**UPCOMING GAMES**



**Monday, Dec. 8, 2014 at Indiana Pacers (7:00 p.m.)**

**TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: V103 FM**

Atlanta travels to Indiana for the only time this year in the second contest between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Atlanta on 1/21 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0, after defeating the Pacers, in Atlanta's home-opener, on 11/1 (102-92) ... In the contest, Atlanta recorded a wire-to-wire victory and were led by Jeff Teague, who posted a game-high 25 points and team-high six assists ... For the Pacers, Chris Copeland scored a team-high 21 points, hitting six three-pointers ... Atlanta owns a two-game winning streak in the series, including the last contest in Indiana on 4/6/14 (107-88) ... The Pacers last victory against the Hawks was a 108-98 home decision on 2/18/14 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 95-79 (34-53 on the road).



**Wednesday, Dec. 10, 2014 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the 76ers for the first-of-four matchups between the teams ... The clubs will play in Philadelphia on 1/13 and 3/7 and will meet once more in Atlanta on 1/31 ... The Hawks swept the 2013-14 series 3-0, with the most recent victory at home on 3/31/14 (103-95) ... The Hawks are on a four-game winning streak against the 76ers with Philadelphia's last victory coming on 4/5/13 (101-90) at Philips Arena ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 162-159 and are 99-52 at home.



**Friday, Dec. 12, 2014 vs. Orlando Magic (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Orlando for the first-of-two consecutive contests against the Magic ... The clubs will play again in Orlando on 12/13 and on 3/25, and once more at Philips Arena on 2/27 ... The Hawks and Magic split the 2013-14 series 2-2 with each club winning once at home and once on the road ... Atlanta took the last meeting between the teams, a 112-109 road decision on 1/22/14, while Orlando won the last contest at Philips Arena on 11/26/13 (109-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 49-47, including a 31-16 home mark.



**Saturday, Dec. 13, 2014 at Orlando Magic (7:00 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Orlando for the second-of-two consecutive contests against the Magic ... The clubs will meet again in Atlanta on 2/27 and once more in Orlando on 3/25 ... The teams split the 2013-14 series 2-2 with each club winning once at home and once on the road ... Atlanta took the last meeting between the teams, a 112-109 road decision on 1/22/14 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 49-47, with the Magic holding a 31-18 edge in home games.

**COMMUNITY NEWS**

\* The Atlanta Hawks Foundation is dedicated to improving the quality of life of Georgia youth by inspiring them to develop a passion for learning and a commitment to physical fitness and recreation. **NEWS & NOTES**

\* Atlanta is currently on a season long six-game winning streak, and has moved into a first place tie with Washington in the Southeast Division. The last time the Hawks won six consecutive games was 11/16-11/28/12.

\* Kyle Korver is the only player (among qualifiers) in the NBA shooting at least .500 FG% (.526), .500 3FG% (.554) and .900 FT% (.951). He ranks first in the league in 3FG%, second in FT% and 20<sup>th</sup> in FG%.

\* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Glen Rice and moved into 16<sup>th</sup> on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list (currently 1,564). Korver made six three-pointers vs. Boston on 12/2, the third time this season he has made six threes in a game.

\* Kyle Korver has made 36 consecutive free throws (last miss 11/7 at Charlotte), while Jeff Teague has made 24-in-a-row (last miss 11/25 at Washington). Earlier this year, Teague made a career-high 27 straight FTs (11/12-11/25).

\* The Hawks made their largest comeback of the season (down 23 points) vs. Boston on 12/2, posting a 109-105 victory.

\* Al Horford recorded his 500<sup>th</sup> career block vs. Boston on 12/2. He ranks seventh in franchise history in blocked shots (currently 505).

\* Dennis Schröder had 16 points, three assists, one rebound and one steal in 22 minutes (6-9 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) at Miami on 12/3, setting or tying career-highs in points, FGM and 3FGM.

\* From 11/26-12/3 (five games), Atlanta averaged 108.2 points on .522 FG% and .859 FT%, scoring over 100 points and shooting at least .500 FG% and .800 FT% in each contest. The Hawks' streak of five straight games shooting at least .500 FG% and .800 FT% tied the longest in franchise history (3/18-3/24/82). The last time any NBA team had a streak that long was Boston with six-in-a-row from 3/11-3/21/90.

\* On 12/6, Atlanta assigned Mike Muscala to Fort Wayne of the NBA Development and recalled Adreian Payne. Muscala and John Jenkins (assigned on 11/28) were recalled from Fort Wayne on 12/8. In two stints with the Mad Ants this season, Payne has averaged 13.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.3 assists in 31.3 minutes in six games. Jenkins posted 19.4 points and 3.8 rebounds in 23.8 minutes in five games, while Muscala recorded 13.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 assists in 25.0 minutes in two contests.

\* Through 17 games, the Hawks' viewership numbers on SportSouth in the Atlanta market are up nearly 20% compared to last season at this date. The Hawks victory over the Celtics on 12/2 drew the highest average game rating of the season on SportSouth (2.0 rating).
