**UPCOMING GAMES**



**Monday, Mar. 16, 2015 at Sacramento Kings (10:00 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Sacramento for the only time this year in the second-of-two contests between the teams ... The Hawks won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 3/9 (130-105) ... DeMarre Carroll and Kyle Korver scored 20 points apiece for Atlanta, and Jeff Teague had a double-double (18 points/13 assists) ... Sacramento's Rudy Gay led all scorers with 23 points and DeMarcus Cousins posted a double-double (12 points/14 rebounds) ... The Hawks have won 13 consecutive games, including six straight in Sacramento, against the Kings ... The most recent Kings victory was a 119-107 home triumph on 2/20/08 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 155-152 (44-71 on the road).



**Wednesday, Mar. 18, 2015 at Golden State Warriors (10:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM/ESPN Radio**

The Hawks continue their six-game road trip by visiting Oakland for the only time this year in the second-of-two games against Golden State ... The Hawks won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 2/6 (124-116) ... Jeff Teague scored 23 points, and Al Horford (12 points/14 rebounds) recorded a double-double for Atlanta ... Klay Thompson scored 29 points, and Draymond Green (12 points/20 rebounds) posted a double-double for Golden State ... The Hawks have lost two consecutive road games against the Warriors, with the most recent victory in Oakland coming on 2/25/11 (95-79) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 142-139, and is 44-76 on the road.



**Friday, Mar. 20, 2015 at Oklahoma City Thunder (8:00 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta ends its six-game road trip by travelling to Oklahoma City for the only time this year in the second-of-two meetings between the teams ... The Hawks won the first contest at Philips Arena on 1/23/15 (103-93) ... Paul Millsap (22 points/10 rebounds) and Al Horford (14 points/12 rebounds) each recorded a double-double for the Hawks ... Russell Westbrook (22 points/11 assists) and Serge Ibaka (13 points/10 rebounds) posted double-doubles for Oklahoma City ... The Thunder took the last meeting in Oklahoma City on 1/27/14 (111-109), while Atlanta's last road win in the series came on 11/4/12 (104-95) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 64-61 and are 24-36 on the road.



**Sunday, Mar. 22, 2015 vs. San Antonio Spurs (3:00 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

The Hawks host the Spurs for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Spurs won the first meeting in San Antonio on 11/5 (94-92) ... Paul Millsap recorded 17 points, five steals, three assists and two blocks for the Hawks ... Tim Duncan (17 points/13 rebounds) recorded a double-double for the Spurs ... San Antonio owns an eight-game win streak against the Hawks, including three consecutive victories at Philips Arena ... The most recent Hawks victory against the Spurs came on 3/21/10 (119-114 OT) in Atlanta ... San Antonio leads the all-time series 48-36, while the Hawks hold a 24-17 advantage at home.

**NEWS & NOTES**

\* With the win over Sacramento on 3/9, Atlanta hit 50-wins for the 10<sup>th</sup> time since 1968-69 and became the first team in the league this season to reach 50 victories. Prior to this year, the Hawks had never been the first club to reach 50 wins.

\* The Hawks have tied a franchise record for road victories in a season with 22 (set in 1986-87). Atlanta's 22-10 record away from home this year is the best road mark in the NBA and the 22 road wins are the most in the Eastern Conference (second in the NBA).

\* The Hawks set a franchise record with 20 3FGM vs. Sacramento on 3/9, while tying the mark for 3FGM in a half (12). That same night Atlanta scored a season-best 130 points, set a Philips Arena record with 53 FGM and dished out an NBA season-high 42 assists (also an arena record).

\* Atlanta is the only team in the NBA ranking in the Top 5 in FG%, 3FG% and FT%. On the season, Atlanta is third in FG% (.467), second in 3FG% (.383) and fourth in FT% (.777).

\* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Kobe Bryant for 12<sup>th</sup> in NBA history in 3FGM (currently 1700). Korver has made 192 3FGs this year, fourth on the Hawks' all-time single season chart. He hit at least one 3FG in 51 consecutive games (11/26/14-3/13/15), the second-longest run of his career behind his NBA record streak of 127 straight contests from 11/4/12-3/2/14.

\* On 3/9 vs. Sacramento, Jeff Teague recorded the 41<sup>st</sup> point/assist double-double (18 points/13 assists) of his career, tying Jason Terry and Eddie Johnson for fourth in franchise history.

\* Dennis Schröder recorded his third career double-double with 24 points (7-16 FGs, 1-5 3FGs, 9-11 FTs) and 10 assists in 38 minutes at LAL on 3/15, setting or tying career-highs in points, FTM, assists and minutes. Schröder has scored in double-figures in eight consecutive outings (the longest streak of his career).

\* Several other Hawks set or tied single game career-highs last week: Pero Antic with six FTM (6-6) at Denver on 3/11; Kent Bazemore with nine rebounds and two blocked shots at L.A. Lakers on 3/15; Al Horford with five steals at L.A. Lakers on 3/15; Mike Scott with five assists vs. Sacramento on 3/9.

\* Kyle Korver (currently at 3010 FGM) made his 3000<sup>th</sup> field goal at Denver on 3/11.

\* The Hawks signed five-year NBA veteran forward Austin Daye to a 10-day contract on 3/15. Daye appeared in 26 games (four starts) earlier this season with San Antonio, averaging 4.0 points and 2.3 rebounds in 10.3 minutes. In 10 games this year with Erie of the NBA Development League, Daye averaged 16.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.1 blocks in 28.5 minutes.

\* In addition to SportSouth and 92-9 The Game (92.9 FM), the Atlanta at Golden State contest on 3/18 will be broadcast on ESPN and ESPN radio.
