**UPCOMING GAMES**



**Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2014 vs. Boston Celtics (7:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Celtics for the first-of-three-matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet in Boston on 1/14 and 2/11 ... The Hawks and Celtics split the 2013-14 series 2-2, with each team winning once at home and once on the road ... Atlanta won the last meeting, a 105-97 home decision on 4/9/14 ... The Celtics lead the all-time series 227-135, with the Hawks holding an 86-82 advantage at home.



**Wednesday, Dec. 3, 2014 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Miami for the first time in the second contest between the clubs this year ... The teams will meet again in Miami on 2/28 and once more in Atlanta on 3/27 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0, after defeating the Heat on 11/14 (114-103) at Philips Arena ... In the contest, Atlanta recorded a wire-to-wire victory and had eight players score in double figures, led by Al Horford and Paul Millsap, who each recorded 19 points ... For the Heat, Mario Chalmers tallied his first double-double of the season with game highs of 23 points and 11 assists ... Atlanta is currently on a three-game winning streak in the series, with Miami's last victory coming on 12/23/13 (121-119 OT) ... Miami has won five straight at home against Atlanta ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Heat in Miami was on 1/2/2012 (100-92) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 57-43 and are 37-13 in Miami.



**Friday, Dec. 5, 2014 at Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Brooklyn for the first-of-four matchups between the clubs ... The teams will play in Atlanta on 1/28 and 4/4, and will meet once more in Brooklyn on 4/8 ... The Nets won the 2013-14 series 2-1, including winning a game in London, England ... The Hawks took the last game, 93-88 on 4/9/14 at the Barclays Center ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 91-69 and are 34-47 on the road.



**Sunday, Dec. 7, 2014 vs. Denver Nuggets (3:30 p.m.)**  
TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Denver for the only time in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Denver on 3/11 ... The squads split the 2013-14 series with each team winning at home ... Atlanta won the last meeting 97-92 on 3/15/14 and owns a two game home winning streak ... The last time Denver defeated the Hawks in Atlanta was on 3/16/11 (102-87) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 42-37 and are 31-7 in Atlanta.

**COMMUNITY NEWS**

\* The Atlanta Hawks Foundation is dedicated to improving the quality of life of Georgia youth by inspiring them to develop a passion for learning and a commitment to physical fitness and recreation. By creating programs and forging partnerships with local agencies, the foundation continues to impact the lives of Georgia's young people. Since its inception in 1988, the foundation has contributed millions of dollars in monetary and in-kind donations.

**NEWS & NOTES**

\* Atlanta has scored 90-or-more points in every game (15), the longest streak of 90-plus scoring games to start a season since 1989-90 (34). The Hawks have also shot at least .500 FG% in each of the last three games (seven times total this year), the longest run since the last four games of 2011-12.

\* The Hawks are the best fourth quarter scoring team in the NBA, averaging 27.5 points. Atlanta has scored at least 25 fourth quarter points 12 times and 30-or-more points on five occasions. The Hawks are also averaging 52.0 second half points, which is tied for fourth in the league. Atlanta has topped the 50-point mark in the second half 11 times.

\* Kyle Korver is the only player (among qualifiers) in the NBA shooting at least .500 FG% (.509), .500 3FG% (.553) and .900 FT% (.943). He ranks second in the league in FT%, second in 3FG% and t21<sup>st</sup> in FG%.

\* Jeff Teague scored over 20 points in five consecutive contests (11/18-11/28), the longest streak of his career. During the five-game run, Teague averaged 25.8 points on .538 FG%, .500 3FG% and .951 FT%.

\* Jeff Teague tallied his 34<sup>th</sup> career point/assist double-double, and second of the season, with team highs of 24 points and 12 assists in 34 minutes vs. Toronto on 11/26. It was his 18<sup>th</sup> 20-point/10-assist game, tying him for sixth on the Hawks' all-time list with Joe Johnson.

\* Dennis Schröder has scored in double-figures seven times this season, including the last three games, after doing so twice during his rookie campaign. Among players from his 2013 draft class, he ranks first in FG% (.530) and FT% (.833), second in apg (2.8), third in A/TO ratio (2.05), tied for sixth in spg (0.9) and 10<sup>th</sup> in ppg (8.4) this season.

\* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Eddie Jones and moved into 17<sup>th</sup> on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list (currently 1,550). Korver also grabbed his 2,500<sup>th</sup> career rebound vs. New Orleans on 11/28.

\* Kyle Korver has made 30 consecutive free throws FTs (last miss 11/7 at Charlotte). Earlier this year, Jeff Teague made a career-high 27 straight FTs (11/12-11/25) and has currently made 14-in-a-row.

\* Kent Bazemore grabbed a career-high eight rebounds vs. Charlotte on 11/29 and tied a career-best with two blocks vs. New Orleans on 11/28.

\* The Hawks assigned guard John Jenkins and reassigned rookie forward Adreian Payne to Fort Wayne of the NBA Development League on 11/28. In two games with the Mad Ants, Jenkins is averaging 22.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals in 24.2 minutes (.545 FG%, .429 3FG%, 1.000 FT%). In four games (three starts) with the Mad Ants, Payne is averaging 13.0 points, 11.3 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 0.8 blocks in 32.9 minutes.
