Monday, Jan. 6, 2014 at Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit the Nets for the first-of-three contests this season ... The clubs will meet again in London on 1/16 and in Brooklyn on 4/11 ... The teams split the 2012-13 series 2-2, which each squad taking a game apiece at home and on the road ... Atlanta won the last matchup 105-93 on 3/17 in Brooklyn ... The Nets last defeated the Hawks 93-80 in Atlanta on 3/9/13 while their last home triumph came on 1/18/13 (94-89) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 90-67 (33-46 on the road).



Wednesday, Jan. 8, 2014 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Pacers to Philips Arena for the first-of-four matchups this season ... The clubs will meet again in Atlanta on 2/4 and in Indiana on 2/18 and 4/6 ... The 2012-13 series was tied 2-2 as the home team won every contest ... The Pacers have won two in a row, taking the last meeting 100-94 on 3/25/13 ... The Hawks last defeated Indiana 109-100 on 12/29/12 in Atlanta and own an 11-game home winning streak ... The Pacers' last road victory came on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 92-77, including a 58-25 edge at home.



Friday, Jan. 10, 2014 vs. Houston Rockets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Rockets in the second-of-two meetings this season ... Houston won the first game 113-84 at home on 11/27, led by a game-high 21 points apiece from Aaron Brooks and Francisco Garcia ... Four Hawks scored in double figures, led by Paul Millsap's 16 points ... Houston has won two straight at Philips Arena (most recently 109-102 on 11/2/12) and owns a six-game overall winning streak over Atlanta ... Atlanta's last victory over the Rockets was a 102-95 road win on 1/25/10 and the Hawks' last home triumph came on 11/20/09 (105-103) ... Houston leads the all-time series 74-69 (22-49 on the road).



Sunday, Jan. 12, 2014 at Memphis Grizzlies (6:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Memphis for the first-of-two contests this season ... The clubs will close the series at Philips Arena on 2/8 ... Atlanta owns a two-game winning streak in the series, taking both games in 2012-13, ending with a 103-92 triumph in Atlanta on 2/6/13 ... The Hawks have won three in a row at Memphis, most recently on 12/8/12 (93-83) ... The Grizzlies' last victory over the Hawks was a 96-77 road win on 2/2/12 and their last home triumph came on 4/15/09 (98-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 23-11 (9-7 on the road).

* The NBA tipped off NBA FIT Live Healthy Week on 1/3, which will run through 1/10. During the week, the entire NBA family – led by the NBA FIT Team (including Hawks center Al Horford) – will join celebrity chefs, community members and partners to highlight the importance of healthy living through three simple pillars: be active, eat healthy and play together. NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta ranks first in the NBA in assists at 25.5 per game and has dished out at least 20 helpers 32 times, including a league-leading seven 30-assist nights (6-1 in those contests). The Hawks are recording assists on 66.2% (866-1309) of their made baskets, best in the league.

* On 12/31 at Boston, the Hawks overcame an 18-point deficit to mount their biggest comeback victory of the season and defeated the Celtics 92-91.

* Paul Millsap is the only player in the Eastern Conference and one-of-two in the NBA (DeMarcus Cousins) averaging at least 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks. He is averaging 17.7 points, 8.8 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 1.6 steals and 1.2 blocks on the year.

* On 12/31 at Boston, Millsap recorded season-highs in points (34) and rebounds (15). He became the first NBA player since Shaquille O'Neal in 1999 to record a 30/15 game during a win in Boston.

* On 1/4 at Chicago, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG for the 103rd consecutive game. On 12/31 at Boston, Korver converted his fourth four-point play of the season. It was the 32nd four-point play in the history of the franchise, ninth of Korver's career and his sixth as a Hawk.

* Pero Antic made his first career start on 1/3 versus Golden State. He set career-highs in points (16), rebounds (seven), FGM (six) and 3FGM (4) in 27 minutes. Antic started again 1/4 at Chicago and pulled down a career-high seven rebounds for the second consecutive game.

* On 1/3, DeMarre Carroll returned from a two-game absence (sprained right thumb) and tied his career-high with four steals. He added 12 points, seven rebounds and an assist.

* Last week, Al Horford underwent season-ending surgery on his torn right pectoral muscle. John Jenkins (low back pain) has been inactive for six games.

* On 1/1, Atlanta assigned Jared Cunningham to Bakersfield of the NBA Development League. In three stints with the Jam, he is averaging 17.9 points, 4.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 1.2 steals in 32.5 minutes in 11 games.

January 12, 1987 – Dominique Wilkins scores 53 points in Atlanta's 125-115 home win over the Los Angeles Clippers. His point total ranks as the sixth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history.
