Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2014 at Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Toronto to open the regular season ... The two clubs will meet three more times, at Philips Arena on 11/26 and 2/20, and once more in Canada on 1/16 ... The 2013-14 series resulted in a 2-2 split with each team winning on their home floor twice ... Toronto owns a two-game win streak at home against the Hawks ... Atlanta's last victory over Toronto was at Philips Arena on 3/18/14 (118-113 OT) ... The Hawks' last victory against the Raptors in Toronto was on 3/27/13 (107-88) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 41-30 and is 19-16 in Toronto.



Saturday, Nov. 1, 2014 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta welcomes Indiana for the Hawks' home-opener and the first of three matchups between the two teams ... The clubs will play again in Atlanta on 1/21 and at Indiana on 12/8 ... The 2013-14 regular season series resulted in a 2-2 split with each team winning once at home and once on the road ... In the first round of the 2014 Playoffs, Atlanta fell to Indiana 4-3 ... During the regular season, the last time the Hawks defeated the Pacers was in Indiana on 4/6/14 (107-88) ... The most recent regular season victory Atlanta had against Indiana at Philips Arena was on 1/8/14 (97-87) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 94-79 and are 59-26 in Atlanta.



Wednesday, Nov. 5, 2014 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to San Antonio for the first of two matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more at Philips Arena on 3/22 ... The Spurs swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 and own a seven-game regular season win streak against the Hawks ... San Antonio also owns a 16-game win streak at home against Atlanta ... The Hawks' last victory over the Spurs was at home on 3/21/10 (119-114 OT) ... The Hawks last defeated the Spurs in San Antonio on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 47-36 and are 30-12 in San Antonio.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* The Hawks held the annual "Paint the Town" event on 10/24, visiting two local Dunkin' Donuts locations (1776 Howell Mill Rd. and 2420 Piedmont Ave.). Players, cheerleaders and mascots served patrons, posed for pictures and signed autographs, while passing out free t-shirts and other items. The Hawks organization picked up the tab for customers at each location during the visit.

NEWS & NOTES

* Mike Scott, Dennis Schröder and Shelvin Mack were the only Hawks players to appear in all seven preseason games. Scott averaged 12.7 ppg, 4.1 rpg, 2.0 apg and shot .569 from the field and .500 from three-point range in 20.4 mpg. Schröder averaged 8.6 ppg, 2.9 apg and 1.3 rpg and shot .513 from the hardwood and .500 from beyond the arc in 18.7 mpg. Mack averaged 6.6 ppg, 3.4 apg, 2.1 rpg and shot .415 from the floor and .478 from deep.

* The Hawks' final preseason leaders were: Kyle Korver (13.3 ppg), Jeff Teague (4.2 apg), Paul Millsap (5.0 rpg, 1.5 spg), Adreian Payne (1.2 bpg), John Jenkins (.652 FG%), and Mike Scott and Dennis Schröder (.500 3FG%).

* Four Hawks averaged at least 10 points per game during the preseason: Kyle Korver (13.3), Paul Millsap (13.0), Mike Scott (12.7), and Jeff Teague (11.8).

* On 10/21 the Hawks waived Jarell Eddie and Dexter Pittman. The Hawks' roster now stands at 15 players.

* In the Hawks' last preseason game on 10/22, Atlanta recorded a preseason-high 29 assists in a 117-107 victory over the defending NBA Champion San Antonio Spurs. During the preseason the Hawks averaged 25.4 assists per game which ranked second in the NBA (first in the Eastern Conference). During the 2013-14 season, Atlanta ranked second in the NBA (first in the Eastern Conference) in assists at 24.9 per game, dishing out at least 20 helpers 74 times, and 25-or-more on 41 occasions, including 13 30-assist nights (12-1). Last season, the Hawks recorded assists on 66.7% (2041-3061) of their made baskets, best in the league.

* "On The Court With Coach Bud" will begin on 10/30 as Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer joins SportsRadio 92-9 The Game's (FM) "Marc & Randy" show. The weekly coach's program can be heard each Thursday during the season at 7:22 a.m. Additionally, Hawks CEO Steve Koonin will be a weekly guest on 92-9 The Game's "Dukes & Bell" show each Friday at 4:42 p.m.

* On 10/31, Hawks CEO Steve Koonin will appear in studio with FOX-5's (WAGA) "Good Day Atlanta" program. He will be on the air in the eight o'clock hour to discuss the Hawks' upcoming season and all of the special events taking place on Opening Night at Philips Arena on 11/1.
