### UPCOMING GAMES



**BROOKLYN**

**Tuesday, Nov. 17, 2015 at Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Brooklyn for the second-of-three meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Atlanta on 1/16 ... The Hawks lead the season series 1-0 after defeating the Nets 101-87 on 11/4 at Philips Arena ... Al Horford recorded 21 points, eight rebounds, four assists and two blocks for the Hawks ... Brook Lopez posted a double-double (27 points/11 rebounds) for the Nets ... Atlanta has won six consecutive regular season games against Brooklyn, including three straight on the road ... The Nets' most recent regular season victory against the Hawks happened in London (UK) on 1/16/14 (127-110) ... Brooklyn last defeated the Hawks at the Barclays Center on 1/6/14 (91-86) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 96-69, with the Nets holding a 47-36 advantage at home.



**Wednesday, Nov. 18, 2015 vs. Sacramento Kings (8:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Kings for the first-of-two matchups between the teams ... The clubs will play once more on 1/21 in Sacramento ... The Hawks swept the 2014-15 series 2-0 and have won 14 consecutive contests against the Kings, including an eight-game win streak at Philips Arena ... The last time the Kings defeated the Hawks was on 2/20/08 (119-107) in Sacramento, with the most recent Sacramento victory at Philips Arena coming on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 156-152, including an 86-29 home mark.



**Saturday, Nov. 21, 2015 at Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Cleveland for the first-of-three games between the clubs ... The teams will meet again in Atlanta on 4/1, and once more in Cleveland on 4/11 ... The Hawks won the 2014-15 series 3-1, with Cleveland winning the first game and the Hawks taking the final three contests (two at home, one on the road) ... In the Eastern Conference Finals of the 2015 Playoffs, Atlanta fell to Cleveland 4-0 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 117-96, with the Cavaliers holding a 61-47 advantage at home.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks and Atlanta-based recording artist Jeezy will collaborate on 11/30 when the team hosts the Oklahoma City Thunder. Jeezy will headline the next installment of the Sprite Concert Series, as he performs at halftime and postgame. "Church in These Streets," Jeezy's sixth solo offering, will be available for purchase in a merchandise bundle throughout the night at Hawks Shop. The bundle includes the album and a choice of one-of-two limited edition Hawks-and-Jeezy-themed shirts hand-picked by the artist to commemorate the album's release and his game night appearance. \* The Hawks started 2015-16 with a 4-0 road record, tying the second-best road start in club history (1997-98, 2008-09, 2010-11). The franchise record for most consecutive road wins to start a season is five by the St. Louis Hawks in 1967-68.

\* Several Hawks set or tied single-game career highs last week: Jeff Teague tied a career-high with three blocks vs. Minnesota (11/9); Al Horford recorded a career-best four 3FGM vs. New Orleans (11/11); Mike Muscala had a career-high five FTM at Boston (11/13); Dennis Schröder tied a career-best with six rebounds vs. Utah (11/15).

\* Jeff Teague recorded his 43<sup>rd</sup> career point/assist double-double (Hawks are 36-7) in Atlanta's 106-98 win vs. New Orleans (11/11), tying him with Hall of Famer Lenny Wilkens for third on the Hawks' all-time list. Teague finished the night with 14 points, 10 assists, two steals and one block.

\* On 11/11, Edy Tavares was assigned to the Austin Spurs of the NBA Development League and on 11/13 Lamar Patterson was also assigned to Austin. On 11/15 both players were recalled. In two games with Austin, Tavares recorded two double-doubles and averaged 16.0 points, 14.5 rebounds, 4.5 blocks and 1.0 steals in 29.0 minutes (.706 FG%, .800 FT%). Patterson averaged 15.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 1.0 steals in 34.5 minutes (.455 FG%, .375 3FG%) in two outings.

\* Fox Sport Southeast's Emmy award-winning series *DRIVEN*, debuted *DRIVEN: The Human Highlight Film* on 11/13. The show chronicles the life of Hall of Famer and Hawks legend Dominique Wilkins. Fox Sports Southeast will re-air the program on 11/18 (6:30 p.m.), 11/26 (7:00 p.m.) and 11/29 (1:30 a.m.).

\* Tiago Splitter recorded his 1000<sup>th</sup> career FGM vs. New Orleans on 11/11.
