UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Apr. 13, 2015 vs. New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Knicks for the second time in the third-and-final meeting this season between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the season series 2-0, after winning at home on 11/8 (103-96) and at Madison Square Garden on 11/10 (91-85) ... Kyle Korver is averaging 22.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 blocks versus New York this season ... Tim Hardaway Jr. is averaging 15.0 points, 1.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists against the Hawks this year ... The Hawks currently own a three-game winning streak in the series overall and have taken two straight at Philips Arena ... The last Knicks victory in the series was a 111-106 home decision on 12/14/13, while the last win at Philips Arena came on 11/13/13 (95-91) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 188-170 and is 103-50 at home.



Wednesday, Apr. 15, 2015 at Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

The Hawks travel to Chicago to close the regular season in the third-and-final game between the teams ... Atlanta leads the season series 2-0, with victories at Philips Arena on 12/15 (93-86) and in Chicago on 1/17 (107-99) ... Al Horford is averaging 21.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.5 steals against the Bulls this season ... Jimmy Butler is averaging 18.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 steals versus the Hawks this year ... The most recent Bulls victory against the Hawks came on 4/2/14 (105-92) in Atlanta ... The last time Chicago defeated the Hawks at the United Center was on 2/11/14 (100-85) ... Chicago leads the all-time series 122-104 and is 70-40 at home.

COMMUNITY NEWS

- * On 4/13 vs. New York, the Hawks will honor Hope Kemp-Hanson, founder of *2016 Athletes that Care* with the 'Be Greater Atlanta Award.' Comprised of students from Chattahoochee High School, *2016 Athletes That Care* is committed to raising over \$50,000 for local non-profits before graduating in 2016.
- * On 4/14 at 8:30 a.m., Al Horford will visit the International Academy of Smyrna, to encourage health and wellness through the Alliance for a Healthier Generation. This will be Horford's seventh Atlanta school visit of the season made possible through a partnership with the Wasserman Foundation. The Alliance for a Healthier Generation works with schools, companies, community organizations, healthcare professionals and families to build healthier environments for millions of children.
- * The NBA and FIBA have announced that they will host their first joint basketball development camp in Havana, Cuba from 4/23-4/26. NBA Global Ambassador and former Hawks center Dikembe Mutombo will be one-of-three former professional basketball players (Steve Nash and Ticha Penicheiro) to lead the four-day camp.

NEWS & NOTES

- * With the victory against Phoenix on 4/7, Atlanta tied the franchise record for wins in a single season against the Western Conference (22, also in 1996-97 and 1978-79). The Hawks joined the Eastern Conference in the 1970-71 season.
- * Jeff Teague recorded his 10th point/assist double-double of the season at Brooklyn on 4/8, finishing the game with 15 points, 12 assists, six rebounds four steals and one block. Teague passed Jason Terry and Eddie Johnson for fourth on the all-time franchise list in point/assist double-doubles (42) and Josh Smith for 10th on the all-time assist chart (currently 2188).
- * Last week, Kyle Korver (currently 1723 3FGM) passed Dale Ellis for 11th in NBA history in 3FGM. Korver (215 3FGM) is third on the Hawks' all-time single season chart, with Mookie Blaylock ranking first (231 in 1995-96) and second (221 in 1996-97). Korver also holds the fourth (189 in 2012-13) and fifth (185 in 2013-14) spots on the list.
- * Mike Muscala recorded 17 points and six rebounds in 25 minutes (8-9 FGs, 1-1 3FGs) vs. Charlotte on 4/10, setting a career-high in FGM. Muscala also posted 16 points, seven rebounds, a career-best four steals and one block in 26 minutes vs. Phoenix on 4/7. Additionally, he tied his career-high of four assists at Washington (4/12).
- * Three other Hawks set or tied career-highs last week: Kent Bazemore with nine rebounds vs. Phoenix (4/7); John Jenkins with three steals at Washington (4/12) and Dennis Schröder with six rebounds at Washington (4/12).
- * At Washington on 4/12, Elton Brand tied Jermaine O'Neal (1820) for 24th in NBA/ABA history in blocked shots, and Larry Bird (8974) for 56th in rebounds.

* Hawks Assistant Coach Kenny Atkinson was named Head Coach of the Dominican Republic Men's National Team on 4/13.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

April 19, 1986 – Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins ties Bob Pettit's playoff franchise record by scoring 50 points in a 137-125 win over Detroit. The Hawks would go on to win the first round series 3-1 before falling to Boston in the Eastern Conference Semifinals.
