UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Mar. 30, 2015 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Milwaukee for the second time in the fourth-and-final game this year between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the season series 2-1, with the visitor winning each contest ... The Bucks won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 12/26 (107-77) and the Hawks won the next two games in Milwaukee on 12/27 (90-85) and on 2/22 (97-86) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 20.7 points, 11.7 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks against the Bucks this season, while Khris Middleton is putting up 14.0 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals against the Hawks ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Bucks at Philips Arena was on 3/13/14 (102-97) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 105-100 and is 66-36 at home.



Tuesday, Mar. 31, 2015 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Detroit for the second time in the fourth-and-final meeting this season between the teams this year ... Atlanta leads the season series 3-0, after winning at home on 11/21 (99-89), in Detroit on 1/9 (106-103) and once more at Philips Arena on 1/19 (93-82) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 17.3 points, 8.0 assists and 3.0 rebounds against the Pistons this season ... Greg Monroe is averaging 13.7 points, 13.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals against the Hawks this year ... The last time the Pistons defeated the Hawks was in Atlanta on 4/8/14 (102-95) ... The most recent Pistons victory against the Hawks in Detroit came on 2/21/14 (115-107) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 174-162 and is 83-73 on the road.



Friday, Apr. 4, 2015 vs. Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Nets for the final time in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play once more in Brooklyn on 4/8 ... The Hawks lead the season series 2-0, after winning at the Barclays Center on 12/5 (98-75) and at Philips Arena on 1/28 (113-102) ... Paul Millsap is averaging 22.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals versus Brooklyn this season ... Joe Johnson is averaging 19.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 blocks against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won three straight overall in the series, including the last contest at Philips Arena ... The Nets' most recent victory against the Hawks came on 1/16/14 (127-110) in London (United Kingdom) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 93-69 and is 58-22 at home.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 4/1, the Hawks will hold a skills clinic for the students at Ron Clark Academy. The Atlanta Hawks Foundation provided a \$25,000 grant to the school to fund locker rooms in their newly built gymnasium. Pero Antic, Mike Scott and Jeff Teague will be on-site to speak with the students following the clinic. More information will be released this week.

* The Hawks will be recognizing 'World Autism Awareness Day' against Brooklyn on 4/4. More details about the day's events will be released this week.

* On 4/4 vs. Brooklyn, the Hawks will honor Scott Gross, Program Director of *The Wonder League Sports Academy* with the 'Be Greater Atlanta Award'. *The Wonder League* is an adaptive sports league for children facing sensory and physical challenges.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta has clinched the first seed in the Eastern Conference for the first time since 1993-94. The Hawks have also won the Southeast Division title, the first division crown for the franchise since taking the Central in 1993-94.

* The Hawks recorded their eighth wire-to-wire victory of the season versus Miami on 3/25. In 2012-13 and 2013-14 combined, Atlanta had four total wire-to-wire victories according to Elias Sports Bureau.

* Last week, Kyle Korver (199 3FGM) tied Mookie Blaylock (1994-95) for third on the franchise's all-time single season list for 3FGM. Korver also holds the fourth (189 in 2012-13) and fifth (185 in 2013-14) spots on the list.

* Mike Muscala recorded 18 points, 10 rebounds, four assists, two blocks and one steal in 34 minutes (7-13 FGs, 2-2 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) at Charlotte on 3/28, setting career-highs in points, rebounds, assists, FGM, 3FGM and minutes, while posting his first NBA double-double.

* Dennis Schröder tallied 17 points, 11 assists and four rebounds (5-12 FGs, 3-3 3FGs, 4-4 FTs) at Charlotte on 3/28, recording his fifth double-double of the season and tying career-highs in assists and 3FGM. Schröder also had 11 assists the previous night vs. Miami (3/27).

* John Jenkins posted 16 points, three assists, two steals and one rebound (6-12 FGs, 3-6 3FGs, 1-2 FTs) at Charlotte on 3/28, tying career-highs in 3FGM and steals.

* Thabo Sefolosha returned to the court on 3/25 at Orlando after missing 23 games due to a right calf strain (1/31-3/22). He finished the contest with one steal in seven minutes.

* The Hawks signed forward Austin Daye to a second consecutive 10-day contract on 3/25. In four games played for Atlanta this season, Daye is averaging 3.0 ppg and 1.5 rpg in 6.4 mpg, and shooting .455 FG% (5-11) and .400 3FG% (2-5).

* The Hawks-Bucks game on 3/30 features the "The Hudson Grille Full 48" promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$48).
