UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Jan. 13, 2016 at Charlotte Hornets (7:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Charlotte for the final time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup once more in Atlanta on 2/28 ... The Hawks lead the series 2-0 after a 97-94 victory at Philips Arena on 10/30 and a 94-92 road triumph on 11/1 ... Kent Bazemore is averaging 19.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 assists against the Hornets this season ... Nicolas Batum is averaging 15.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 6.0 assists, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks versus the Hawks this year ... Atlanta is currently on a three-game winning streak in the series, including the last contest in Charlotte ... The last Hornets victory against the Hawks was a 115-100 home decision on 3/28/15 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 59-44, with Charlotte holding a 26-24 advantage at home.



Friday, Jan. 15, 2016 at Milwaukee Bucks (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks visit Milwaukee for the only time this season in the first-of-three contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet again in Atlanta on 2/20 and 3/25 ... The Hawks won the final three matchups (one at home and two on the road) last year to take the season series 3-1 ... Atlanta has won six consecutive road games against Milwaukee with the Bucks' last home victory coming on 3/27/12 (108-101) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 106-100 (38-62 on the road).



Saturday, Jan. 16, 2016 vs. Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta welcomes the Nets for the final time this season in the third-of-three games between the teams ... The season series is split 1-1, with each team holding home court ... The Hawks defeated the Nets on 11/4/15 (101-87) at Philips Arena, and Brooklyn was victorious on 11/17/15 (90-88) at Barclays Center ... Al Horford is averaging 19.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 blocks against the Nets this season ... Brook Lopez is averaging 25.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 2.0 blocks versus the Hawks this year ... The Hawks have taken three straight against the Nets at Philips Arena, with Brooklyn's last road win in the series coming on 1/16/14 in a game played in London (UK) ... The Nets last won at Philips Arena on 3/9/13 (93-80) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 96-70, including a 60-22 edge at home.

* The Hawks begin 2016 with the launch of *True Comes In All Colors: Celebrating Black History*. Traditionally recognized in February, the Hawks will get a head start on highlighting Atlantans as an integral part of the rich tapestry of African-American achievement with events beginning in mid-January and continuing through early March. * The Hawks will hold their annual MLK Classic Tournament on 1/18 (9 a.m.-2 p.m.). The Georgia Power-sponsored youth basketball tournament will bring out nearly 100 fifth-through-eighth grade student-athletes from the Park and Recreation leagues of the City of Atlanta and Fulton County to the Adamsville Recreation Center (3201 MLK Jr. Dr. NW, Atlanta GA 30311) for a day of entertainment and basketball to celebrate the life and legacy of Dr. King. NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks had eight different players make at least one 3FG (tying a franchise record) vs. New York (1/5) and again at Philadelphia (1/7). It was the first two times this season the Hawks accomplished the feat and the seventh and eighth time in franchise history.

* In the victory at Philadelphia (1/7), Atlanta recorded 18 steals, tied for 10th-best in franchise history and the highest single-game total since 4/14/98 also vs. the 76ers.

* Atlanta scored 126 points at Philadelphia (1/7) and 120 points vs. Chicago (1/9), moving to 6-0 on the season when scoring at least 120. The Hawks have won 11 straight games, dating back to a 129-120 loss at Phoenix on 3/2/14, when hitting the 120-point mark.

* The Hawks recorded 15 steals and a season-high 13 blocked shots vs. Chicago (1/9). It was the second time in franchise history (previously at Philadelphia on 4/9/97) that Atlanta has posted at least those stats in the same contest. The Hawks have now tallied at least 15 steals and 10 blocks in the same game twice this season (previously vs. Brooklyn 11/4/15) and five times in franchise history.

* Al Horford tallied 18 points, nine rebounds, three assists, three steals and three blocks in 24 minutes (7-12 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 3-3 FTs) while not committing a turnover at Philadelphia (1/7). He is the seventh player in NBA history to record at least those numbers (including FGM, 3FGM, FTM) in game with zero turnovers, and the first to do so in fewer than 38 minutes.

* Al Horford recorded his 10th double-double of the year with a season-best 33 points (career-high 15-21 FGs, 1-3 3FGs, 2-2 FTs) and 10 rebounds, while finishing the night with six assists, a season-high four blocks and one steal vs. Chicago (1/9). Horford is the 10th player in NBA history (first since Dirk Nowitzki on 2/7/07 vs. Memphis) and first Hawk to post at least that stat line without committing a turnover. Horford also tied Bill Bridges (3269 FGM) for 10th on the all-time Hawks FGM list.

* Paul Millsap set a new career-high with six blocked shots vs. Chicago (1/9), also finishing with 18 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two steals (8-16 FGs, 2-2 FTs).

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 16, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the ninth-highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the fifth-highest assist total in club history.
