### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Mar. 31, 2014 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta plays host to Philadelphia for the third-and-final matchup between the teams ... The Hawks won the first two meetings, taking the first contest at home on 11/15 (113-103), before emerging victorious in Philadelphia on 1/31 (125-99) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 22.5 points and 9.0 assists against the Sixers this season while Thaddeus Young is averaging 23.0 points and 7.5 rebounds for Philadelphia ... Atlanta owns a three-game winning streak in the series, with the Sixers last defeating the Hawks on 4/5/13 in Atlanta (101-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 161-159 (98-52 at home).



**Wednesday, Apr. 2, 2014 vs. Chicago Bulls (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Bulls for the second time this season in the fourth-and-final contest between the clubs ... Chicago won the first two meetings at home, 91-84 on 1/4 and 100-85 on 2/11 before a 107-103 road triumph on 2/25 ... Jeff Teague is averaging 18.0 points on .511 FG% in three games against the Bulls this season ... Joakim Noah is averaging 16.3 points, 13.3 rebounds and 5.3 assists versus Atlanta this season ... Chicago has won five straight over the Hawks, including two-in-a-row in Atlanta ... Atlanta's last victory over the Bulls was a 92-75 home win on 12/22/12 ... Chicago leads the all-time series 121-102, but the Hawks hold a 61-48 edge at home.



**Friday, Apr. 4, 2014 vs. Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks welcome the Cavaliers to Philips Arena for the third-and-final matchup this season ... Atlanta has taken the first two contests, winning 108-89 at home on 12/6 and 127-125 (2OT) in Cleveland on 12/26 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 18.0 points and 12.5 rebounds on .516 FG% in two games versus Cleveland this year ... Dion Waiters is putting up 25.0 points on .647 FG% in two games against the Hawks this season ... Atlanta owns a three-game winning streak in the series, with Cleveland's last victory coming on 1/9/13 at home (99-83) ... The Cavs' last road victory in the series came on 11/30/12 (113-111) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 113-95, including a 67-35 mark at home.



**Sunday, Apr. 6, 2014 at Indiana Pacers (6:00 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks make their second visit to Indiana for the fourth-and-final matchup this season ... Atlanta won the first meeting 97-87 at Philips Arena on 1/8 ... The Pacers took the second contest 89-85 in Atlanta on 2/4 and followed that with a 108-98 triumph at home on 2/18 ... Kyle Korver is averaging 15.0 points on .630 FG% and .529 3FG% in three contests against Indiana ... Paul George is averaging 24.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.3 steals in three games against the Hawks ... The Pacers have won three straight over Atlanta at home ... The Hawks' last road victory came on 3/6/12 (101-96) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 93-79 (33-53 on the road).

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* For the second year in a row, the Hawks are partnering with Arrow Exterminators and Trees Atlanta on the Threes for Trees program. As part of the initiative and in conjunction with NBA Green Week, the organizations will help beautify the grounds of Hope Hill Elementary on 4/1 (2-4 p.m.) and plant a tree in memory of Walt Bellamy and Dan Roundfield, two Hawks Alumni that have passed away in recent years. Paul Millsap, Mike Scott and Mike Muscala, along with Hawks & Philips Arena President Bob Williams, will take part in the event.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks have scored 100-plus points 42 times so far this year, equaling last season's total and the most in a season since 2009-10 (48 times).

\* Pero Antic has made 50 3FGs this season, the fourth-highest total for a rookie in franchise history. Ranking ahead of Antic are Salim Stoudamire 82 (2005-06), Paul Graham 55 (1991-92) and John Jenkins 53 (2012-13).

\* On 3/29 at Washington, Pero Antic pulled down a career-high tying 12 rebounds and scored 13 points for his third double-double of the season.

\* On 3/26 at Minnesota, Mike Muscala recorded career-highs in points (eight) and minutes (24), adding four rebounds and a block. On 3/29 at Washington, Muscala set a career-high with eight rebounds.

\* On 3/24 vs. Phoenix, Jeff Teague moved past Marvin Williams into 10<sup>th</sup> place on the Hawks' all-time three-pointers made list (currently at 220 3FGM).

\* Shelvin Mack has handed out at least four assists in four straight games, tying his longest streak of the season (12/4 – 12/13), averaging 5.0 apg during the stretch.

\* On 3/24 vs. Phoenix, DeMarre Carroll made a career-high seven free-throws. He totaled 19 points (5-8 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 7-7 FTs), four rebounds one assist and steal in 37 minutes.

\* Kyle Korver has made 28 consecutive FTs (last miss at Detroit on 2/21), Jeff Teague has hit 14-in-a-row (last miss vs. New Orleans on 3/21) and Shelvin Mack has knocked down 12 straight from the charity stripe (last miss at Boston on 2/26).

\* Kyle Korver has missed the last six games (3/21 – 3/29) due to back spasms. He is listed as a game-time decision for the Philadelphia game on 3/31. Pero Antic missed the Hawks-Trail Blazers game on 3/27 due to a sprained right ankle. DeMarre Carroll was not with the team on 3/29 at Washington due to a stomach virus.

\* The Hawks/Bulls game on 4/2 features the "Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday" promotion and includes an upper level ticket and \$10 food and beverage credit for \$25, while the Hawks-Cavs contest on 4/4 has the "Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays" promotion (four tickets and \$40 in Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$88).
