UPCOMING GAMES



Friday, Feb. 20, 2015 vs. Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Raptors for the second time this season in the fourth-and-final contest between the clubs ... Toronto leads the season series 2-1, after winning the first meeting at home on 10/29 (109-102) and the second contest in Atlanta on 11/26 (126-115) ... Atlanta won the last game in Toronto on 1/16 (110-89) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 19.0 points, 9.7 assists, 3.7 rebounds and 2.0 steals against the Raptors this season ... DeMar DeRozan is averaging 22.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, 2.7 steals and 2.3 assists against the Hawks this year ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Raptors at Philips Arena was on 3/18/14 (118-113 OT) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 42-32, including a 22-15 home mark.



Sunday, Feb. 22, 2015 at Milwaukee Bucks (3:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Milwaukee for the final time in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more at Philips Arena on 3/30 ... The season series is split 1-1, with the Bucks winning the first meeting in Atlanta on 12/26 (107-77) and the Hawks winning the second contest in Milwaukee on 12/27 (90-85) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 19.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals against the Bucks this season ... Jared Dudley is averaging 16.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.0 steals and 2.5 assists against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta is on a five-game winning streak against the Bucks in Milwaukee ... The Bucks' last home victory in the series was on 3/27/12 (108-101) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 104-100 and are 37-62 on the road.



Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2015 vs. Dallas Mavericks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts the Mavericks for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first meeting in Dallas on 12/22 (105-102) ... Dennis Schröder scored a game-high 22 points and added six assists, and Paul Millsap posted a double-double (13 points/12 rebounds) for the Hawks ... Monta Ellis scored 18 points and Rajon Rondo recorded a double-double (13 points/11 assists) for Dallas ... The Mavericks' most recent victory in Atlanta was on 3/18/13 (127-113) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 35-32, including a 19-14 home mark.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* Each February, the Atlanta Hawks and Philips Arena celebrate 'Black History Month' by honoring influential African-Americans who have made significant contributions to the Atlanta community and beyond. Each game during the month will feature a vignette highlighting key figures in the civil rights movement. All five honorees will gather for a presentation at halftime of the Hawks vs. Raptors contest on 2/20. Honorees include C.T. Vivian, Juanita Abernathy, Rev. Joseph Lowery, Congressman John Lewis, and Ambassador Andrew Young.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 2/15, four Hawks participated for the Eastern Conference team, which was led by Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer and his staff, in the NBA All-Star Game at Madison Square Garden. Kyle Korver (first career All-Star appearance) recorded 21 points (7-12 3FG), two assists and one rebound in 16 minutes. Jeff Teague (first career All-Star appearance) posted 14 points (6-9 FG, 2-2 3FG), two assists, two steals and one rebound in 13 minutes. Al Horford (third career All-Star appearance) tallied eight points (4-6 FG), seven rebounds and two assists in 14 minutes. Paul Millsap (second career/consecutive All-Star appearance) recorded five points, six boards, three assists and two steals in 16 minutes. It was the first time in franchise history Atlanta has had four All-Stars, and the eighth time in NBA history.

* On 2/14, Dominique Wilkins, Chris Bosh and Swin Cash won their third consecutive 'Degree Shooting Stars Challenge', as Paul Millsap, Scottie Pippen and Elena Delle Donne were knocked out in the first round. In the 'Taco Bell Skills Challenge', Jeff Teague lost in the semifinals to eventual champion Patrick Beverley of the Houston Rockets, and Dennis Schröder lost in the first round to Kyle Lowry of the Toronto Raptors. In the 'Foot Locker Three-Point Contest', Kyle Korver was eliminated in the first round with a score of 18.

* On 2/13, Dennis Schröder recorded 13 points (6-11 FG), a game-high nine assists and three steals in 23 minutes for the World Team as they defeated the USA Team (121-112) in the 'BBVA Compass Rising Stars Challenge' at the Barclays Center. The World Team was coached by the Hawks' staff, led by Kenny Atkinson.

* On 2/10, the Hawks acquired a future first round pick from the Minnesota Timberwolves in exchange for forward/center Adreian Payne.

* Atlanta dropped an 89-88 decision at Boston on 2/11, snapping a franchise record 13-game winning streak against Eastern Conference foes (12/27-2/4).

* DeMarre Carroll posted 26 points (9-13 FG, 2-3 3FG, 6-6 FT), four rebounds and three steals in 34 minutes at Minnesota on 2/9, setting or tying career-highs in points and FGM.

* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Jason Terry and moved into 10th in franchise history in three point field goals made in a single season (currently 161). Korver has also made at least one 3FG in 41 consecutive games, the second-longest streak of his career. He previously set an NBA record by making a three-pointer in 127 straight contests from 11/4/12-3/2/14.

* The Hawks' win over the Golden State Warriors on 2/6 generated a 6.8 household (HH) rating in the Atlanta DMA on SportSouth, the highest-rated Hawks game – regular season or postseason – ever on the network. Through 48 televised games, Hawks viewership in the Atlanta metropolitan area is up 82% compared to last seasons' first 48 games on SportSouth.
