UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 25, 2016 at Denver Nuggets (9:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks complete their four-game West Coast road trip by visiting Denver in the first-of-two meetings between the teams ... The clubs will play again at Philips Arena on 3/17 ... The teams split the 2014-15 series 1-1, with each team holding home court (Denver won the last matchup) ... The Nuggets have won eight consecutive home games against Atlanta, with the Hawks' most recent road victory coming on 12/6/06 (98-92) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 43-38, with Denver holding a 30-11 advantage at home.



Wednesday, Jan. 27, 2016 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (8:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Clippers for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The clubs will meet once more in Los Angeles on 3/5 ... The Hawks swept the 2014-15 series 2-0, after defeating the Clippers at home on 12/23 (107-104) and on the road on 1/5 (107-98) ... The Hawks have won two straight overall against L.A., and have taken six straight home contests in the series, with Los Angeles' last win at Philips Arena coming on 2/7/09 (121-97) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 75-39 (44-13 home mark).



Thursday, Jan. 28, 2016 at Indiana Pacers (7:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks travel to Indiana for the final time this season in the second-of-four meetings between the teams ... The clubs will matchup again at Philips Arena on 2/5 and 3/13 ... The Pacers lead the series 1-0 after posting a 93-87 home win on 12/28 ... Paul Millsap recorded 24 points, seven rebounds, four steals, two assists and one block for Atlanta ... Monta Ellis tallied 26 points, three rebounds, two assists, two steals and one block for Indiana ... The Hawks' most recent victory against Indiana came on 1/21/15 (110-91) at Philips Arena, while the last road win was a 108-92 decision on 12/8/14 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 97-80 (35-53 road record).



Sunday, Jan. 31, 2016 at Miami Heat (6:00 p.m.)
TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta visits Miami for the last time this season in the third-of-four matchups between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more at Philips Arena on 2/19 ... The series is split 1-1, with the road team winning each contest ... The Hawks defeated the Heat on 11/3 (98-92) and Miami responded by beating Atlanta on 12/14 (100-88) ... Kent Bazemore is averaging 19.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals against the Heat this season ... Chris Bosh is recording 16.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won three consecutive road games against Miami with the Heat's last home victory coming on 12/23/13 (121-119 OT) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 58-47 and are 37-16 at home.

* The NBA and Kaiser Permanente are teaming up for the first Total Health Forum, which will be taking place in Washington, D.C. on 1/28. * The Hawks launched *True Comes In All Colors: Celebrating Black History*. The cornerstone of the Black History celebration was the inaugural MOSAIC (Model of Shaping Atlanta through Inclusive Conversations) Race & Gender in Sports event, which was held on 1/21 at the Center for Civil and Human Rights. Hosted by Rohit Malhotra, Executive Director of the Center for Civic Innovation, the day featured Hawks Board of Directors Vice-Chair Grant Hill, former corporate consultant to MLB and Fortune 500 companies, Janet Hill, author/activist Kevin Powell, Troy Vincent, EVP – Football Operations, NFL, Oris Stewart, Chief Diversity Officer, NBA and Amy Wilson, Director, Gender Inclusion, NCAA.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are averaging 26.8 fourth quarter points this year, ranking tied for first in the NBA. Atlanta is also first in the league in A/TO ratio (1.84) in the final period, second in assists (6.3), third in FG% (.469) and eighth in FT% (.789). The Hawks are averaging 28.4 points (142) in the final stanza over the last five games, while allowing 21.8 (109), and have outscored their opponent each night.

* Atlanta has recorded four wire-to-wire wins this season (all at home) – Orlando (1/18), Chicago (1/9), Philadelphia (12/16) and L.A. Lakers (12/4).

* Mike Budenholzer (currently 124 victories) tied Bob Weiss for eighth on the Hawks' all-time wins list after defeating Portland on 1/20.

* At Sacramento (1/21), Paul Millsap recorded 14 points, 14 rebounds, five steals, four blocks and three assists in 33 minutes. He became the 12th player in NBA history (17 times total) to record at least those numbers in the same game, joining Hakeem Olajuwon, Charles Barkley, David Robinson, Shawn Kemp, Gerald Wallace, LaSalle Thompson, Dan Roundfield, George Johnson, Bob McAdoo and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar.

* At Phoenix (1/23), Dennis Schröder tied a career-best with three 3FGM, while posting 19 points (6-10 FGs, 3-6 3FGs, 4-4 FTs), five assists, two steals, one rebound and one block.

* Mike Scott made one 3FG in nine consecutive games (12/29/15-1/18/16), the longest streak of his career. Additionally, Scott recorded a career-high two blocks at Sacramento (1/21), also finishing the night with six points and one rebound (2-4 FGs, 2-3 3FGs).

* On 1/18, Philips Arena introduced three new food and beverage offerings: Mini Melts, Astor Chocolates and Jittery Joe's Coffee. Mini Melts are cryogenically frozen ice cream that produces irregular shapes, Astor Chocolate is a gourmet chocolate company based out of New Jersey, and Jittery Joe's Coffee is a coffee company based in Athens, GA. THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 31, 2001 – Dikembe Mutombo pulls down 29 rebounds (12 offensive, 17 defensive) in the Hawks' 102-97 home win over Toronto. It is the third-best single game rebounding performance since the team moved to Atlanta in 1968.

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
