SERIES RECAP

The Hawks and Wizards have alternated victories, as Washington leads the series 2-1. Atlanta and Washington split the first two games at Philips Arena, with the Wizards winning Game 1 (104-98) and the Hawks victorious in Game 2 (106-90). In Game 3, in the Nation's Capital, a buzzer-beating jump shot by Paul Pierce sealed Washington's victory (103-101). Game 4 will be played tonight at the Verizon Center at 7:00 p.m. and Game 5 is scheduled for 8:00 p.m. at Philips Arena on 5/13. For the Hawks, DeMarre Carroll is averaging 20.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.0 steals (.550 FG%, .429 3FG%, .833 FT%) in the series, while Al Horford is putting up 15.7 points, 10.3 rebounds, 5.7 assists, 1.7 blocks and 1.3 steals. Washington's Bradley Beal is averaging 21.7 points, 5.3 assists, 5.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals.

ALL-TIME REGULAR SEASON/POSTSEASON

Atlanta and Washington meet in the Eastern Conference Semifinals after the Hawks won the regular season series (3-1) ... The Hawks were victorious in the first three games of the regular season series: in Washington on 11/25 (106-102) and at Philips Arena on 1/11 (120-89) and on 2/4 (105-96), before Washington won the final contest at the Verizon Center on 4/12 (108-99) ... Jeff Teague averaged 21.7 points, 7.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.3 rebounds, while Al Horford averaged 14.3 points, 7.7 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.3 blocks against Washington this season ... John Wall averaged 21.0 points, 9.8 assists, 5.3 rebounds and 1.3 steals versus Atlanta this season ... The Hawks are 148-138 all-time against the Wizards in the regular season (94-43 at home and 47-90 on the road) ... The Hawks have met Washington twice in the postseason previously, with the Wizards winning both series' (1978 and 1979) ... Atlanta is 4-8 all-time against Washington in the postseason (2-4 at home, 2-4 on the road).

NEWS & NOTES

* The Atlanta bench combined for 50 points in Game 3 at Washington (5/9), tied for the second-highest scoring output by the reserves since 1984-85. The Hawks had 51 bench points on 5/6/86 against Boston and 50 on 4/17/86 against Detroit.

* Atlanta dished out 30 assists in the Game 2 win versus Washington (5/3), tied for the 10th-highest total in Hawks playoff history. It was the second time this postseason that the Hawks have recorded 30-or-more assists in a game (also 34 at Brooklyn on 5/1).

* Last week, four players moved up the Hawks' all-time playoff leaderboard in several categories (Atlanta-era): Al Horford moved into first in games played (57), tied for fourth in FGM (306), sixth in points (726), tied for sixth in double-doubles (21) and seventh in steals (42); Jeff Teague is now fourth in assists (191) and eighth in games played (45); Paul Millsap moved into ninth in blocks (23), tied for ninth in 3FGM (22) and 10th in steals (30); Kyle Korver jumped to third all-time in 3FGM (67).

* DeMarre Carroll scored 20-or-more points in six consecutive playoff games (4/25-5/5), the first six 20-point postseason outings of his career. He is the first Hawk to score 20-or-more points in six straight playoff games (same year) since Dominique Wilkins from 4/29-5/22/88 (12 games).

* On 5/5 vs. Washington, Paul Millsap recorded 18 points, 11 rebounds, five assists and four steals while making a 3FG, becoming the 13th player in NBA postseason history to record at least that stat line. Kyle Korver, in the same contest, tallied 12 points, six rebounds, three blocks, two assists, one steal and four 3FGM, becoming the ninth player in NBA playoff history to have those numbers.

* Dennis Schröder scored a postseason career-high 18 points in 20 minutes off the bench in Game 3 at Washington on 5/9. Schröder scored 16 of his points in the fourth quarter, the highest scoring final period for a Hawk in the playoffs since Joe Johnson put in 20 vs. Boston on 4/28/08. He is also the fourth Hawk since 1984-85 to score at least 18 points in 20 minutes-or-less in a playoff game, joining Duane Ferrell (18 on 5/4/93), John Battle (19 on 5/10/87) and Spud Webb (18 on 4/17/86).

* In Game 3 at Washington on 5/9, Mike Muscala set playoff career-highs in points (seven), rebounds (three), FGM (three), and minutes (13), while hitting his first career postseason three-pointer. Kent Bazemore set or tied postseason career-highs in assists (two) and FGM (three) in the same contest.

* In Game 2 versus Washington (5/5) several Hawks set or tied playoff career-highs, including: Kent Bazemore in points (10), FGM (three), 3FGM (two) and FTM (two); Kyle Korver in blocks (three); Dennis Schröder in rebounds (five) and FTM (five); DeMarre Carroll in FGM (nine); and Al Horford in steals (three).

* The Hawks have launched the new official team mobile application, providing users with the first custom emoji keyboard in professional sports, as well as access to seat upgrades and traffic alerts around Philips Arena. Users of the new app will also be able to view team highlights and stats, follow the club's social media channels and compete for chances to win prizes.
