UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Oct. 27, 2015 vs. Detroit Pistons (8:00 p.m.)

TV: Fox Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Pistons in the regular season opener for both teams ... The two clubs will meet three more times, at Philips Arena on 12/23, and at The Palace of Auburn Hills on 3/16 and 3/26 ... The Hawks won the 2014-15 season series 2-1 ... After taking the first two contests (one at home and one on the road) last year, the Hawks dropped a 105-95 road decision on 3/31/15 in the series finale ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 173-163 (76-78 at home).



Thursday, Oct. 29, 2015 at New York Knicks (8:00 p.m.)

TV: TNT ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to New York for the first-of-four games between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Atlanta on 12/26 and 1/5, and at Madison Square Garden on 1/3 ... The Hawks won the 2014-15 series 2-1, with New York triumphant (112-108) in the final matchup on 4/13/15 at Philips Arena ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Knicks was on 11/10/14 (91-85) in New York ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 188-171 and are 61-89 on the road.



Friday, Oct. 30, 2015 vs. Charlotte Hornets (8:00 p.m.)

TV: Fox Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Charlotte for the first-of-two consecutive contests against the Hornets ... The teams will meet three more times, in Charlotte on 11/1 and 1/13, and at Philips Arena on 2/28 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 series (2-2), with each team holding home court ... The most recent Hawks victory came on 4/10/15 (104-80) at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 57-44 (34-18 at home).



Sunday, Nov. 1, 2015 at Charlotte Hornets (2:00 p.m.)

The Hawks travel to Charlotte for the second-of-two consecutive contests against the Hornets ... The clubs will meet two more times, in Charlotte on 1/13 and in Atlanta on 2/28 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 series (2-2), with each team holding home court ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Hornets was on 4/10/15 (104-80) in Atlanta ... The most recent Hawks victory in Charlotte was on 12/28/13 (118-116 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 57-44 and is 23-26 on the road.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks and recording artist Big Grams, featuring Big Boi and Phantogram, announced plans to have the newly formed three-person collective perform multiple sets when the team welcomes Washington to Atlanta on 11/7 at 7:30 p.m. Big Grams, comprised of seven-time Grammy Award®-winner Big Boi and Phantogram's Sarah Barthel and Josh Carter, will perform during halftime and postgame. The trio will also host an album signing for fans, autographing copies of "BIG GRAMS," their self-titled, seven-track debut released on 9/25 through Epic Records. Tickets are on sale now and available by visiting www.hawks.com/tickets, calling 1-866-715-1500, or visiting the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.

* The Hawks' final preseason leaders were: Al Horford (11.5 ppg and 1.000 FT%, 11-11), Paul Millsap (8.0 rpg and 1.6 spg), Jeff Teague (4.0 apg and 24.7 mpg), Edy Tavares (1.50 bpg), Kent Bazemore (.548 FG% and .500 3FG%) and Kyle Korver (1.000 FT%, 14-14). Horford and Korver tied for league lead in FT% during the preseason, while Horford also ranked t34th in blocks (1.2) and t36th in rebounds (6.8). Millsap was 19th in rebounds and t22nd in steals, and Teague finished t23rd in FT% (.929) and t28th in assists. Bazemore ranked t22nd in 3FG% and Tavares was t13th in blocks. Rookie Lamar Patterson had a 1.60 STL/TO ratio, good 13th in the league.

* Four Hawks averaged at least 10 points per game during the preseason: Al Horford (11.5), Jeff Teague (10.8), Kent Bazemore (10.4) and Paul Millsap (10.4).

* Tim Hardaway Jr. was the only Hawks player to appear in all seven preseason games. Hardaway averaged 5.6 points and 2.3 rebounds in 19.4 minutes.

* "On The Court With Coach Bud", presented by FanDuel, began on 10/22 as Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer joined SportsRadio 92-9 The Game's (FM) "The Rick & Randy Show." The weekly coach's program can be heard each Thursday during the season at 1:22 p.m. Additionally, Hawks CEO Steve Koonin will be a weekly guest on 92-9 The Game's "Dukes & Bell" show each Friday at 4:42 p.m.

* The Hawks announced a 23-game radio schedule with iHeartMedia Spanish language station El Patrón 105.3 FM. El Patrón will broadcast each home contest played from Sunday-through-Wednesday in 2015-16. Jose Manuel Flores will again serve as play-by-play announcer. In addition to game coverage, Hawks-themed content and interviews with members of the team will air on the station.

* On 10/24 the Hawks waived Earl Barron and DeQuan Jones. On 10/22 Atlanta waived Terran Petteway.
