UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 5, 2015 at Los Angeles Clippers (10:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit the Clippers for the only time this season in the second-of-two contests between the teams ... Atlanta defeated Los Angeles (107-104) for the sixth straight time at home on 12/23 in the first meeting ... DeMarre Carroll recorded the first 20-point/10-rebound game of his career, with a career-high 25 points (career-high tying 5-6 3FGs) and 10 rebounds for the Hawks ... Blake Griffin (21 points/11 assists) and DeAndre Jordan (15 points/22 rebounds) each posted a double-double for the Clippers ... L.A. owns a three-game win streak at Staples Center against the Hawks, with Atlanta's most recent victory coming on 1/2/11 (107-98) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 74-39, including a 30-25 road mark.



Wednesday, Jan. 7, 2015 vs. Memphis Grizzlies (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Grizzlies for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The teams finish the season series in Memphis on 2/8 ... The Grizzlies swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 ... The Hawks last defeated the Grizzlies on 2/6/13 (103-92) at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 23-13, including a 14-5 mark at home.



Friday, Jan. 9, 2015 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Detroit for the first time in the second-of-four-games between the clubs ... The teams will meet again at Philips Arena on 1/19 and once more in the Motor City on 3/31 ... Atlanta leads the season series 1-0, after winning at home 99-89 on 11/21 ... Jeff Teague scored a game-high 28 points and added six assists, and Paul Millsap tallied a double-double (15 points/12 rebounds) for the Hawks ... Andre Drummond posted a double-double (13 points/16 rebounds) for the Pistons ... The Pistons took the last meeting in Detroit (115-107) on 2/21/14, while the Hawks' most recent road victory was on 11/22/13 (96-89) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 172-162 and is 82-73 on the road.



Sunday, Jan. 11, 2015 vs. Washington Wizards (3:00 p.m.)
TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Wizards for the first time in the second-of-four-matchups between the teams ... The clubs will meet again at Philips Arena on 2/4, and once more in the nation's capital on 4/12 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0, after defeating the Wizards at the Verizon Center 106-102 on 11/25 ... Jeff Teague recorded a game-high 28 points and Paul Millsap posted a double-double (17 points/11 rebounds) for Atlanta ... John Wall tallied a double-double (21 points/13 assists) for Washington ... The Wizards took the last meeting at Philips Arena (114-97) on 2/19/14, while the Hawks' most recent victory at home came on 12/13/13 (101-99 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 146-137, including a 92-43 mark at home.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* The Atlanta Hawks Foundation is dedicated to improving the quality of life of Georgia youth by inspiring them to develop a passion for learning and a commitment to physical fitness and recreation. NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are currently in first place in the Eastern Conference leading Chicago and Toronto by 1.5 games, while also leading the Southeast Division by 3.0 games over Washington. This is the latest in the season that Atlanta has held first place in the East since winning the conference in 1993-94.

* Head Coach Mike Budenholzer was named the NBA Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for the first time his career, after leading Atlanta to an NBA-best 14-2 record, which included identical 7-1 records at home and on the road, in Dec. For the month, Atlanta led the league in road winning percentage (.875), tied for the most road wins and led the Eastern Conference in home winning percentage.

* Jeff Teague was named the NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from 12/29/14-1/4/15. In winning the honor for the second time in his career, Teague led the Hawks to a perfect 3-0 week, averaging a conference-high 23.7 points, 8.3 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.7 steals in 35.3 minutes (.543 FG%, .783 FT%).

* The Hawks are on a seven-game overall winning streak against Western Conference foes, the team's longest single-season streak since an eight-game run from 10/31-11/18/97. Atlanta has also won four consecutive road games against the West (last four-game streak coming from 11/8-11/19/95).

* Paul Millsap recorded 26 points, nine rebounds, three assists, three blocks and two steals, while committing zero turnovers in 37 minutes vs. Cleveland on 12/30. He is one-of-two players in the NBA to have at least that line in a game this season, while committing zero turnovers (Anthony Davis has accomplished it twice).

* Jeff Teague tallied 23 points, 11 assists, five rebounds and three steals in 35 minutes vs. the Cavaliers on 12/30. It was his third double-double of the season (all 20-point/10-assist games). Teague has 19 career 20-point/10-assist games to his credit and moved past Joe Johnson for sixth all-time in Hawks history.

* Thabo Sefolosha recorded his first double-double of the season with season-highs of 13 points and 12 rebounds in 28 minutes at Portland on 1/3.

* On 12/30, John Jenkins was assigned to the Idaho Stampede and Adreian Payne was assigned to the Austin Spurs of the NBA Developmental League, both pursuant to the flexible assignment rule.

* The Hawks-Grizzlies game on 1/7 features the "Swipe Right Night" promotion (a \$15 ticket includes a \$10 food and beverage credit). The Hawks-Wizards game on 1/11 features the "The Hudson Grille Full 48" promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$48).
