BROOKLYN

Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2015 vs. Brooklyn Nets (8:00 p.m.)

TV: ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Nets for the first time in the second-of-four contests between the teams ... The clubs will meet again at Philips Arena on 4/4 and once more in Brooklyn on 4/8 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0, after defeating the Nets 98-75 on 12/5 at the Barclays Center ... DeMarre Carroll recorded 18 points and six rebounds, and Paul Millsap tallied 17 points and nine boards for the Hawks ... Brook Lopez scored a game-high 20 points and grabbed seven rebounds for the Nets ... Brooklyn has won the last two contests at Philips Arena, with Atlanta's last home victory coming on 1/16/13 (109-95) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 92-69 and is 57-22 at home.



Friday, Jan. 30, 2015 vs. Portland Trail Blazers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Portland for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first meeting in Portland on 1/3 (115-107) ... Paul Millsap scored 27 points, Jeff Teague had 22 points and six assists, and Thabo Sefolosha recorded a double-double (13 points/12 rebounds) for the Hawks ... LaMarcus Aldridge recorded a double-double (30 points/12 rebounds) for the Trail Blazers ... Portland owns a two-game winning streak at Philips Arena, with Atlanta's last home victory coming on 1/18/12 (92-89) ... Portland leads the all-time series 53-52 with the Hawks holding a 33-18 advantage at home.



Saturday, Jan. 31, 2015 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks end their seven-game home-stand hosting the 76ers for the final time in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in Philadelphia on 3/7 ... Atlanta has won six consecutive games against the Sixers and leads the season series 2-0, after winning at Philips Arena on 12/10 (95-79) and in Philadelphia on 1/13 (105-87) ... Al Horford is averaging 16.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists against the 76ers this season ... Michael Carter-Williams is averaging 14.0 points, 9.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 1.5 blocks against the Hawks this year ... The most recent 76ers victory in the series was on 4/5/13 (101-90) at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 164-159, including a 100-52 home mark.

* On 1/23, the Hawks honored Coach Sharman White from Miller Grove High School with the Be Greater Atlanta Award. Coach White has led the Wolverines to the 5A State Basketball Championship six years running, and he was named USA TODAY Basketball Coach of the Year in 2014. Earlier this year, Miller Grove hosted the Hawks for this season's "Open Practice Event." Presenting Coach White with the award was former Hawks center Theo Ratliff.

* As part of 'NBA Fit Live Healthy Week', Elton Brand and the Hawks are teaming up with Autism Speaks to host a basketball clinic at Sensations TheraFun for youth with special needs on 1/26 (beginning at 3:45 p.m.). Sensations TheraFun is a sensory-based, indoor playground where children with special needs play in a safe, accepting environment. The NBA FIT program celebrates the values of the game – hard work, discipline, leadership and teamwork – and features some of the best athletes in the world encouraging fans of all ages to lead healthy, active lives.

* On 1/27, the Atlanta Hawks and Philips Arena will be recognized for sportsmanship, citizenship and significant economic impact to the City of Atlanta. CEO Steve Koonin, Hawks legend Dominique Wilkins, Head Coach Mike Budenholzer, Kyle Korver, Elton Brand and Hawks alumni will be at the State Capitol (206 Washington Street SW Atlanta, GA 30334) to meet with Governor Nathan Deal, the Georgia State Senate and the Georgia House of Representatives at 11:30 a.m.

* On 1/29, Al Horford, with special guest Kent Bazemore, will host a VIP movie event at Regal Atlantic Station 18 Theaters for underprivileged children. More details about the event will be released later this week.

NEWS & NOTES

* Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer and his staff will coach the Eastern Conference All-Star team at the 2015 NBA All-Star Game at Madison Square Garden in New York on 2/15. With the win over Indiana on 1/21, the Hawks clinched the East's best record through games of 2/1.

* Atlanta is on a 16-game winning streak, the longest run in club history (12/27/14-1/25/15), and the longest win streak ever by any professional sports team in Atlanta. The Hawks are 30-2 (.938) over the last 32 contests and have won 11 consecutive games against the Western Conference (extending the single-season franchise record).

* With the 112-100 victory over Minnesota on 1/25, Atlanta moved to 14-0 in the month of January, equaling the franchise record for wins in a single month (previously in Dec. 2014 and Jan. 1997).

* The Hawks recorded their sixth wire-to-wire victory of the season vs. Indiana on 1/21. In two previous seasons (2012-13 and 2013-14) combined, Atlanta posted four total wire-to-wire victories according to Elias Sports Bureau.

* For the second time this season (also vs. Washington on 1/11) and third time in team history, the Hawks tied a franchise record with eight different players hitting at least one 3FG vs. Indiana (1/21).

* Al Horford recorded 19 points (8-9 FG, 3-3 FT), six rebounds, four assists, two blocks and one steal vs. Minnesota on 1/25. Horford is the only player in the NBA to have at least that statistical line, while shooting .889 from the field, in a game since the 2012-13 season.

* On 1/19 vs. Detroit, Kyle Korver passed Dominique Wilkins for fifth on the Hawks' all-time list in 3FGM (currently at 509).

* On 1/23 vs. Oklahoma City, Al Horford tied Dikembe Mutombo for ninth in franchise history with his 181st double-double (14 points/12 rebounds). Also last week Horford moved into fifth (passing Dan Roundfield) on the Hawks' all-time defensive rebounds list (currently 3132) and 10th (passing Alan Henderson) on the offensive rebounds chart (currently 1161).

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 31, 2001 – Dikembe Mutombo pulls down 29 rebounds (12 offensive, 17 defensive) in the Hawks' 102-97 home win over Toronto. It is the third-best single game rebounding performance since the team moved to Atlanta in 1968.
