### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Feb. 25, 2014 vs. Chicago Bulls (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Bulls for the first time this season in the third-of-four contests between the teams ... Chicago won the first meeting 91-84 on 1/4 and took the second matchup 100-85 on 2/11 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 15.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks against the Bulls ... Joakim Noah is averaging 14.5 points, 14.0 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 4.0 blocks versus Atlanta this season ... The clubs will close the season series at Philips Arena on 4/2 ... Chicago has won four straight over the Hawks, including the last game in Atlanta on 2/2/13 (93-76) ... Atlanta's last victory over the Bulls was a 92-75 home win on 12/22/12 ... Chicago leads the all-time series 120-102, but the Hawks hold a 61-47 edge at home.



**Wednesday, Feb. 26, 2014 at Boston Celtics (7:30 p.m.)**

Atlanta visits Boston for the third-of-four contests between the clubs this season ... The Celtics won the first matchup 94-87 on 11/23 on the Hawks' home floor ... Atlanta was victorious in Boston on 12/31 (92-91) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 23.0 points and 10.0 rebounds against Boston this season ... Jeff Green is averaging 12.0 points and 5.0 rebounds versus the Hawks this year ... The teams will close the series at Philips Arena on 4/9 ... The Celtics' last home victory against Atlanta came on 3/29/13 (118-107) ... Boston leads the all-time series 226-134, including a 119-35 mark at home.



**Sunday, Mar. 2, 2014 at Phoenix Suns (8:00 p.m.)**

The Hawks travel to Phoenix for the first-of-two matchups this season ... The clubs will close the season series at Philips Arena on 3/24 ... The 2012-13 series resulted in a 1-1 split as both teams won at home, punctuated by the Hawks' 107-94 victory on 3/15/13 ... Atlanta's last victory in Phoenix came on 2/15/12 (101-99) ... The Suns lead the all-time series 67-49, including a 41-16 mark in Phoenix.

### NEWS & NOTES

- \* On 2/21 at Detroit, Atlanta scored 41 points in the second quarter to set a season-high for any period. The Hawks' .850 FG% (17-20) in the quarter was the second-best in a quarter in the NBA this season and their 13 straight FGM tied a league season-high.
- \* On 2/22 vs. New York, Mike Scott set career-highs in points (30), field goals made (11) and three-pointers made (six). He became the first Hawk to ever score 30 points and make six 3FGs in 30 minutes-or-less off the bench.
- \* DeMarre Carroll scored a career-high 24 points (8-14 FGs, 4-8 3FGs, 4-5 FTs) against the Knicks on 2/22, also adding six rebounds and two steals in 34 minutes.
- \* Jeff Teague's 13 FTM on 2/22 vs. New York set a new career-high. It tied for the fourth-highest total by a point guard this season and was the third time this season Teague has converted at least 10 FTs. He finished with 28 points, six assists and three rebounds in 37 minutes. Teague's 16 points in the fourth quarter tied the Hawks' individual season-high for any quarter.
- \* On 2/21 at Detroit, Shelvin Mack set career-bests with 21 points and eight FGM, adding six assists and four rebounds in a career-high 38 minutes.
- \* On 2/19 vs. Washington, Elton Brand scored 20 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, turning in his first effort with at least 20 points and at least 10 rebounds since 3/31/12.
- \* Last week, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record of consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer to 124. Also last week, Lou Williams converted the 500<sup>th</sup> 3FG of his career.
- \* On 2/20, the Hawks acquired Antawn Jamison from the Clippers in exchange for the draft rights to Cenk Aykol. On 2/21, the Hawks waived Jamison.
- \* On 2/21, the Hawks signed Cartier Martin for the remainder of the season. He has appeared in 33 games (four starts) with the Hawks this season, averaging 6.5 points and 2.0 rebounds in 16.8 minutes.
- \* On 2/22, the Hawks waived Jared Cunningham. He appeared in five games with the Hawks this season.
- \* On 2/22, the Hawks signed Dexter Pittman to a 10-day contract. Most recently, Pittman was with the Austin Toros of the NBA Development League, playing in 17 contests (nine starts), and averaged 9.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.9 blocks in 17.5 minutes (.538 FG%, .717 FT%).

**March 1, 1988** – Dominique Wilkins scores 50 points in a 117-104 home loss to Detroit. It is tied for ninth highest single-game point total in Hawks history.
