UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Nov. 18, 2014 vs. Los Angeles Lakers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Lakers for the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The clubs will meet in Los Angeles on 3/15 ... The teams split the 2013-14 series 1-1, with each team winning at home ... Atlanta is on a two-game home win streak against Los Angeles, with L.A.'s last win at Philips Arena came on 3/8/11 (101-87) ... The Lakers lead the all-time series 183-136 and are 30-29 in Atlanta (since 1968-69).



Friday, Nov. 21, 2014 vs. Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes Detroit for the first-of-four games between the clubs ... The teams will meet again in the Motor City on 1/9 and 3/31, and once more at Philips Arena on 1/19 ... The teams split the 2013-14 series 2-2, with each team winning once at home and once on the road ... Detroit has won two straight regular season games against Atlanta, with the Hawks last recording a victory on 11/22/13 (96-89) in Detroit ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Pistons at Philips Arena was on 11/20/13 (93-85) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 171-162 and are 75-78 at home.



Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2014 at Washington Wizards (7:00 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Washington for the first-of-four-matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet at Philips Arena on 1/11 and 2/4, and once more in Washington on 4/12 ... The Wizards won the 2013-14 series 3-1 ... Washington is on a two-game win streak overall and a three-game win streak at home against the Hawks ... The most recent Atlanta victory in the series was on 12/13/13 (101-99 OT) at Philips Arena ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Wizards in Washington was on 12/18/12 (100-95 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 145-137 and are 46-89 on the road.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On Veterans Day (11/11), Hawks players, coaches and cheerleaders teamed with currently enlisted soldiers from Fort Gordon to visit veterans and their families at the Atlanta VA Medical Center, while passing out gifts, signing autographs, posing for pictures and more. The hospital visit honored the Commitment to Service initiative, introduced this season as part of the NBA Cares Hoops for Troops program.

* Hawks forward DeMarre Carroll will provide a Thanksgiving meal from 5-to-6 p.m. for residents of Genesis Shelter (173 Boulevard NE, Atlanta, GA 30312) today. Carroll and his fiancé Iesha will also provide diapers for children staying at the shelter, as well as t-shirts, photos and Hawks gear. Genesis Shelter is a facility for homeless newborn babies under six months of age and their families.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta has started the season 4-0 at home for the first time since 2009-10, when they began 7-0 at Philips Arena. In the four home victories, the Hawks are outscoring their opponents 104.8-97.0, while shooting .495 (149-301) from the field, .400 (36-90) from three-point range and .773 (85-110) from the free throw line. Atlanta is also outrebounding its opponents 40.0-37.5, while averaging 25.0 assists per game and 9.5 steals per game.

* Against Utah on 11/12, Paul Millsap posted his third double-double of the season with season-highs of 30 points and 17 rebounds, and also tallied three assists, two steals and two blocks. Millsap is the only player in the league to have at least those totals in a game this season.

* Kyle Korver recorded his first double-double as a Hawk (first since 11/3/07 vs. the Nets) with 17 points and 10 boards vs. Utah on 11/12.

* Last week, Kyle Korver moved into 19th on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list (currently 1538), passing former Hawks Assistant Coach Nick Van Exel (1528) and Mike Miller (1533).

* Dennis Schröder set or tied career-highs of 14 points, four FGM, six FTM and 28 minutes at New York on 11/10. He also recorded a career-high five steals vs. New York on 11/8, while tying his career-best with four FGM again vs. Miami on 11/14.

* Mike Muscala recorded 13 points, four rebounds and a career-high four blocks (5-8 FGs, 1-1 3FGs, 2-3 FTs) at Cleveland on 11/15, while knocking down the first three-pointer of his career.

* Jeff Teague went over the 4000 career point mark vs. Utah on 11/12, and Paul Millsap pulled down his 3000th career defensive rebound that same night. Al Horford topped 6000 career points at Cleveland on 11/15.

* On 11/15 at Cleveland, Wally Blase, worked his 1200th game as the Hawks' Head Athletic Trainer.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

November 23, 2001 – Shareef Abdur-Rahim scores 50 points against the Pistons in a 106-99 Hawks win at Philips Arena. It is tied for the eighth-highest single game scoring effort in team history and is the highest scoring game by a Hawks player at Philips Arena. Abdur-Rahim's 21 made field goals in that game is tied for fifth on the club's all-time list.
