**UPCOMING GAMES**



**Wednesday, Feb. 25, 2015 vs. Dallas Mavericks (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Dallas for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first contest in Dallas on 12/22 (105-102) ... Dennis Schröder scored a game-high 22 points and added six assists, and Paul Millsap posted a double-double (13 points/12 rebounds) ... Monta Ellis scored 18 points and Rajon Rondo recorded a double-double (13 points/11 assists) for the Mavs ... Atlanta has won two straight overall in the series, including the last meeting at Philips Arena on 11/29/13 (88-87) ... The Mavericks' most recent win against the Hawks was a 118-109 home triumph on 10/30/13, while their last victory at Philips Arena came on 3/18/13 (127-113) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 35-32, including a 19-14 home mark.



**Friday, Feb. 27, 2015 vs. Orlando Magic (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Magic for the final time in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in Orlando on 3/25 ... The season series is split 1-1, with each team winning on its home floor ... The Hawks won the first match-up on 12/12 (87-81) and the Magic won the second game on 12/13 (100-99) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 18.5 points, 6.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals against the Magic this season ... Evan Fournier is averaging 18.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists against the Hawks this year ... The last time the Magic won in Atlanta was on 11/26/13 (109-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 50-48, including a 32-16 home mark.



**Saturday, Feb. 28, 2015 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Miami for the final time in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more at Philips Arena on 3/27 ... The Hawks lead the season series 2-0, after winning at home on 11/14 (114-103) and in Miami on 12/3 (112-102) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals against the Heat this season ... Chris Bosh is averaging 23.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won four straight overall against Miami, including three-in-a-row at home ... The most recent Heat victory against the Hawks came in Miami on 12/23/13 (121-119 OT) ... Miami leads the all-time series 57-44 and is 37-14 at home.

**COMMUNITY NEWS**

\* Each February, the Atlanta Hawks and Philips Arena celebrate 'Black History Month' by honoring influential African-Americans who have made significant contributions to the Atlanta community and beyond. At the 2/20 game vs. Toronto, five Civil Rights heroes, which included C.T. Vivian, Juanita Abernathy, Rev. Joseph Lowery, Congressman John Lewis and Ambassador Andrew Young, were honored at halftime. Visit [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com) for more information.

\* On 2/20, following the conclusion of the game against Raptors, the Hawks held a screening of Paramount Pictures' motion picture *Selma*. Fans that stayed to watch the film witnessed the movie displayed on the playing surface via in-arena projection system.

**NEWS & NOTES**

\* Atlanta has posted a 19-8 record away from home this year, which is tied for the best road mark in the NBA with Golden State. The 19 road wins are also tied for the most in the league with Chicago, Golden State and Dallas.

\* The Hawks are one-of-three teams (Golden State and Houston) in the NBA to not have had at least a three-game losing streak this season.

\* The Hawks are third in the NBA in fewest points allowed (96.8) and are one-of-two teams (Portland) to rank in the Top 10 in both scoring (seventh, 102.9) and fewest points allowed per game.

\* Atlanta is 38-2 on the season when holding a double-digit lead at any juncture of a game.

\* The Hawks have had home sellout crowds in 13-of-the-last-15 games and now have 14 sellouts on the year. The last time Atlanta had as many capacity crowds came in 1996-97 at the Omni (17).

\* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Jamal Crawford (163 in 2009-10) and tied Mike Bibby (167 in 2008-09) for eighth on the franchise's all-time single season chart in made three-pointers. Korver already holds the fourth (189 in 2012-13) and fifth (185 in 2013-14) spots on the list. He has also made at least one 3FG in 43 consecutive games, the second-longest streak of his career. Korver set an NBA record by making a three-pointer in 127 straight contests from 11/4/12-3/2/14.

\* Jeff Teague has scored in double-figures a career-best 27 consecutive games and 44 times overall on the season.

\* Atlanta has hit 10-plus 3FGs in a game 33 times this year, two away from tying the franchise record of 35 set last season.

\* DeMarre Carroll tied a career-high with three blocked shots vs. Toronto on 2/20, while Dennis Schröder tied his career-best with two 3FGM that same night. Kent Bazemore tied his career-high with two blocks at Milwaukee on 2/22.
