### UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Feb. 18, 2014 at Indiana Pacers (7:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks make their first visit to Indiana for the third-of-four matchups this season ... Atlanta won the first meeting 97-87 at Philips Arena on 1/8 ... The visiting Pacers took the second contest 89-85 on 2/4 ... Mike Scott is averaging 15.0 points and 4.5 rebounds on .529 FG% and 1.000 FT% in two contests against Indiana ... David West is averaging 15.0 points and 10.5 rebounds in two games against the Hawks ... The clubs will close the series in Indiana on 4/6 ... The Pacers have won two straight at home ... Atlanta's last road victory came on 3/6/12 (101-96) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 93-78 (33-52 on the road).



Wednesday, Feb. 19, 2014 vs. Washington Wizards (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Washington to town for the third-of-four contests this season ... The Wizards took the first meeting 108-101 at home on 11/30 ... The Hawks won the second matchup 101-99 (OT) on 12/13 at Philips Arena ... Atlanta's Paul Millsap has recorded a double-double in both contests, averaging 19.5 points and 10.5 rebounds ... John Wall has recorded a double-double in both games for the Wizards, averaging 19.5 points and 11.5 assists ... The clubs will meet again Washington on 3/29 ... The Hawks own an 11-game home winning streak in the series ... Washington's last road victory came on 1/11/08 (102-98 OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 145-135 (92-42 at home).



Friday, Feb. 21, 2014 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks travel to Detroit for the third-of-four matchups this season ... Atlanta was victorious in the first two meetings, taking the first contest 93-85 on 11/20 at home and winning the second game 96-89 on 11/22 in Detroit ... Atlanta's DeMarre Carroll is averaging 11.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals against the Pistons this season while Jeff Teague is averaging 18.0 points and 8.0 assists ... Detroit's Brandon Jennings (14.5 points and 10.0 assists) and Andre Drummond (12.5 points and 14.0 rebounds) are each averaging a double-double against the Hawks ... The clubs will close the season-series in Atlanta on 4/8 ... Atlanta owns a three-game winning streak in the series, including two straight on the road... The Pistons' last victory over the Hawks came on 1/4/13 in Detroit (85-84) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 171-160 (82-72 at home).



Saturday, Feb. 22, 2014 vs. New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta welcomes New York to Philips Arena for the fourth-and-final meeting this season ... The Knicks own a 2-1 series lead this year, including a 95-91 triumph at Philips Arena (11/13) ... Kyle Korver is averaging 12.0 points and 4.7 rebounds in three contests against the Knicks ... Carmelo Anthony is averaging 27.7 points and 7.3 rebounds in three games against the Hawks ... The Knicks own a three-game road winning streak in the series ... Atlanta's last home victory came on 3/30/12 (100-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 185-170, including a 62-36 home record.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* On 2/16, Paul Millsap participated in his first career NBA All-Star Game at New Orleans Arena. He finished the night with six points (3-5 FGs), three rebounds and one assist in 15 minutes of action for the victorious Eastern Conference squad.

\* Pero Antic was selected as a participant in the BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge played on 2/14 during All-Star Weekend. He was unable to participate due to injury.

\* At the All-Star break, the Hawks rank in the top-10 in the following statistical categories: assists per game (first - 25.6); steals per game (fourth - 8.88); free throw percentage (sixth - .779); three point shooting percentage (seventh - .371); turnovers forced per game (seventh - 15.7); and field goal percentage (eighth - .459).

\* The following Hawks rank in the top-10 of a statistical category: DeMarre Carroll (1.56 steals/turnover - second); Kyle Korver (.628 adjusted field goal percentage - second), (.464 three point shooting percentage - fourth), (123 three pointers made - tied for seventh); Shelvin Mack (3.22 assists per turnover - eighth); and Jeff Teague (7.6 assists per game - seventh).

\* Last week, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record for consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer to 120.

\* On 2/12 at Toronto, Gustavo Ayon scored a career-high 18 points (9-11 FGs) and added 10 rebounds for his first double-double of the season. His nine FGM were also a career-best.

\* On 2/11, the Hawks signed Cartier Martin to a second 10-day contract. Martin has appeared in 27 games (two starts) with the Hawks this season, averaging 6.6 points and 2.0 rebounds in 17.0 minutes. He has also played in six contests this year with the Chicago Bulls, and averaged 2.5 points in 7.9 minutes.

\* On 2/11 at Chicago, DeMarre Carroll suffered a left hamstring strain. He was listed as out for 2/12 at Toronto and his status will be updated as appropriate.

February 21, 1979 – Wayne "Tree" Rollins notches the first recorded triple-double in Hawks history with 11 points, 13 rebounds and a franchise record 12 blocked shots in Atlanta's 106-83 home win over Portland.
