UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Oct. 14, 2014 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Miami for the only meeting against the Heat during the preseason ... The teams will meet four times during the regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/14 and 3/27, and at Miami on 12/3 and 2/28 ... The Hawks and Heat split the 2013-14 series 2-2, with the home team winning each contest ... Atlanta has won two straight regular season games against Miami, with the Heat last recording a victory on 12/23/13 (121-119 OT) ... The Hawks last defeated the Heat in Miami on 1/2/12 (100-92) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 57-42 and are 37-13 at home.



Thursday, Oct. 16, 2014 at Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks head to Chicago for the only preseason match-up with the Bulls ... The clubs will meet three times during the regular season – at Philips Arena on 12/15, and at Chicago on 1/17 and 4/15 ... The Bulls swept the 2013-14 series 4-0 and own a six-game regular season winning streak against the Hawks ... The Hawks' last victory over the Bulls was at home on 12/22/12 (92-75) ... The Hawks last defeated the Bulls in Chicago on 3/1/10 (116-92) ... Chicago leads the all-time series 122-102 and is 61-49 in the Windy City.



Saturday, Oct. 18, 2014 vs. Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast

Atlanta travels to Detroit for the only meeting against the Pistons during the preseason ... The teams will meet four times during the regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/21 and 1/19, and at Detroit on 1/9 and 3/31 ... The Hawks and Pistons split the 2013-14 series 2-2, with each team winning at home and on the road once ... Detroit has won two straight regular season games against Atlanta, with the Hawks last recording a victory on 11/22/13 (96-89) in Detroit ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Pistons at home was on 11/20/13 (93-85) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 171-162 and are 75-78 at home.

COMMUNITY NEWS

- * The Hawks held a surprise visit and open scrimmage for the students at Miller Grove High School in Lithonia on 10/9. Students were able to watch the coaches put the team through practice and a scrimmage, while also being entertained by Harry the Hawk and the cheerleaders.
- * For the second straight season, Kyle Korver is assisting the Atlanta Mission with a sock drive benefiting the homeless. Drop-off sites around the city for "Socktober" will be at Atlanta Mission (165 Ivan Allen Jr. Blvd., Atlanta, GA 30318) and Women's Premier Fitness (4961 Lower Roswell Rd., Marietta, GA 30068). Socks will also be collected at the Hawks-Pistons preseason game on 10/18 at Philips Arena. The first 50 fans to donate at the game will receive a pass for a postgame meet & greet with Korver.

NEWS & NOTES

- * Hawks guard John Jenkins posted a team-high in points in each of the first two games of the preseason. On 10/6, Jenkins scored 13 points (5-7 FGs, 1-2 3FG, 2-2 FTs) in 24 minutes vs. New Orleans. On 10/11, Jenkins tallied 15 points (5-6 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 3-4 FTs) in 24 minutes at Memphis. In the two games combined, Jenkins is averaging a team-best 14.0 ppg while shooting team-highs of .769 (10-13 FG) from the field and .600 (3-5 3FG) from beyond the arc.
- * Atlanta Hawks individual game tickets for the 2014-15 season are currently on sale. The regular season home schedule tips off on 11/1 against Indiana in a rematch of playoff opponents from the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons. Prices for seats in select locations will be reduced by over 50% throughout Philips Arena for the season-opening contest while supplies last. Tickets are available for purchase with no ticketing fees by visiting www.hawks.com, by calling 1.866.715.1500, and at the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.
- * First-round draft pick Adreian Payne and free agent signee Thabo Sefolosha made their Atlanta debuts in the 10/6 preseason game vs. New Orleans. In the 93-87 victory, Payne recorded four points, grabbed seven rebounds and added two assists, while Sefolosha scored nine points, tallied seven boards and recorded a game-high three steals. In two preseason games Payne is averaging 2.0 ppg, a team-high 7.5 rpg and 1.5 apg, while Sefolosha is averaging 8.5 ppg, 6.5 rpg and a team-high 1.5 spg.
- * The Hawks have four international players on the roster this year, including representatives from the Republic of Macedonia (Pero Antic, the first NBA player from the country), Dominican Republic (Al Horford), Germany (Dennis Schröder) and Switzerland (Thabo Sefolosha). Additionally, first-year Assistant Coach Neven Spahija is a native of Croatia.
- * SportSouth is televising 75 Atlanta Hawks games throughout the 2014-15 NBA season, all in high definition. Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins returns for his seventh year as the Hawks game analyst with play-by-play announcer Bob Rathbun, in his 19th season. Visit www.hawks.com for complete TV listings.
