UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Mar. 9, 2015 vs. Sacramento Kings (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Kings for the only time in the first-of-two contests between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Sacramento on 3/16 ... Atlanta swept the 2013-14 series 2-0 and has won 12 consecutive games, including seven straight at home, against Sacramento ... The most recent Kings victory was on 2/20/08 (119-107) at home ... The last time the Kings defeated the Hawks at Philips Arena was on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 154-152 and are 85-29 at home.



Wednesday, Mar. 11, 2015 at Denver Nuggets (9:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Denver for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 12/7 (96-84) ... Paul Millsap recorded 23 points, four steals, two rebounds and two assists for Atlanta ... Wilson Chandler (29 points/10 rebounds) and Timofey Mozgov (14 points/11 rebounds) each recorded a double-double for Denver ... The Nuggets have won seven consecutive home games against Atlanta, with the Hawks' last road victory coming on 12/6/06 (98-96) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 43-37 and is 11-29 on the road.



Friday, Mar. 13, 2015 at Phoenix Suns (10:00 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Phoenix for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play again in Atlanta on 4/7 ... The Suns swept 2013-14 series 2-0 ... The most recent Hawks victory in the series came on 3/15/13 (107-94) at Philips Arena, while the last road win was on 2/15/12 (101-99) ... The Suns lead the all-time series 69-49 and are 42-16 at home.



Sunday, Mar. 15, 2015 at Los Angeles Lakers (9:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Los Angeles to play the Lakers for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Lakers won their first meeting at Philips Arena on 11/18 (114-109) ... Paul Millsap posted 29 points, four rebounds, four steals, three assists and two blocks for the Hawks ... Jeremy Lin (15 points/10 assists), Carlos Boozer (20 points/10 rebounds) and Jordan Hill (18 points/10 rebounds) each recorded a double-double for the Lakers ... Atlanta's most recent victory against the Lakers came on 12/16/13 (114-100) at Philips Arena ... The Lakers have won eight consecutive games at home against Atlanta, with the Hawks' last road victory coming on 2/15/06 (114-110) ... Since the Hawks moved to Atlanta, Los Angeles leads the all-time series 75-45 (44-16 at home).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 3/5, Hall of Famer and Hawks legend Dominique Wilkins was honored in a private ceremony with the unveiling of a larger-than-life size statue. The 13.5-foot-tall, 18,500-pound sculpture features Wilkins in one of his signature explosive poses. The statue was unveiled to the public on 3/6 as it took its place between the Atlanta letters at Philips Arena on the newly named 'Dominique Wilkins Lane.' NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks have clinched a playoff berth for the eighth consecutive season, the longest active postseason streak in the Eastern Conference and the longest streak in team history. Since moving to Atlanta in 1968, the franchise has made 30 postseason appearances (including this year).

* Atlanta recorded a six-game winning streak from 2/22-3/6. It was the third time this year the club has won at least six consecutive games. This season, two other teams in the NBA have had three different winning streaks of six-or-more games (Toronto, Memphis).

* Atlanta has hit 10-plus 3FGs in a game 37 times this year, breaking the franchise record of 35 set last season.

* Last week, Kyle Korver passed Steve Nash for 13th in NBA history in 3FGM (currently 1686 for his career). Korver (currently 552 3FGM as a Hawk) also passed Steve Smith for fourth in Hawks' franchise history. He has hit at least one 3FG in 48 consecutive games, the second-longest run of his career behind his NBA record streak of 127 straight contests from 11/4/12-3/2/14.

* The Hawks signed rookie Jarell Eddie to a 10-day contract on 3/5. Eddie, originally signed by Atlanta on 9/29 before being waived on 10/21, has appeared in 37 games this season with the Austin Spurs of the NBA Development League, averaging 11.9 points, 3.3 rebounds and 1.0 assists in 25.6 minutes (.421 FG%, .422 3FG%, .868 FT%). During the 2015 All-Star Weekend, Eddie won the D-League Three-Point Contest.

* Jeff Teague (currently 1013 FTM) made his 1000th career free throw vs. Houston on 3/3.

* Jeff Teague has scored in double-figures in 32 straight games played (12/26-3/7), the longest streak of his career.

* Kent Bazemore set a career-high with nine rebounds vs. Houston (3/3). He tied the mark two games later at Philadelphia (3/7) while also equaling his career-best with two blocked shots.

* Al Horford moved into the 10th place in franchise history in career rebounds (currently 4453) on 3/3 vs. Houston, passing John Drew.

* John Jenkins made his first start of the season at Philadelphia on 3/7, finishing with eight points, four rebounds and one assist in 23 minutes (3-7 FGs, 2-5 3FGs).

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

March 14, 1997 – Steve Smith sets a franchise record by hitting nine three-pointers in a 97-91 home loss to Seattle. He finished the night with 36 points on 10-20 FGs, 9-15 3FGs and 7-7 FTs. Smith also set a record for three's in a quarter (seven) which was later tied by Henry James.
