BROOKLYN

Thursday, Jan. 16, 2014 vs. Brooklyn Nets (3:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks and Nets meet at The O2 in London, United Kingdom in the second-of-three games this year between the clubs ... Atlanta is serving as the home team in the game ... Brooklyn won the first matchup 91-86 on 1/6, led by Joe Johnson's 23 points ... Paul Millsap and Jeff Teague paced the Hawks with 16 points apiece ... The clubs will finish the series in Brooklyn on 4/11 ... Atlanta last defeated the Nets 105-93 on 3/17/13 in Brooklyn ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 90-68 (57-21 as the home team) ... The teams have never met on a neutral court.



**MIAMI
HEAT**

Monday, Jan. 20, 2014 vs. Miami Heat (5:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Heat to Philips Arena for the third-of-four matchups this season ... The clubs will close out the series on 4/12 in Atlanta ... Miami won the first two games of the series, both at home, with LeBron James averaging 25.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists ... Jeff Teague is averaging 17.5 points and 7.5 assists in two contests against Miami ... The Heat currently own a nine-game winning streak against the Hawks, including seven straight in Atlanta ... The Hawks' most recent victory was a 100-92 triumph in Miami on 1/2/12 and their last home win came on 11/18/09 (105-90) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 57-40 (Hawks are 27-20 at home).



Wednesday, Jan. 22, 2014 at Orlando Magic (7:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Orlando for the fourth-and-final matchup between the teams ... The Magic own a 2-1 edge this season and have won two in a row over the Hawks ... Jeff Teague is averaging 18.7 points and 9.0 assists for Atlanta while Arron Afflalo is averaging 22.7 points and 5.7 assists in three games for Orlando ... Atlanta last defeated the Magic on 11/9 at Philips Arena (104-94) and last won in Orlando on 2/13/13 (108-76) ... The Magic most recently defeated the Hawks on 12/29/13 in Orlando (109-102) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 48-47, (17-31 on the road).

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta ranks first in the NBA in assists at 25.4 per game and has dished out at least 20 helpers 36 times (20 games in a row), including seven 30-assist nights (6-1 in those contests). The Hawks are recording assists on 66.9% (964-1440) of their made baskets, best in the league.

* On 1/10 vs. Houston, the Hawks allowed their lowest point total of the season (80), holding the Rockets (third in the NBA in scoring with 105.8 points per game entering the contest) to their lowest scoring output of the year.

* On 1/8 vs. Indiana, the Hawks allowed first quarter season-lows of 12 points and .238 FG% (5-21). Atlanta also set a defensive first-half season-best by limiting the Pacers to 32 points on a season-low tying .325 FG% (13-40).

* Paul Millsap is the only player in the Eastern Conference and one-of-two in the NBA (DeMarcus Cousins) averaging at least 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks. He is averaging 17.4 points, 8.5 rebounds, 2.9 assists, 1.6 steals and 1.1 blocks on the year.

* On 1/12 at Memphis, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG for the 107th consecutive game. He also surpassed Jamal Crawford for seventh place on the Hawks' all-time 3FGM list (283). On 1/8 vs. Indiana, Korver converted his fifth four-point play of the season. It was the 33rd four-point play in the history of the franchise, 10th of Korver's career and his seventh as a Hawk.

* Last week, Pero Antic became the first player in NBA history with 12 3FGM in his first four starts at center. He also became the second player all-time with at least two 3FGM in each of his first four starts in the middle (Tim Thomas).

* Over the last three games, Mike Scott is averaging 14.7 points on .563 FG% and 1.000 FT%. He tied a career-high with three 3FGM at Memphis on 1/12.

* On 1/11, the Hawks signed forward James Nunnally to a 10-day contract. In 19 starts with the Bakersfield Jam of the NBA Development League, he averaged 18.2 points, 4.4 rebounds and 4.0 assists in 33.6 minutes (.448 FG%, .415 3FG%, .853 FT%).

* On 1/7, Atlanta waived forward Cartier Martin. In 25 games (two starts) with the Hawks, he averaged 6.6 points and 2.0 rebounds in 17.5 minutes.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 16, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the ninth-highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the fifth-highest assist total in club history.
