Monday, Oct. 20, 2014 vs. Charlotte Hornets (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast

Atlanta hosts Charlotte for the only meeting against the Hornets during the preseason ... The teams will meet four times during the regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/29 and 4/10, and at Charlotte on 11/7 and 3/28 ... The Hawks won the 2013-14 series 3-1 with Charlotte winning the final game of the series ... The Hawks are on a six-game road win streak against the Hornets ... The last time Atlanta defeated Charlotte was on 3/17/14 (97-83) in Charlotte ... The Hawks last defeated the Hornets at Philips Arena on 12/28/13 (118-116 OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 55-42 and are 32-18 at home.



Wednesday, Oct. 22, 2014 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to San Antonio to close out its preseason campaign ... The clubs will meet twice during the regular season – at Philips Arena on 3/22, and at San Antonio on 11/5 ... The Spurs swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 and own a seven-game regular season win streak against the Hawks ... San Antonio also owns a 16-game win streak at home against Atlanta ... The Hawks' last victory over the Spurs was at home on 3/21/10 (119-114 OT) ... The Hawks last defeated the Spurs in San Antonio on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 47-36 and are 30-12 in San Antonio.



Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2014 at Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to Toronto to open the regular season ... The two clubs will meet three more times, at Philips Arena on 11/26 and 2/20, and once more in Canada on 1/16 ... The 2013-14 series resulted in a 2-2 split with each team winning on their home floor twice ... Toronto owns a two-game win streak at home against the Hawks ... Atlanta's last victory over Toronto was at Philips Arena on 3/18/14 (118-113 OT) ... The Hawks' last victory against the Raptors in Toronto was on 3/27/13 (107-88) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 41-30 and is 19-16 in Toronto.

* As part of the NBA Cares initiative and the Hawks' Building Bridges through Basketball program, the Atlanta Hawks partnered with The Business, Engineering, Science, and Technology (B.E.S.T.) Academy High School and gave 50 students exclusive access to the organization's basketball operations department on 10/17. The students signed a one-day contract with the club and were addressed by Head Coach Mike Budenholzer and team executives. Students then met with the entire roster of Hawks players and staff to discuss off the court careers, and provide lessons in teamwork, decision making and dedication. The effort also supported the My Brother's Keeper initiative launched by the White House in 2014.

* For the second straight season, Kyle Korver is assisting the Atlanta Mission with a sock drive benefiting the homeless. Drop-off sites around the city for "Socktober" will be at Atlanta Mission (165 Ivan Allen Jr. Blvd., Atlanta, GA 30318) and Women's Premier Fitness (4961 Lower Roswell Rd., Marietta, GA 30068).

NEWS & NOTES

* The Atlanta Hawks and Grammy Award-winning superstar and Atlanta native Tip "T.I." Harris have teamed up to make Opening Night versus the Indiana Pacers on 11/1 a memorable event. T.I. will be performing at pregame, halftime and postgame. Everyone entering Philips arena before 7:00 p.m. will receive \$10 in Hawks Bucks and will be able to watch the first of three performances by T.I. in the special pregame concert. T.I. will also collaborate with PA Announcer Ryan Cameron to introduce the players before a new state-of-the-art introduction. All fans will also receive a free Grand Opening T-shirt courtesy of Kia Motors and there are other surprises in store. Ticket prices have been reduced to the most fan-friendly and affordable in Hawks history.

* The Atlanta Hawks will debut a state-of-the-art, 3D projection system when the team takes the floor for the regular season home opener versus the Indiana Pacers on 11/1. The system will allow the entire playing surface to be used as a video screen during pregame introductions and select halftime performances. In addition to the new 3D projection technology, the sound system and video board inside the arena are being upgraded, which will improve the gameday experience for fans by providing more robust and intelligible audio output than previously heard in Philips Arena.

* On 10/18, Atlanta outscored Detroit 25-15 in the third quarter. The Hawks shot .450 (9-20) from the field, .500 (3-6) from deep and .800 (4-5) from the charity stripe. The Hawks also held the Pistons to .300 (6-20) from the hardwood and .000 (0-7) from three-point range. Through five preseason games, the Hawks have outscored their opponents in every third quarter (138-87 total, 27.6-17.4 average).

* Former Hawks guard and current SportSouth studio analyst Mike "Stinger" Glenn has been elected to the Board of Directors of the National Basketball Retired Players Association.
