**Monday, Dec. 22, 2014 at Dallas Mavericks (8:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Dallas for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play again in Atlanta on 2/25 ... The squads split the 2013-14 series with each team winning at home ... Atlanta won the last meeting 88-87 on 11/29/13 ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Mavericks in Dallas was on 2/11/13 (105-101) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 34-32 and are 15-18 in Dallas.



**Tuesday, Dec. 23, 2014 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (7:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Clippers for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The teams finish the season series in Los Angeles on 1/5 ... The clubs split the 2013-14 series with each team winning on its home floor ... L.A. took the last meeting (109-108) on 3/8/14 ... The Hawks own a five-game win streak against Los Angeles at Philips Arena ... The Clippers' last win in Atlanta came on 2/7/09 (121-97) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 73-39 and are 43-13 at home.



**Friday, Dec. 26, 2014 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)**  
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Milwaukee for the first-of-two consecutive contests against the Bucks ... The clubs will play again in Milwaukee on 12/27 and on 2/22, and once more at Philips Arena on 3/30 ... The Hawks swept the 2013-14 series 3-0 and have won the last seven games against Milwaukee, including five consecutive home victories ... Milwaukee's last win in the series was a 108-101 home decision on 3/27/12 ... The Bucks' most recent victory in Atlanta was on 11/10/10 (108-91) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 103-99 and are 66-35 at home.



**Saturday, Dec. 27, 2014 at Milwaukee Bucks (8:30 p.m.)**

The Hawks travel to Milwaukee for the second-of-two consecutive contests against the Bucks ... The clubs will meet again in Milwaukee on 2/22 and once more in Atlanta on 3/30 ... The Hawks swept the 2013-14 series 3-0, and have won the last seven games against Milwaukee, including four consecutive road victories ... The most recent Bucks victory against the Hawks was in Milwaukee on 3/27/12 (108-101) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 103-99 and is 36-62 on the road.

- \* On 12/23 when the Hawks take on the Clippers, Kent Bazemore will host a family from Hope Atlanta at the game, surprising them with gifts in a special meet & greet event for the holidays.
- \* The Atlanta Hawks Holiday Basketball Clinic will take place from 1-4 p.m. on the Philips Arena Practice Court prior to the Clippers game on 12/23. The clinic will be open to the public and consist of fundamental skills training, contests, games and special appearances from the Atlanta Hawks alumni. - \* On 12/24, DeMarre Carroll will make a surprise visit to a local YMCA to pass out gifts as part of a special holiday event. More information will be released soon.

**NEWS & NOTES**

- \* Atlanta is currently on a seven-game winning streak at Philips Arena, which began on 11/28. It is the most consecutive victories at home for the Hawks since taking 11-in-a-row from 11/25/10-1/8/11.
- \* Al Horford was named NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from 12/15-12/21. In winning the honor for the second time in his career, Horford led the Hawks to a perfect 3-0 week, averaging 18.3 points, 6.7 rebounds, 5.0 assists, 1.7 blocks and 1.0 steals in 32.0 minutes (.605 FG%, .750 FT%). He was the only NBA player to average at least 18.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists, 1.0 blocks and 1.0 steals, and shoot at least .600 FG% for the week.
- \* Atlanta set franchise records for 3FGM in a quarter and a half at Cleveland (12/17). The Hawks knocked down nine triples (9-11, .818 3FG%) in the second quarter and 12 in the first half (12-18, .667 3FG%). Atlanta finished 16-28 (.571) from distance on the night, a season-high for 3FGM. The previous record for 3FGM in a quarter was eight vs. Indiana (4/7/95), while the record for a half was 10 (three times).
- \* Kyle Korver has made 49 consecutive FTs (last miss at Charlotte on 11/7) setting a new franchise record and a new personal best. The previous Hawks' record for consecutive FTM was 47, set by Tom McMillen in 1978-79, and Korver's previous career-long streak was also 47 (in Feb./Mar. of 2007). The record breaking make came in the fourth quarter at Houston (12/20), which was his 1000<sup>th</sup> career FTM.
- \* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Jason Richardson and moved into 15<sup>th</sup> place on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list (currently 1,584).
- \* Shelvin Mack scored his 1000<sup>th</sup> career point and recorded career-highs of 24 points (7-8 FGs, 6-6 3FGs, 4-4 FTs) and six made 3FG's in 23 minutes at Cleveland on 12/17.
- \* Dennis Schröder made his first career start at Cleveland (12/17), finishing with 10 points, a career-high 10 assists (his first career double-double) and two rebounds in 22 minutes (4-6 FGs, 2-2 FTs). He is the fourth Hawk to record a point/assist double-double in his first start with the team, joining Bob Sura (3/12/04), Spud Webb (10/25/85) and Armond Hill (1/28/77).

\* On 12/22, Atlanta recalled Adreian Payne from Austin of the NBA Development League.

\* The Hawks-Bucks game on 12/26 features the "Chick-fil-A® Family Nights" promotion (four game tickets and four Combo Meal vouchers starting at \$48). The contest will also feature "Atlanta Hawks Youth Sports Days" promotion, where children can take photos at the OMG Booth, meet Harry the Hawk and Hawks Cheerleaders, and shoot postgame free throws on the court.
