UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Mar. 5, 2014 at Portland Trail Blazers (10:30 p.m.)
TV: ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit the Trail Blazers for the only time this season in the first-of-two contests between the teams ... The clubs will close the season series at Philips Arena on 3/27 ... The 2012-13 series resulted in a 1-1 split, as each team won on the road ... Portland took the most recent contest 104-93 on 3/22/13 and last won at home on 2/18/12 (97-77) ... The all-time series is tied 51-51, with the Trail Blazers holding a 33-18 edge at home.



Friday, Mar. 7, 2014 at Golden State Warriors (10:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Golden State for the only time this season to close the two-game series ... The Warriors won at Philips Arena on 1/3 (101-100) via a buzzer-beater by Andre Iguodala ... Pero Antic led six Hawks in double-figures with 16 points ... David Lee scored 23 points to lead three Warriors who scored at least 20 points ... Atlanta's last victory in the series was a road triumph on 2/25/11 (95-79) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 141-138 (44-75 at Golden State).



Saturday, Mar. 8, 2014 at Los Angeles Clippers (10:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks take on the Clippers in the second-of-two meetings this season ... On 12/4, Atlanta defeated Los Angeles for the second straight time, emerging with a 107-97 home victory ... Paul Millsap scored a game-high 25 points and added nine rebounds for the Hawks ... Blake Griffin led Los Angeles in scoring with 24 points ... The Clippers last defeated the Hawks on 11/11/12 in Los Angeles (89-76) ... Atlanta owns a 73-38 lead in the all-time series, including a 30-24 edge on the road.

NEWS & NOTES

- * Jeff Teague is averaging 27.3 points on .577 FG% over the last four games, scoring at least 26 points and shooting at least .500 FG% in each contest. It is the highest scoring four-game stretch of his career and marks the first time a Hawk has scored at least 26 points in four straight games since Joe Johnson in 2009 (3/9-3/15).
- * On 3/2 at Phoenix, Jeff Teague tied his career-high with 14 FGM. He scored a team-high 29 points and added nine assists, six rebounds, two steals and a block in 31 minutes.
- * On 3/2 at Phoenix, Mike Scott made his second start of the season. He played a career-high 40 minutes and totaled 20 points, five rebounds, a career-high three steals and two assists.
- * On 2/26 at Boston, DeMarre Carroll tied his career-high with 24 points. He added seven rebounds, one assist, one steal and a block in 37 minutes.
- * Last week DeMarre Carroll converted a four-point play in two consecutive games (2/22-2/25). He became the first Hawk to accomplish that feat since Jamal Crawford (11/5/10-11/7/10). Carroll joined Crawford, John Jenkins, Kyle Korver and Salim Stoudamire as the only players with multiple four-point plays in an Atlanta uniform.
- * On 2/25 vs. Chicago, Shelvin Mack tied a career-high with eight FGM. He finished with 17 points, four rebounds and three assists in 27 minutes.
- * Last week, Kyle Korver extended his NBA record of consecutive games with at least one made three-pointer to 127. He has made at least two 3FGs in 11 consecutive games, tied for the third-longest streak of his career.
- * Lou Williams has scored in double-figures in a season-best seven consecutive games, averaging 14.4 points during the stretch.
- * On 3/2 at Phoenix, Elton Brand blocked two shots to tie Elvin Hayes for 21st in NBA history (1771). Brand added 13 points, six rebounds, four assists and a steal in 31 minutes.
- * On 2/27, the Hawks signed Mike Muscala to a contract. Atlanta acquired the draft rights to Muscala in a trade with Dallas on 6/28/13. He had spent the 2013-14 season with Blusens Monbus Obradoiro of the ACB League in Spain and averaged 14.6 points, 7.8 rebounds and 1.1 assists in 26.3 minutes over 20 games. Muscala made his NBA debut on 3/2 at Phoenix, becoming the first Bucknell University alum to play in a regular-season NBA game. He finished with four points, five rebounds and two blocks in 19 minutes.
- * On 2/27, the Hawks released Dexter Pittman. He was signed to a 10-day contract on 2/22 and appeared in two games with the Hawks this season.
- * Gustavo Ayon underwent surgery to repair a right shoulder injury on 2/28. Ayon will undergo a period of rest, treatment and rehabilitation. He will be out through the remainder of the season. He appeared in 26 games (14 starts) and averaged 4.3 points, 4.8 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.0 blocks in 16.5 minutes (.510 FG%).
