### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Nov. 24, 2015 vs. Boston Celtics (8:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: TNT ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

The Hawks host the Celtics for the second-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup in Boston on 12/18 and once more in Atlanta on 4/9 ... The Celtics lead the season series 1-0 after defeating the Hawks 106-93 on 11/13 in Boston ... Six Hawks scored in double-figures, led by Paul Millsap with 14 points ... Isaiah Thomas posted a double-double (23 points/10 assists) for Boston ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Celtics was on 1/14/15 (105-91) at TD Garden, with the most recent victory at Philips Arena coming on 12/2/14 (109-105) ... Boston leads the all-time series 229-137, including an 87-82 road mark.



**Wednesday, Nov. 25, 2015 at Minnesota Timberwolves (8:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Minnesota for the only time this year in the second-of-two-games between the teams ... The Timberwolves won the first meeting 117-107 in Philips Arena on 11/9 ... Paul Millsap tallied 22 points, six assists, five rebounds, two steals and two blocks for Atlanta ... Andrew Wiggins recorded 33 points, five rebounds, four assists, one steal and one block for Minnesota ... The Hawks took the last meeting in Minnesota, 117-105, on 2/9/15 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 32-18 and is 12-12 on the road.



**Friday, Nov. 27, 2015 at Memphis Grizzlies (8:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta travels to Memphis for the first-of-two contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more at Philips Arena on 3/12 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 season series 1-1, with each team holding home court and Memphis winning the final matchup ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Grizzlies came on 1/7/15 (96-86) at Philips Arena, with the most recent Atlanta victory in Memphis occurring on 12/8/12 (93-83) ... The Grizzlies have taken two straight at home against Atlanta ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 24-14 and are 9-9 on the road.



**Saturday, Nov. 28, 2015 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks complete their three-game road trip with a visit to San Antonio for the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup once more on 12/12 at Philips Arena ... San Antonio swept the 2014-15 season series 2-0 and has won nine straight games against Atlanta overall, including 17 consecutive contests in San Antonio ... The Hawks last defeated the Spurs on 3/21/10 (119-114 OT) at Philips Arena, with the most recent Atlanta victory in San Antonio coming on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 49-36, with a 31-12 home mark.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks and Atlanta-based recording artist Jeezy will collaborate on 11/30 when the team hosts the Oklahoma City Thunder. Jeezy will headline the next installment of the Sprite Concert Series, as he performs at halftime and postgame. "Church in These Streets," Jeezy's sixth solo offering, will be available for purchase in a merchandise bundle throughout the night at Hawks Shop. The bundle includes the album and a choice of one-of-two limited edition Hawks-and-Jeezy-themed shirts hand-picked by the artist to commemorate the album's release and his game night appearance. \* Several Hawks set or tied single-game career highs last week: Justin Holiday tied a career-high with four rebounds at Brooklyn (11/17); Lamar Patterson recorded a career-best five rebounds in a career-high 25 minutes, while tying career-highs with nine points and three FGM vs. Sacramento (11/18); In the same contest against the Kings, Dennis Schröder tied career-highs with nine FGM and three 3FGM; Patterson tied a career-high with three assists at Cleveland (11/21).

\* Kyle Korver recorded his 2500<sup>th</sup> career defensive rebound vs. Sacramento (11/18), and scored his 9000<sup>th</sup> career point at Cleveland (11/21).

\* Paul Millsap recorded 23 points, 16 rebounds, three assists, three steals and two blocks vs. Sacramento (11/18). Millsap is the only player in the NBA to record at least that stat line in a single game this season, and he is one of two players (DeMarcus Cousins) to accomplish that since the 2012-13 season.

\* Paul Millsap is the only player in the NBA averaging at least 17.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 3.0 apg, 2.0 spg and 1.0 bpg this season. On the year he is averaging 17.9 points, 9.3 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 2.1 steals and 1.1 blocks; ranking fifth in the league in spg, t15<sup>th</sup> in rpg, t31<sup>st</sup> in ppg and t32<sup>nd</sup> in bpg.
