UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 27, 2014 at Oklahoma City Thunder (8:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Oklahoma City for the second-and-final game between the clubs this year ... The Thunder prevailed 101-92 at Philips Arena on 12/10, led by Kevin Durant's 30 points and 10 rebounds ... Paul Millsap had 23 points and 12 rebounds for Atlanta ... Oklahoma City owns a two-game winning streak in the series but Atlanta won the last contest in OKC on 11/4/12 (104-95) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 63-60 (24-35 on the road).



Wednesday, Jan. 29, 2014 vs. Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Pistons for the third-of-four matchups this season ... Atlanta was victorious in the first two meetings, taking the first contest 93-85 on 11/20 at home and winning the second game 96-89 on 11/22 in Detroit ... Atlanta's DeMarre Carroll is averaging 11.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals against the Pistons this season while Jeff Teague is averaging 18.0 points and 8.0 assists ... Detroit's Brandon Jennings (14.5 points and 10.0 assists) and Andre Drummond (12.5 points and 14.0 rebounds) are each averaging a double-double against the Hawks ... The clubs will close the season-series in Detroit on 2/21 ... Atlanta owns a three-game winning streak in the series and has won 10 straight at home ... The Pistons' last victory over the Hawks came on 1/4/13 in Detroit (85-84) and their last road triumph came on 2/12/08 (94-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 171-160 (75-77 at home).



Friday, Jan. 31, 2014 at Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to Philadelphia for the second-of-three matchups between the teams ... The Hawks won the first meeting 113-103 at home on 11/15 ... Jeff Teague scored 33 points and added 10 assists for Atlanta while Evan Turner led the 76ers with 27 points ... The clubs will close the series at Philips Arena on 3/31 ... The Hawks won the most recent game in Philadelphia 124-101 on 4/5/13 ... Philadelphia's last home victory was a 99-80 triumph on 12/21/12 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 160-159 (50-90 on the road).



Saturday, Feb. 1, 2014 vs. Minnesota Timberwolves (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks host the Timberwolves for the first-of-two contests this season ... The teams will meet again on 3/26 in Minnesota ... The 2012-13 series resulted in a 1-1 split with each club winning at home ... The Timberwolves last defeated the Hawks on 1/8/13 (108-103) in Minnesota ... Atlanta's most recent road victory came on 11/5/10 (113-103) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 29-16 (11-11 on the road).

NEWS & NOTES

* Kyle Korver was one of 28 players selected for the 2014-16 USA Men's National Team pool, from which the 2014 USA World Championship Team and, if the U.S. qualifies, the 2016 U.S. Olympic Team will be selected.

* Gustavo Ayon tied a career-high with four steals on 1/24 vs. San Antonio. He also tied season-highs with seven rebounds and two blocks, adding eight points and two assists in 27 minutes. DeMarre Carroll tied a career-high with eight FGM versus Miami on 1/20. He finished with 19 points, six rebounds and a steal in 37 minutes.

* At Orlando on 1/22, Paul Millsap tallied 24 points, six rebounds, five assists, a career-high-tying five blocks and three steals in 38 minutes, becoming the first player in franchise history to record at least those numbers in a game (according to the Elias Sports Bureau). The last player in the league to have at least that stat line was Dwyane Wade vs. Philadelphia on 3/25/11.

* Over his last nine games, Mike Scott is averaging 12.9 points on .518 FG% and .880 FT% in 21.3 minutes off the bench, while committing just seven turnovers. He has scored in double-figures in each of the last eight games (the longest streak of his career).

* On 1/25 at Milwaukee, Shelvin Mack made his first start of the year (fourth career and second as a Hawk), ending the night with nine points, four assists, two steals and one rebound in 24 minutes (3-7 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 2-2 FTs).

* On 1/25 at Milwaukee, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG for the 112th consecutive game.

* Injury report: Pero Antic (stress fracture, right ankle); Al Horford (right pectoral muscle surgery); John Jenkins (low back pain); and Jeff Teague (sprained left ankle) are all listed as "out" for 1/27 at Oklahoma City.

* On 1/22, the Hawks signed James Nunnally to a second 10-day contract. He is averaging 4.3 points and 1.7 rebounds in 14.1 minutes per game over three contests.

* On 1/25, Atlanta recalled Jared Cunningham from the Bakersfield Jam of the NBA Development League. In 17 games (14 starts) with the Jam, Cunningham averaged 15.2 points, 4.2 assists, 3.5 rebounds and 1.1 steals in 29.8 minutes.
