UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Nov. 30, 2015 vs. Oklahoma City Thunder (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

The Hawks host the Thunder for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Oklahoma City on 12/10 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 season series 1-1, with each team holding home court ... Atlanta's most recent victory against Oklahoma City came on 1/23/15 (103-93), with the Thunder taking the last meeting at home, a 123-115 decision on 3/20/15 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 64-62, including a 39-25 home mark.



Wednesday, Dec. 2, 2015 vs. Toronto Raptors (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Raptors for the first-of-four-games between the teams ... The clubs will meet again in Toronto on 3/10 and 3/30, and once more at Philips Arena on 4/7 ... Toronto won the 2014-15 series 3-1, including the final contest, a 105-80 at Philips Arena (2/20/15) ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Raptors was on 1/16/15 (110-89) in Toronto, while the most recent Hawks victory against the Raptors at Philips Arena came on 3/18/14 (118-113 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 42-33 (22-16 home record).



Friday, Dec. 4, 2015 vs. Los Angeles Lakers (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks host the Lakers for the first-of-two contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Los Angeles on 3/4 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 season series 1-1, with each team winning on the road ... Atlanta took the last meeting on 3/15/15 (91-86) ... The last time the Hawks defeated the Lakers at Philips Arena was on 12/16/13 (114-100) ... Since the Hawks moved to Atlanta, the Lakers lead the all-time series 75-46 and are 31-29 on the road.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks and Atlanta-based recording artist Jeezy will collaborate today (11/30) when the team hosts the Oklahoma City Thunder. Jeezy will headline the next installment of the Sprite Concert Series, as he performs at halftime and postgame. "Church in These Streets," Jeezy's sixth solo offering, will be available for purchase in a merchandise bundle throughout the night at Hawks Shop. The bundle includes the album and a choice of one-of-two limited edition Hawks-and-Jeezy-themed shirts hand-picked by the artist to commemorate the album's release and his game night appearance. Tickets are on sale now and available by visiting www.hawks.com/tickets, calling 1-866-715-1500, or visiting the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.

*The Hawks tied a franchise record with 39 3FGAs (twice previously) at Memphis (11/27), making a season-best 14 triples. The 39 3FGAs represented 52.0% (75 FGAs) of Atlanta's attempted shots on the night, the first time in club history where at least half of the shot attempts were from three-point range. The Hawks also hit 32-36 FTs (.889), marking the second time in team history (first in regulation) with 35-plus 3FGAs and FTAs in the same game (also 1/25/13 vs. Boston in double OT).

* Jeff Teague tied a career-high with four 3FGM at Memphis on 11/27, finishing the night with 20 points, seven assists, two rebounds and one steal in 29 minutes (5-7 FGs, 4-6 3FGs, 6-6 FTs). He became the seventh Hawk since the 1985-86 season to score at least 20 points with seven-or-fewer FGAs, and the first since Josh Childress at Utah on 3/2/05.

* With three 3FGs at Memphis on 11/27, Kyle Korver (currently 1761 3FGM) passed Peja Stojakovic for 10th in NBA/ABA history.

* Al Horford has scored in double-figures in each of the season's first 19 games (three 20-point scoring nights). Horford's longest double-figure scoring streak to open a season is 21 in 2013-14 (longest overall is 33 from 2/2/10-4/9/10). Paul Millsap scored 10-plus points in the first 18 games of the year, tying his career-best to start a season (2010-11).

* In the victory against Boston on 11/24, Paul Millsap recorded 25 points (10-14 FGs, 5-5 FTs), nine rebounds, three assists, one steal and one block. He is the only player in the NBA this season to record at least that stat line, while shooting above .700 FG%. In the same contest, Thabo Sefolosha posted 15 points (7-8 FGs, 1-1 FTs), seven rebounds, three assists, three steals and three blocks. He is the first player in the NBA to record at least that stat line while shooting at least .800 FG% since 3/21/11 (Dwight Howard).

* The Hawks retired Dikembe Mutombo's No. 55 jersey in a halftime ceremony on 11/24 when Atlanta defeated Boston. Dikembe Mutombo Night, presented by Bank of America and Merrill Lynch featured a number of tributes focusing on Mutombo's accomplishments on and off the court. Fans received Mutombo-centric game programs and commemorative "No, No, No" finger-wagging foam hands, presented by Fusion. A No. 55 t-shirt was available in the Hawks Shop for purchase with 100% of the proceeds going to the Dikembe Mutombo Foundation. Visit www.hawks.com for more details.
