SERIES RECAP

The teams have alternated wins through the first four games of the series, with each club recording a victory at home and on the road. The Hawks took Game 1 at Indiana and Game 3 at home, while the Pacers won Game 2 at home and Game 4 at Philips Arena. Game 5 will be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse on 4/28 and Game 6 is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. in Atlanta on 5/1. For the Hawks, Paul Millsap is averaging 21.8 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 blocks (.444 3FG%) in the series while Jeff Teague is putting up 19.5 points, 6.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals. Indiana's Paul George has recorded four double-doubles, averaging 21.8 points, 11.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.0 blocks.

ALL-TIME REGULAR SEASON/POSTSEASON

Atlanta and Indiana square off in a first round playoff series after splitting four games in the regular season ... This marks the sixth time, and second consecutive year, Atlanta and Indiana have met in the postseason (previously four times in the first round and once in the Eastern Conference Quarterfinals) ... The Hawks recorded first round series wins in 1987 (3-1) and 1996 (3-2), while falling in 1995 (3-0) and 2013 (4-2) ... The Pacers posted a 4-2 quarterfinals series triumph in 1994 ... The Hawks are 12-16 all-time against the Pacers in the postseason (8-5 at home and 4-11 on the road) ... Prior to this year, Atlanta dropped the last postseason game in Indiana on 5/1/13 (106-83).

* On 4/27, Al Horford was given the Global Community Hero Award at the UNICEF Experience Atlanta. UNICEF works in more than 190 countries and territories to save and improve children's lives.

NEWS & NOTES

- * On 4/24 versus Indiana, the Hawks scored 59 points in the second half, their highest scoring second half in postseason play since 5/2/91 versus Detroit (65).
- * On 4/26, Atlanta held the Pacers to 13 points on .250 FG% (5-20), tying a Hawks playoff opponent low for second-quarter scoring.
- * Atlanta made 12 three-pointers on 4/24, tying the franchise playoff record for 3FGM in a game (set 5/13/96 against Orlando). The Hawks made 10 3FGs in the second half.
- *The Hawks set a franchise record by connecting on 10-plus 3FGs in four consecutive postseason games (4/19-4/26).
- * On 4/26, the Hawks went 17-17 from the free-throw line, the first perfect free-throw shooting performance in franchise postseason history.
- * On 4/24, Jeff Teague recorded the first double-double of his postseason career. He scored 22 points and handed out a postseason career-high 10 assists, adding two rebounds, a steal and a block in 37 minutes. He became the first Hawk with 20 points and 10 assists in a playoff game since Spud Webb in 1986.
- * Paul Millsap set postseason career-highs in scoring and three-pointers on 4/26, scoring 29 points and making three 3FGs.
- * Millsap recorded the seventh double-double of his playoff career on 4/24, tallying 14 points and 14 rebounds. He added a postseason career-high tying four assists and a block in 38 minutes.
- * On 4/24, DeMarre Carroll set postseason career-bests in points (18), FGM (six) and FTM (four).
- * Kyle Korver pulled down a postseason career-high nine rebounds on 4/26. He added 15 points, including three 3FGs, tying him with Tyrone Corbin for sixth on the Hawks all-time postseason 3FGM list (22).
- * Korver scored 20 points (6-9 FGs, 4-7 3FGs, 4-4 FTs) on 4/24, tying for the second-highest total of his postseason career. His four-point play in the fourth quarter was his eighth of 2013-14 (including regular season).
- * On 4/26, Mike Scott set playoff career-highs in points, scoring 12 points and tied his postseason career-best with four FGM.
- * Lou Williams set a postseason career-best with four steals on 4/26.
