Monday, Mar. 17, 2014 at Charlotte Bobcats (7:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Charlotte for the third-of-four contests between the teams ... Atlanta defeated the Bobcats in the first two meetings, winning 103-94 at Charlotte on 11/11 and claiming a 118-116 victory on 12/28 at Philips Arena ... Jeff Teague is averaging 17.0 points and 10.5 assists against Charlotte this season ... Al Jefferson is averaging 17.0 points and 15.0 rebounds against Atlanta this year ... The clubs will close the series on 4/14 in the Hawks' home finale ... Atlanta owns a 10-game win-streak over Charlotte, including five straight on the road ... The Bobcats last defeated the Hawks on 4/13/11 (96-85) in Charlotte ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 22-16 (8-11 on the road).



Tuesday, Mar. 18, 2014 vs. Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Raptors in the third-of-four games between the clubs ... The Hawks were victorious in their home season-opener on 11/1 (102-95) but Toronto bounced back to win at home on 2/12 (104-83) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 15.0 points and 9.0 assists versus Toronto this season ... DeMar DeRozan is averaging 31.0 points against the Hawks this year ... The teams will end the series on 3/23 in Toronto ... The Raptors last defeated the Hawks in Atlanta on 4/16/13 (113-96) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 40-29, including a 21-14 mark at home.



Friday, Mar. 21, 2014 vs. New Orleans Pelicans (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks welcome the Pelicans to Philips Arena for the second-and-final contest between the teams this season ... New Orleans won the first matchup 105-100 at home on 2/5 ... Paul Millsap (26 points and 10 rebounds) and Jeff Teague (11 points and 13 assists) each had a double-double for the Hawks ... Anthony Davis led the Pelicans with 27 points and 10 rebounds ... The Pelicans own a two-game overall win-streak over Atlanta and have won two straight at Philips Arena ... The Hawks' last home victory in the series came on 11/14/09 (121-98) ... Atlanta owns a 43-40 lead in the all-time series, including a 25-17 home record.

* In partnership with the National Center for Civil and Human Rights, the Atlanta Hawks are hosting their annual Poetry Slam Contest for high school students. This year's theme is "Non-Discrimination, Acceptance and Respect for Others: Why It Matters to You." Students should submit their written poems or a DVD of their performance for the chance to win an iPad, laptop computer or tablet notebook along with Hawks autographed merchandise. * On 3/20, the Hawks will host a Wheelchair Basketball Clinic at Philips Arena with the American Association of Adapted Sports Programs (AAASP) Wheelchair Basketball State Championship Teams. Players from the defending state champion Houston County Sharks and the Henry County Hurricanes will participate in the clinic, engaging in shooting and passing drills with the Atlanta Hawks Coaching Staff and select players. The event will take place from 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. on the Practice Court.

* On 3/21, when the Hawks host New Orleans, *Good Morning America* anchor Robin Roberts will receive the Be Greater award presented by SunTrust, recognizing individuals who are making a difference in their communities. At halftime, Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins will take a three-point shot for a chance to have \$10,000 donated to Be The Match (Roberts has personally committed to donating an additional \$10,000 if Wilkins makes the shot). Be The Match will be on-site during the game signing individuals up for the Be The Match Registry®. Tickets to the game are still available and by purchasing at www.hawks.com/bethematch and using code ROBIN, \$2 will be donated directly to Be The Match efforts in Georgia.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 3/10 at Utah, the Hawks made 13 three-pointers, marking their 28th time this season (currently 30) with at least 10 3FGM and breaking the franchise record of 27 such games set last year.

* Paul Millsap recorded 24 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, three steals and two blocks while not committing a turnover vs. Denver (3/15), marking the ninth time (by seven players) since 1985-86 an NBA player has accumulated at least that stat line while not committing a miscue. Joining Millsap on the list are Charles Barkley (twice), Hakeem Olajuwon (twice), Dirk Nowitzki, Vlade Divac, David Lee and Luol Deng.

* On 3/15, Jeff Teague recorded his 12th double-double of the season, contributing 15 points, 10 assists, six rebounds, one steal and a block in 36 minutes. It was Teague's 31st point/assist double-double of his career, breaking a tie with Pete Maravich for eighth in franchise history and entering into a tie for seventh with Joe Johnson. The Hawks are 26-5 all-time when Teague records a double-double.

* DeMarre Carroll registered the second double-double of his career on 3/15, tallying 11 points, 10 rebounds, four steals and three assists in 42 minutes. The Hawks are 4-0 when Carroll records at least 10 rebounds.

* Kyle Korver is shooting .727 FG%, .875 3FG%, 1.000 FT% and averaging 19.0 points over his last four games. Korver has also made 23 consecutive free-throws (last miss on 2/21 at Detroit).

* In addition to being broadcast on SportSouth HD and 92.9 FM, the Hawks vs. Raptors contest on 3/18 will be shown on NBA TV.
