UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Mar. 10, 2014 at Utah Jazz (9:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit the Jazz for the only time this season in the second-of-two contests between the teams ... Atlanta defeated Utah for the fifth straight time on 12/20, winning 118-85 at Philips Arena ... Paul Millsap had 14 points and 10 rebounds for the Hawks ... Enes Kanter had 13 points and a game-high 13 rebounds for Utah ... The Jazz last defeated the Hawks on 11/12/10 (90-86) in Atlanta ... Utah's last home victory came on 2/23/09 (108-89) ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 48-44, including a 31-13 home record.



Thursday, Mar. 13, 2014 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Bucks for the only time this season in the second-of-three games between the clubs ... The Hawks were victorious in Milwaukee on 1/25 (112-87) ... Paul Millsap scored 20 points and grabbed eight rebounds to lead Atlanta ... Brandon Knight scored a game-high 27 points for the Bucks ... The Hawks own a five-game overall win-streak in the series and have beaten the Bucks four straight times in Atlanta ... Milwaukee's last victory over Atlanta came on 3/27/12 (108-101) at home, while the Bucks' most recent road triumph over the Hawks came on 11/10/10 (108-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 101-99, including a 65-35 mark at home.



Saturday, Mar. 15, 2014 vs. Denver Nuggets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome the Nuggets to Philips Arena for the second-and-final contest between the teams this season ... Denver won the first matchup 109-107 at home on 11/7 ... Paul Millsap led Atlanta in points (29) and rebounds (11) ... Ty Lawson led Denver in points (23) and assists (eight) ... The Nuggets have won two-in-a-row in the series, but the Hawks won the most recent contest in Atlanta on 12/5/12 (108-104) ... Atlanta owns a 41-37 lead in the all-time series, including a 30-7 edge at home.

* In partnership with the National Center for Civil and Human Rights, the Atlanta Hawks are hosting their annual Poetry Slam Contest for high school students. * On 3/15 vs. the Nuggets, the Atlanta Hawks will honor Joe and Peggy O'Toole (YMCA volunteers) with the Be Greater Atlanta Award. The Be Greater Atlanta Program follows United Way's campaign designed to recognize individuals throughout Metro Atlanta that are making a difference in their local communities.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks have made double-digit three-pointers in 27 games this season, tying the franchise record set last year.

* Atlanta ranks in the NBA's Top 10 in: FG% (ninth at .459); 3FG% (ninth at .375); and FT% (sixth at .778). The Hawks have shot at least .500 from the field in three of their last five games.

* On 3/5 at Portland, Cartier Martin tied his career-high with three steals adding a season-high six rebounds and 16 points in 24 minutes.

* On 3/5, Pero Antic appeared in his first game since 1/22 at Orlando, a span of 16 games. Antic had 10 points (3-5 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) and four rebounds in 16 minutes. In three games since returning, Antic has averaged 12.0 points on .542 FG%, .423 3FG% and .750 FT%.

* On 3/7 at Golden State, Paul Millsap returned to the lineup after missing five games due to a right knee contusion. He scored a team-high 16 points and added seven rebounds and three assists in 24 minutes.

* On 3/7, Elton Brand blocked the 1,772nd shot of his career, moving him past Elvin Hayes into sole possession of 21st place in league history. He added nine points, six rebounds and three assists. In his last six games, Brand is shooting .611 FG%, hitting at least .500 from the field in each contest.

* Last week, Kyle Korver's NBA record of consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer ended at 127. The streak lasted from 11/4/12-3/2/14 and broke Dana Barros' old record of 89 straight games. Korver shot .469 (377-718) from beyond-the-arc during the run.

* On 3/8, Kyle Korver converted his seventh four-point play of the season. He is two shy of Jamal Crawford's single-season franchise record of nine set in 2009-10. It was Korver's ninth four-point play as a Hawk, 12th of his career and the 37th in franchise history.

* The Hawks committed a season-low eight turnovers on 3/5 at Portland, resulting in a season-low five points off turnovers for an opponent.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

March 14, 1997 – Steve Smith sets a franchise record by hitting nine three-pointers in a 97-91 home loss to Seattle. He finished the night with 36 points on 10-20 FGs, 9-15 3FGs and 7-7 FTs. Smith also set a record for three's in a quarter (7) which was later tied by Henry James.

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
