Atlanta travels to Washington for the first-of-four-matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet at Philips Arena on 1/11 and 2/4, and once more in the nation's capital on 4/12 ... The Wizards won the 2013-14 series 3-1 ... Washington is on a two-game win streak overall and a three-game win streak at home against the Hawks ... The most recent Atlanta victory in the series was on 12/13/13 (101-99 OT) at Philips Arena ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Wizards in Washington was on 12/18/12 (100-95 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 145-137 and is 46-89 on the road.

**Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2014 vs. Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)****TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Toronto for the second contest between the clubs ... The teams will meet two more times, in Canada on 1/16, and at Philips Arena on 2/20 ... The Raptors lead season series 1-0 after defeating the Hawks on 10/29 (109-102) at the Air Canada Centre ... Amir Johnson (16 points/10 rebounds) and DeMar DeRozan (15 points/10 boards) had double-doubles for the Raptors ... Three Hawks players scored 20 points – Kyle Korver, Jeff Teague and Mike Scott ... Toronto has now won two straight against the Hawks overall (both at home) ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 113-96 home triumph on 3/18/14 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 41-31 and is 22-14 at home.

**Friday, Nov. 28, 2014 vs. New Orleans Pelicans (7:30 p.m.)****TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Pelicans for the first of two games between the clubs ... The teams finish the season series in New Orleans on 2/2 ... The Pelicans swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 ... New Orleans currently owns a three-game regular season win streak against the Hawks and has taken three straight at Philips Arena ... Atlanta's most recent victory was a 95-86 triumph in New Orleans on 1/1/13 ... The last time Atlanta defeated New Orleans at home was on 11/14/09 (121-98) ... The Pelicans lead the all-time series 16-11, with the Hawks holding a 7-6 advantage at Philips Arena.

**Saturday, Nov. 29, 2014 vs. Charlotte Hornets (7:30 p.m.)****TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Charlotte for the second matchup between the teams this year ... The clubs will meet again at Charlotte on 3/28 and once more at Philips Arena on 4/10 ... The Hornets took the first contest, at home on 11/7, 122-119 in double overtime ... Al Jefferson scored a game-high 34 points and grabbed nine boards, and Lance Stephenson (17 points, 13 rebounds) knocked down a buzzer beating three-pointer to win the game in the second overtime ... The Hawks had three players scored 20-or-more points: Al Horford (24), Jeff Teague (22) and Kyle Korver (20) ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Hornets was on 3/17/14 (97-83) in Charlotte ... The most recent victory at Philips Arena against the Hornets was on 12/28/13 (118-116 OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 55-43 and are 32-18 at home.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* Hawks players, coaches, cheerleaders and mascot Harry the Hawk surprised customers with games, gifts and groceries at Kroger in Atlanta's Edgewood Retail District on 11/20 as part of the NBA Cares Season of Giving. Hawks players and coaches assisted shoppers, worked in the deli and bagged groceries, while also passing out team gear, Kroger gift cards and more. The Hawks organization picked up the tab for purchases made by the shoppers during the visit.

* Al Horford surprised the boys and girls varsity basketball teams at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn on 11/19. Horford, a member of the NBA's FIT Team, addressed both teams about maintaining a healthy diet and led the squads through a series of drills and activities as an honorary assistant coach.

* DeMarre Carroll visited the Genesis Shelter on 11/17 to prepare meals and deliver clothing supplies for residents. Carroll and his fiancé Iesha Davis provided Thanksgiving dinner for roughly 20 families currently residing in the shelter. Residents also received t-shirts, diapers, socks and stuffed animals from the couple. Genesis Shelter, a key program of Our House Inc., is a shelter for homeless newborn babies under six months of age and their families.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks own a 5-1 record at Philips Arena this season, tied for the second-best home mark in the Eastern Conference. Atlanta is undefeated (4-0) at home against Eastern Conference foes.

* Kyle Korver is the only player in the NBA shooting at least .500 FG% (.500), .500 3FG% (.567) and .900 FT% (.920). He ranks third in the league in 3FG%, fifth in FT% and 31st in FG%.

* Jeff Teague scored a season-high 28 points (9-15 FGs – including career field goal no. 1,500) and added six assists vs. Detroit on 11/21. He is the third player in the Eastern Conference and fifth in the NBA to have tallied at least 20 points and five assists in a game five times this year.

* Last week, Kyle Korver moved into a tie for 18th with Tim Hardaway on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list (currently 1,542). Korver is four shy of tying Eddie Jones for 17th place.

* Jeff Teague has made 25 consecutive free throws (last miss 11/12 vs. Utah) and Kyle Korver has knocked down 20-in-a-row (last miss 11/7 at Charlotte). Teague's streak ties the longest of his career (also done in Feb. 2013).

* Thabo Sefolosha grabbed a career-high six offensive rebounds (nine total) vs. L.A. Lakers (11/18), also finishing with 10 points, two assists and one steal in 31 minutes.

* The Hawks assigned rookie Adreian Payne to Fort Wayne of the NBA Development League on 11/20 and recalled him on 11/23. In two games (one start) with the Mad Ants, he averaged 12.0 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 blocks in 31.0 minutes.

* Through the Hawks' first five contests at Philips Arena, Atlanta has seen a 12.6% increase in home attendance (total: 84,172; average: 16,834) compared to the first five games of the 2013-14 season (total 73,601; average 14,720). Through the season's first 10 games, the Hawks' television viewership numbers on SportSouth are up 30% compared to last year's regular season in the Atlanta market.
