**UPCOMING GAMES**



**Monday, Jan. 19, 2015 vs. Detroit Pistons (2:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Detroit for the final time in the third-of-four-games between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the series 2-0, after winning at home on 11/21 (99-89) and defeating the Pistons in Detroit on 1/19 (106-103) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 21.0 points, 8.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds versus Detroit this season ... Greg Monroe is averaging 12.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists against the Hawks this year ... The teams will end the series in the Motor City on 3/31 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 173-162 (76-78 at home).



**Wednesday, Jan. 21, 2015 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks welcome the Pacers for the third-and-final-matchup of the season ... Atlanta leads the season series 2-0, after winning at Philips Arena on 11/1 (102-92) and defeating the Pacers in Indiana on 12/8 (108-92) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 23.0 points, 6.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals against the Pacers this season ... Luis Scola is averaging 12.0 points and 9.5 rebounds versus the Hawks this year ... The Hawks are on a three-game win streak against the Pacers overall, including the last meeting at Philips Arena ... Indiana's last win in the series was a 108-98 home decision on 2/18/14, while the last win at Philips Arena came on 2/4/14 (89-85) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 96-79, including a 60-26 record at home.



**Friday, Jan. 23, 2015 vs. Oklahoma City Thunder (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Thunder for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play again in Oklahoma City on 3/20 ... The Thunder swept the 2013-14 series 2-0, own a three-game win streak overall and have won two consecutive games at Philips Arena against the Hawks ... Atlanta's most recent victory against the Thunder was on 11/4/12 (104-95) in Oklahoma City, with the last home win coming on 3/3/12 (97-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 63-61, including a 38-25 home mark.



**Sunday, Jan. 25, 2015 vs. Minnesota Timberwolves (6:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

Atlanta welcomes the Timberwolves for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The teams will play again in Minnesota on 2/9 ... The teams split the 2013-14 series 1-1 (each winning at home), with Minnesota taking the most recent meeting on 3/26/14 (107-83) ... Atlanta owns an 11-game home winning streak against the T'Wolves, with Minnesota's last win at Philips Arena coming 11/20/02 (103-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 30-17, including a 19-5 home record.

\* The Hawks will celebrate the life and legacy of civil rights pioneer and Atlanta native Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. vs. Detroit on 1/19. Fans arriving early to Philips Arena will be treated to a unique video tribute honoring Dr. King, displayed across the playing surface via 3D projection. Following the video, an ensemble choir, led by former Hawk and current pastor John Battle and his wife, Grammy Award-winning singer Regina Belle, will join public address announcer Ryan Cameron for a one-of-a-kind version of player introductions. \* The Hawks hosted the Martin Luther King All-Star Classic in collaboration with the City of Atlanta's Department of Parks and Recreation. More than 60 Center of Hope youth basketball players and community coaches from Atlanta Parks and Recreation basketball leagues participated in a weekend of activities to celebrate the life and legacy of Dr. King. The celebration began with a luncheon at the Omni Hotel on 1/18, hosted by Rashan Ali and featuring team executives and representatives from Atlanta's Department of Parks and Recreation as speakers, along with former Hawks forward Duane Ferrell, and others. Following the luncheon, attendees toured the National Center for Civil and Human Rights with Hawks players Elton Brand and Kyle Korver. \* On 1/20, Al Horford will visit staff and students at Garden Hills Elementary. Horford will tour school facilities, participate in physical activities and speak with students to promote healthy living. Horford's visit is a reward for Garden Hills Elementary, which has created a healthier environment for its students through the Alliance for a Healthier Generation's Healthy Schools Program.

\* On 1/23, members of the Hawks' coaching staff will participate in the CNN Fit Nation event. More details about the event will be released this week.

**NEWS & NOTES**

\* Atlanta is on a 12-game winning streak, tying the second longest run in club history (12/8/68-1/3/69), and are 26-2 (.929) over the last 28 contests. The Hawks have also won 12 straight road games, a new franchise record.

\* Kyle Korver is shooting a league leading .536 3FG%, the highest percentage for any player through 41 team games in NBA history (according to the Elias Sports Bureau).

\* Al Horford notched his first career triple-double with 21 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high tying 10 assists in 29 minutes at Philadelphia (1/13). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he is the first NBA player this season to have a triple-double while playing fewer than 30 minutes, and he's the first Hawk to accomplish the feat since Dan Roundfield in 1983. Additionally, Shelvin Mack had 12 points and 10 assists that night for his first double-double of the year. The last time the Hawks had two players record 10-or-more assists in the same game was at Toronto on 4/2/08 (Joe Johnson and Mike Bibby).

\* Last week, Al Horford moved past Dikembe Mutombo into sixth place for defensive rebounds (currently 3108) and Alan Henderson for 10<sup>th</sup> in offensive rebounds (currently 1154) in club history.

\* Mike Muscala made his first NBA start at Philadelphia on 1/13, finishing with six points, a career-high nine rebounds and one steal in a career-best 26 minutes.

\* Pero Antic swiped a career-high four steals at Boston on 1/14. Dennis Schröder tied his career-best of two 3FGM twice – vs. Washington (1/11) and at Philadelphia (1/13). Jeff Teague tied a career-high with three blocked shots at Chicago (1/17).

\* On 1/12, the Hawks recalled Adreian Payne from Austin of the NBA Development League.

\* The Hawks-Pistons game on 1/19 and the Hawks-Timberwolves game on 1/25 feature "The Hudson Grille Full 48" promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$48).
