### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Jan. 18, 2016 vs. Orlando Magic (5:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

Atlanta welcomes Orlando in the second-of-four meetings between the teams this year ... The clubs will matchup again in Orlando on 2/7 and in Atlanta on 2/8 ... The Hawks lead the series 1-0 after posting a 103-100 road win on 12/20 ... Kyle Korver scored 19 points and Paul Millsap recorded a double-double (13 points/13 rebounds) for the Hawks ... Nikola Vucevic had a double-double (20 points/11 rebounds), while finishing the night with four assists and one steal for the Magic ... Atlanta has won three consecutive games overall against Orlando, including two straight at Philips Arena ... The Magic's most recent victory in the series came on 12/13/14 (100-99) in Orlando, while the last win at Philips Arena was a 109-92 decision on 11/26/13 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 53-48 (33-16 at home).



**Wednesday, Jan. 20, 2016 at Portland Trail Blazers (10:30 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Portland for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the teams ... Atlanta won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 12/21 (106-97) ... Dennis Schröder recorded 18 points, three assists, one rebound and one steal for the Hawks ... Mason Plumlee posted a double-double (11 points/10 rebounds), while adding six assists, one steal and one block for the Trail Blazers ... Atlanta has won three straight games against the Blazers overall, including the last meeting in Portland (115-107) on 1/3/15 ... The last time the Trail Blazers defeated the Hawks was on 3/27/14 (100-85) at Philips Arena, while their most recent home victory against Atlanta came on 3/5/14 (102-78) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 54-53, with Portland holding a 34-19 advantage at home.



**Thursday, Jan. 21, 2016 at Sacramento Kings (10:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks visit Sacramento for the only time this season in the second-of-two contests between the clubs ... Atlanta won the first meeting at Philips Arena on 11/18 (103-97) ... Paul Millsap recorded a double-double (23 points/16 rebounds), while adding three assists, three steals and two blocks for the Hawks ... Rajon Rondo posted a triple-double (12 points/12 rebounds/10 assists) for the Kings ... The Hawks have taken 15 consecutive contests against the Kings overall, including a seven-game road win streak ... The Kings' last win in the series was a 119-107 home decision on 2/20/08 (119-107) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 157-152 (45-71 road record).



**Saturday, Jan. 23, 2016 at Phoenix Suns (9:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta travels to Phoenix for the only time this season in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup again in Atlanta on 4/5 ... The Hawks swept the 2014-15 series 2-0, after defeating the Suns in Phoenix on 3/13/15 (96-87) and in Atlanta on 4/7/15 (96-69) ... The Suns' most recent victory against the Hawks came on 3/24/14 (102-95) in Atlanta, while the last time Phoenix defeated the Hawks at home was on 3/2/14 (129-120) ... The Suns lead the all-time series 69-51 and are 42-17 at home.

Today (1/18), the youth basketball players will compete in games at the Center of Hope at Adamsville (3201 MLK Jr. Dr. NW, Atlanta, GA 30311). Free and open to the public, the exhibition will run from 9 a.m.-to-2 p.m. and will feature four matchups between boys and girls squads with Hawks alumni serving as coaches during the action. ### NEWS & NOTES

\* Paul Millsap went over the 10,000 career point mark (currently 10,017) vs. Brooklyn on 1/16, while Jeff Teague grabbed his 1000<sup>th</sup> career rebound that same night. Kyle Korver hit his 1800<sup>th</sup> career three-pointer (currently 1801) at Milwaukee on 1/15.

\* Atlanta is hosting a Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday game for the 17<sup>th</sup> straight year (on 1/18 vs. Orlando), and this will be the 25<sup>th</sup> time the Hawks have played on the holiday overall (22 games at home and three on the road). Atlanta is 15-9 all-time (14-7 at home) on MLK Day and has won five consecutive games.

\* Paul Millsap recorded his 14<sup>th</sup> double-double of the year (eighth 20-point/10-rebound game) with 23 points and 10 rebounds, while finishing the night with six assists, four blocks and two steals at Milwaukee (1/15). Millsap is the second player in the NBA this season to accumulate at least those numbers in a game (Raymond Green).

\* Dennis Schröder recorded his first double-double of the season and sixth of his career with 15 points (6-9 FGs, 2-4 3FGs, 1-1 FTs) and a season-high tying 10 assists, to go along with a career-high tying six rebounds and three steals vs. Brooklyn (1/16).

\* Al Horford (currently 3284 FGM) passed Bill Bridges for 10<sup>th</sup> on the all-time Hawks FGM list at Charlotte on 1/13.

\* On 1/17, Atlanta recalled Lamar Patterson and Edy Tavares from Austin of the NBA Development League. Patterson has averaged 16.2 points, 6.6 assists, 5.6 rebounds and 1.2 steals in 33.4 minutes (.422 FG%, .778 FT%) in five games with Austin (three stints) this year. Tavares has recorded 10.9 points, 10.6 rebounds and 2.7 blocks (.686 FG%, .800 FT%) in nine games with Austin and Canton over five assignments.
