Monday, Nov. 10, 2014 at New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to New York for the second-of-two consecutive contests against the Knicks ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0 after defeating New York 103-96 on Saturday at Philips Arena ... In the victory, Kyle Korver scored a game-high 27 points on six made three-pointers and Dennis Schröder, off the bench, scored a career-high 11 points. The teams will play once more in Atlanta on 4/13 ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Knicks in New York was on 11/16/13 (110-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 187-170 and are 60-89 on the road.



Wednesday, Nov. 12, 2014 vs. Utah Jazz (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Utah for the first-of-two games between the teams ... The clubs will meet in Utah on 1/2 ... The Hawks swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 ... Atlanta is on a six-game win streak overall and a three-game home win streak against Utah ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Jazz was on 3/10/14 (112-110) in Utah ... Atlanta's last victory over Utah at Philips Arena was on 12/20/13 (118-85) ... The Hawks trail the all-time series 48-45 and are 29-16 at home.



Friday, Nov. 14, 2014 vs. Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta welcomes Miami for the first-of-four-meetings between the clubs ... The teams will meet again at Philips Arena on 3/27, and at Miami on 12/3 and 2/28 ... The Hawks and Heat split the 2013-14 series 2-2, with the home team winning each contest ... Atlanta has won two straight regular season games against Miami, with the most recent victory coming on 4/12/14 (98-85) at Philips Arena ... The Heat lead the all-time series 57-42 and are 20-29 in Atlanta.



Saturday, Nov. 15, 2014 at Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta travels to Cleveland for the first-of-four-matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more in Cleveland on 12/17, and at Philips Arena on 12/30 and 3/6 ... The Hawks swept the 2013-14 series 3-0 ... Atlanta is on a four-game win streak overall and a three-game win streak at home against Cleveland ... The Hawks' most recent victory over the Cavaliers was on 4/4/14 (117-98) at Philips Arena ... Atlanta last defeated the Cavaliers in Cleveland on 12/26/13 (127-125 2OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 114-95 and are 46-60 on the road.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 11/5, former Hawks player Dikembe Mutombo was elected to the board of directors of the CDC Foundation. Established by Congress, the CDC Foundation helps the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) do more, faster, by forging public-private partnerships to support CDC's 24/7 work to save lives and protect people from health and safety threats.

* Hawks forward Paul Millsap met the two winners of the "Hang Out with Paul" sweepstakes following a Hawks practice at Philips Arena. Taylor Prezzano and Will Clifton won their experiences through the sweepstakes by calling **DUNK from their mobile phones. Millsap challenged Prezzano in a game of "HORSE", and played Clifton in NBA 2k15. Besides spending time with Millsap, both Prezzano and Clifton left with plenty of gifts. The "Hang Out with Paul" sweepstakes is a year-long promotion that began in April 2014.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks rank second in the NBA in assists at 24.8 per game, having dished out over 25 helpers in four-of-five games this year. Atlanta is recording assists on 65.6% (124-189) of their made baskets, best in the league.

* Atlanta ranks second in the NBA in 3FG% at .410 and 10th in FG% at .455. Three Hawks rank among the NBA leaders in FG%, led by Mike Scott at .559 (t16th), Kyle Korver is next at 24th (.531) with DeMarre Carroll at t29th (.523). Korver is also fourth in 3FG% (.613), and Scott is tied for 10th (.500).

* Kyle Korver scored a season-high 27 points and tied a season-high with six made three-pointers vs. New York on 11/8. Korver, for the first time in his career, has scored 20 or more points in three-of-the-first-five games of the season. Korver ranks second on the team at 16.6 points per game.

* Mike Scott is averaging 10.0 points in 14.7 minutes in four games off the bench, while hitting .559 FG% and .500 3FG%. Scott ranks tied for 16th in the NBA in FG% and is tied for 10th in 3FG%. He has scored in double-figures twice, including one 20-point game, and has hit at least one 3FG in all five contests.

* Dennis Schröder is averaging 10.0 points on .733 FG% (11-15), .333 3FG% (1-3) and .875 FT% (7-8) in 14.0 minutes over the last three games. He set a career-high in scoring (11) and steals (five) vs. the New York on 11/8, while he set a new career-high in free throws made (four) at Charlotte on 11/7. Schröder also ranks 17th in the league in steals per game (1.75).

* On 11/3, SportSouth announced that it will televise two additional regular season Hawks games. The schedule now includes the Utah Jazz on 12/2, and the Sacramento Kings on 3/16. After the first three games of the season, SportSouth ratings are up 44% over the first three games of the 2013-14 season. These additions bring SportSouth's game count to 77 for the 2014-15 season.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

November 10, 1969 – Lou Hudson ties Bob Pettit's franchise record by scoring 57 points against Chicago (in Auburn, AL). Hudson also set new team records for made field goals (25) and made field goals in one half (15) during the contest.
