UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Mar. 3, 2015 vs. Houston Rockets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Houston for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first meeting in Houston on 12/20 (104-97) ... Kyle Korver scored a game-high 22 points (7-12 FGs, 4-8 3FGs), and Al Horford recorded 14 points, eight rebounds, five assists and three blocks for the Hawks ... Dwight Howard (19 points/11 rebounds), and James Harden (18 points/14 assists) recorded double-doubles for Houston ... Atlanta has won two straight overall against the Rockets, including the last meeting at Philips Arena on 1/10/14 (83-80) ... Houston's last win in the series was a 113-84 home decision on 11/27/13, with the last win at Philips Arena coming on 11/2/12 (109-102) ... Houston leads the all-time series 74-71, with the Hawks holding a 50-22 advantage at home.



Friday, Mar. 6, 2015 vs. Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

The Hawks host the Cavaliers for the second time this season in the fourth-and-final contest between the teams ... Atlanta leads the season series 2-1 ... Cleveland won the first contest at home on 11/15 (127-94), while Atlanta won the second game at Quicken Loans Arena on 12/17 (127-98) and the most recent matchup at Philips Arena on 12/30 (109-101) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 18.7 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 1.3 steals and 1.3 blocks against the Cavaliers this season ... Kyrie Irving is averaging 21.3 points, 6.7 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won four consecutive games at home against the Cavs, with Cleveland's last victory at Philips Arena coming on 11/30/12 (113-111) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 116-96, including a 69-35 home mark.



Saturday, Mar. 7, 2015 at Philadelphia 76ers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Philadelphia for the second time in the fourth-and-final game this year between the clubs ... Atlanta leads the season series 3-0, after winning at home on 12/10 (95-79), at Philadelphia on 1/13 (105-87) and at Philips Arena on 1/31 (91-85) ... Al Horford is averaging 18.3 points, 9.3 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.3 blocks against the 76ers this season ... Luc Mbah a Moute is averaging 10.7 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.7 steals against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won seven consecutive games against the Sixers, including three straight in Philadelphia ... The 76ers most recent victory came on 4/5/13 (101-90) at Philips Arena and the last home win was a 99-80 decision on 12/21/12 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 165-159 (52-90 on the road).

* On 3/5, Hall of Famer and Hawks legend Dominique Wilkins will be honored in a private ceremony with the unveiling of a larger-than-life size statue. The 13.5-foot-tall, 18,500-pound granite sculpture will feature Wilkins in one of his signature explosive poses. * On 3/5, Al Horford will visit Fulton County's Campbell Elementary to promote healthy living. Horford will tour school facilities before surprising kindergartners and first graders to lead them in a "Brain Breaks" physical activity, and speaking with hundreds of third, fourth, and fifth graders. Horford's visit is a reward for Campbell Elementary, which has created a healthier environment for its students through the Alliance for a Healthier Generation's Healthy Schools Program. NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are currently on a four-game winning streak, the fifth time this year the club has won at least four consecutive games.

* Atlanta is one-of-three teams (Milwaukee and Phoenix) to rank among the Top 10 in the NBA in FG%, 3FG% and FT%. The Hawks are fourth in FG% (.466), second in 3FG% (.384) and sixth in FT% (.775).

* Atlanta has a 12-3 record this season in the second game of a back-to-back, which is the second best mark in the league (tops in the Eastern Conference) behind Golden State (10-2). The 12 wins are also the most in the NBA.

* Atlanta has hit 10-plus 3FGs in a game 36 times this year, breaking the franchise record of 35 set last season. The Hawks have knocked down double-digit 3FGs in each of the last three games, connecting on 37-91 (.407) from deep.

* For the third time this year (also vs. Washington on 1/11 and vs. Indiana on 1/21) and fourth time in team history, the Hawks had eight players hit at least one 3FG vs. Orlando (2/27).

* Last week, Kyle Korver (175 3FGM) moved into sixth on the franchise's all-time single season list for 3FGM, passing Mike Bibby (167 in 2008-09), Joe Johnson (169 in 2007-08) and Jason Terry (172 2001-02). Korver already holds the fourth (189 in 2012-13) and fifth (185 in 2013-14) spots on the list. He has hit at least one 3FG in 46 consecutive games, the second-longest run of his career behind his NBA record streak of 127 straight contests from 11/4/12-3/2/14.

* Dennis Schröder made his sixth start of the season at Miami (2/28) and recorded the second double-double of his career (16 points/10 assists) in 35 minutes, setting or tying career-highs in minutes and assists. Schröder is averaging 12.3 points, 7.0 assists and 3.0 rebounds in 27.8 minutes (.452 FG%, .429 3FG%, .682 FT%) as a starter (Hawks are 6-0).

* John Jenkins set a career-high with seven rebounds and tied a career-best with three 3FGM at Miami (2/28), while Mike Muscala tied his career-high of four blocks the same night. Dennis Schröder set a career-high with three 3FGM vs. Dallas (2/25). Kent Bazemore tied his career-best of two blocked shots vs. Orlando (2/27).

* Paul Millsap (currently at 9025 points) scored his 9000th career-point vs. Orlando on 2/27.

* On 3/1, Mike Muscala was assigned to the Fort Wayne Mad Ants of the NBA Developmental League and was recalled on 3/2. In six games (over five stints) with the Mad Ants this season, Muscala is averaging 12.8 points, 8.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.0 blocks in 29.9 minutes (.475 FG%, .857 FT%).
