The Hawks host the Pelicans for the only game between the clubs in the preseason ... The teams will match-up twice during the 2014-15 regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/28 and at New Orleans on 2/2 ... The Pelicans swept the 2013-14 season series 2-0 ... New Orleans currently owns a three-game regular season winning streak against the Hawks, including three straight at Philips Arena ... Atlanta's most recent victory was a 95-86 triumph in New Orleans on 1/1/13 ... The last time Atlanta defeated New Orleans at home was on 11/14/09 (121-98) ... New Orleans leads the all-time series 16-11, with Atlanta holding a 7-6 advantage at home.

**Saturday, Oct. 11, 2014 at Memphis Grizzlies (8:00 p.m.)****TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast**

The Hawks head to Memphis for the only preseason match-up with the Grizzlies ... The clubs will meet twice during the 2014-15 regular season – at Philips Arena on 1/7 and at Memphis on 2/8 ... The Grizzlies swept the 2013-14 season series 2-0 and own a two-game regular season winning streak against the Hawks ... The Hawks last victory over the Grizzlies was a 103-92 home win on 2/6/13 ... The Hawks last defeated the Grizzlies in Memphis on 12/8/12 (93-83) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 23-13 and is 9-8 in Memphis.

**Tuesday, Oct. 14, 2014 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)****TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta travels to Miami for the only meeting against the Heat during the preseason ... The teams will meet four times during the 2014-15 regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/14 and 3/27, and at Miami on 12/3 and 2/28 ... The Hawks and Heat split the 2013-14 season series 2-2, with the home team winning each contest ... Atlanta has won two straight regular season games against Miami, with the Heat last recording a victory on 12/23/13 (121-119 OT) ... The Hawks last defeated the Heat in Miami on 1/2/12 (100-92) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 57-42 and are 37-13 at home.

**NEWS & NOTES**

\* The Atlanta Hawks will wear new home uniforms and play on a redesigned floor when the team hosts the New Orleans Pelicans in the club's first preseason game tonight (10/6) at Philips Arena. The new home uniform consists of a white jersey with "Atlanta" stitched in block-style blue letters with red trim and white shorts featuring the new secondary logo found at the bottom of the left leg, an updated version of the Pac-Man logo from years past. The red and white Pac-Man logo also appears at midcourt on the redesigned floor at Philips Arena, replacing the team's primary logo. The playing surface is now surrounded by an apron that has been painted Hawks blue. The apron displays "Atlanta Hawks" painted in white block-style letters with red trim along both baselines. The address for the team's website (Hawks.com), and Twitter and Instagram handle (@ATLHawks) are painted on the sideline opposite both team benches.

\* Atlanta Hawks individual game tickets for the 2014-15 season will go on sale to the general public at 10 a.m. on 10/8. The regular season home schedule tips off on 11/1 against Indiana in a rematch of playoff opponents from the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons. Prices for seats in select locations will be reduced by over 50% throughout Philips Arena for the season-opening contest while supplies last. Tickets are available for purchase with no ticketing fees by visiting [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com), by calling 1.866.715.1500, and at the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.

\* The Hawks and Philips Arena are celebrating the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Philips Arena and will construct a larger-than-life-size statue of Hawks' legend Dominique Wilkins. The statue, which is to be unveiled at a special ceremony at Philips Arena on 3/5/15, will be a symbol of the Hall of Famer's success as a player both on and off the court. Details of the statue and the ceremony will be released at a later date.

\* CBS RADIO's SportsRadio 92.9 The Game is the official flagship station of the Atlanta Hawks and will broadcast all Hawks regular season and postseason games. Steve Holman will return for his 30<sup>th</sup> year as the Voice of the Hawks. The station will also air pregame and postgame shows and create Hawks programming with on-air basketball talent including Rick Kamla and Dennis Scott.

\* The Fort Wayne Mad Ants will serve as the NBA Development League affiliate for the Hawks. The Mad Ants will also serve as the affiliate for the Brooklyn Nets, Charlotte Hornets, Chicago Bulls, Denver Nuggets, Indiana Pacers, Los Angeles Clippers, Milwaukee Bucks, Minnesota Timberwolves, New Orleans Pelicans, Portland Trail Blazers, Toronto Raptors, and Washington Wizards.
