers. Teague set career-highs of 34 points and 14 FGM and his 14 assists fell just short of his career-high of 15. He became the first Hawk with at least 34 points and 14 assists in a game since Eddie Johnson (3/1/85).
- * Paul Millsap set career-highs by making 7-10 3FGS on 12/23 at Miami. He finished with 25 points and 10 rebounds, becoming the first Hawk with at least seven 3FGM and 10 rebounds in a game since Mookie Blaylock (2/2/97).
- * Millsap scored a season-high 33 points, added 13 rebounds and made a career-high 12 free throws on 12/28 vs. Charlotte. The contest was his third straight with at least 20 points/10 rebounds. He averaged 26.0 points and 11.3 rebounds on .509 FG% and .588 3FG% over the stretch.
- * Al Horford suffered a torn right pectoral muscle on 12/26 at Cleveland and is out indefinitely. DeMarre Carroll suffered a sprained right thumb on 12/26. He did not travel to Orlando (12/29) and will not be with the team in Boston (12/31). John Jenkins (low back pain) has been inactive for three games and is listed as out at Boston (12/31).
- * On 12/29, Atlanta recalled Jared Cunningham from Bakersfield of the NBA Development League. In two stints with the Jam, he averaged 18.1 points, 5.4 assists, 4.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals in 33.1 minutes.

December 30, 1978 – John Drew scores 50 points in Atlanta's 113-87 home win over Denver. Drew's effort is tied for the ninth-highest single-game scoring total in club history.
