Tuesday, Feb. 4, 2014 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Pacers to Philips Arena for the second-of-four matchups this season ... Atlanta won the first meeting 97-87 at Philips Arena on 1/8 ... Kyle Korver led five Hawks with double-digit scoring efforts, recording 17 points ... Indiana's Paul George had game-highs of 28 points and 12 rebounds ... The clubs will meet again at Indiana on 2/18 and 4/6 ... Atlanta owns a 12-game regular season home winning streak over Indiana ... The Pacers last defeated the Hawks on 3/25/13 in Indiana (100-94), and their last road victory came on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 93-77, including a 59-25 edge at home.



Wednesday, Feb. 5, 2014 at New Orleans Pelicans (8:00 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to New Orleans for the first of two meetings between the clubs ... The teams will close the season series at Philips Arena on 3/21 ... The 2012-13 season series ended in a 1-1 split, with the visiting team winning each contest ... The Hawks have won two straight games at New Orleans, with the Pelicans last recording a home victory on 12/26/10 (93-86) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 43-39 (18-22 on the road).



Saturday, Feb. 8, 2014 vs. Memphis Grizzlies (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks welcome Memphis to town for the second-and-final contest between the teams this season ... The Grizzlies won the first matchup on 1/12 in Memphis (108-101), led by double-doubles from Mike Conley (21 points and 13 assists) and Zach Randolph (18 points and 12 rebounds) ... Paul Millsap (21 points) and Jeff Teague (20 points) paced the Hawks ... Atlanta won the most recently played game at Philips Arena on 2/6/13 (103-92) ... The Grizzlies' most recent road victory over the Hawks came on 2/2/12 (96-77) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 23-12 (14-4 at home).

* The Hawks will be honoring individuals for the Be Greater Atlanta Award during both home games this week. On 2/4 vs. Indiana, Nell Benn, Director of the Agape Youth & Family Center, will be recognized. The Agape Center provides mentoring relationships for underprivileged families and children along with after school programs for students in metro Atlanta. On 2/8 vs. Memphis, the Hawks will honor James Shepherd, Co-Founder of the Shepherd Center, a nationally ranked rehabilitation facility in Atlanta that has served as official sponsor of the wheelchair division of the Peachtree Road Race since 1984.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 1/27, Paul Millsap was named Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played 1/20-1/26. He averaged 21.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.8 assists, 2.5 steals and 2.0 blocks in 31.0 minutes per game (.508 FG%, .815 FT%).

* On 1/30, Millsap was selected as an Eastern Conference All-Star in voting among the Conference's coaches. It is the first All-Star selection of his career. The 2014 NBA All-Star game takes place on 2/16 at New Orleans Arena.

* On 1/29, Pero Antic was selected as a participant in the BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge to be played on 2/14 in New Orleans during NBA All-Star 2014. He is the fifth Hawk to appear in the game, joining Alan Henderson, Jason Terry, Josh Smith and Al Horford.

* The Hawks/Pistons game originally scheduled for 1/29 at Philips Arena has been rescheduled for 4/8 at 7:30 p.m.

* Last week, the Hawks scored at least 120 points in consecutive contests for the first time since 4/12/04 and 4/14/04. Atlanta scored 125 on 1/31 at Philadelphia and 120 on 2/1 vs. Minnesota.

* On 2/1 vs. Minnesota, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record by converting at least one 3FG for the 115th consecutive game. Korver also converted his 300th 3FG as a Hawk (currently at 302). He scored a team-high 24 points in 36 minutes.

* On 1/31 vs. Philadelphia, Elton Brand and Mike Scott each scored a season-high 18 points. It was Scott's second 18 point effort of the year.

* On 1/27 at OKC, Dennis Schröder tied his career-high with 10 points and Gustavo Ayon set season-highs with 10 rebounds and four assists in 26 minutes. Lou Williams scored his 6000th career point in the contest.

* On 12/1, Atlanta signed Cartier Martin to a 10-day contract. Martin appeared in 25 games (two starts) with the Hawks earlier this season before being waived on 1/7. He averaged 6.6 points and 2.0 rebounds in 17.5 minutes over the 25-game span. After being waived, Martin signed two 10-day contracts with Chicago and saw action in six contests (2.5 points, .625 FG%, .600 3FG%, 7.9 minutes).

February 5, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
