### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Feb. 1, 2016 vs. Dallas Mavericks (8:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Mavericks for the only time this year in the second-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the series 1-0 after posting a 98-95 road victory on 12/9 ... Paul Millsap recorded a double-double (20 points/11 rebound), while adding five assists, three steals and one block for Atlanta ... Deron Williams tallied 18 points, seven rebounds and six assists for Dallas ... The Hawks have taken four straight games against Dallas, including two consecutive wins at Philips Arena ... The Mavericks most recent victory against the Hawks came on 10/30/13 (92-84) in Dallas, and their last win at Philips Arena was on 3/18/13 (127-113) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 37-32 (20-14 home mark).



**Wednesday, Feb. 3, 2016 at Philadelphia 76ers (7:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks visit Philadelphia for the final time this season in the third-of-three games between the teams ... Atlanta leads the series 2-0 after posting a 127-106 home win on 12/16 and a 126-98 road decision on 1/7 ... Paul Millsap is averaging 19.5 points, 3.5 assists, 3.0 rebounds, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks against the 76ers this season ... Jahlil Okafor is averaging 20.0 points and 7.0 rebounds against the Hawks this year ... The last time the 76ers defeated Atlanta was on 3/7/15 (92-84) in Philadelphia ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 167-160, with the 76ers holding a 91-53 advantage at home.



**Friday, Feb. 5, 2016 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Indiana for the first time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Atlanta on 3/13 ... The Pacers lead the series 2-0, after defeating the Hawks at Bankers Life Fieldhouse on 12/28 (93-87) and 1/28 (111-92) ... Jeff Teague is averaging 19.0 points, 4.5 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals against Indiana this season ... Monta Ellis is averaging 25.5 points, 4.0 assists, 4.0 rebound, 3.5 steals and 1.0 blocks against the Hawks this year ... The Hawks have won two consecutive home games against the Pacers, with Indiana's last victory at Philips Arena coming on 2/4/14 (89-85) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 97-81 and is 61-26 at home.



**Sunday, Feb. 7, 2016 at Orlando Magic (1:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks visit Orlando in the first of two consecutive contests against the Magic, and the third-of-four games between the teams ... The clubs will meet once more in Atlanta on 2/8 ... The Hawks lead the series 2-0 after a 103-100 road victory on 12/20 and a 98-81 home win on 1/18 ... Al Horford is averaging 14.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals against the Magic this season ... Nikola Vucevic is averaging 15.0 points, 11.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steals against the Hawks this year ... The Hawks have won four straight games against Orlando, including two consecutive victories at the Amway Center ... The last time the Magic defeated Atlanta was on 12/13/14 (100-99) in Orlando ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 54-48 (20-32 road record).

\* On 1/29, the NBA and the International Basketball Federation (FIBA) announced the top 53 boys and girls from 27 countries who will travel to Toronto for the second annual Basketball without Borders (BWB) Global Camp. The camp will be held 2/12-2/14 at Mattamy Athletic Centre as part of NBA All-Star 2016. Hawks alumni Jerry Stackhouse and Vladimir Radmanovic will assist in coaching the campers during the event.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Paul Millsap has been selected by the Eastern Conference coaches to the All-Star team, and will compete in the 2016 All-Star game on 2/14 at Air Canada Centre in Toronto. This is the third straight year in which Millsap has been named to the All-Star team. He joins Joe Johnson, Dominique Wilkins, Lenny Wilkens, Lou Hudson, Bob Pettit and Slater Martin as the only players in franchise history to earn all-star honors in three consecutive seasons.

\* Atlanta is the only club in the league with four players ranked among the Top 40 in steals per game – Paul Millsap (1.9) is ninth, Thabo Sefolosha (1.3) is t28<sup>th</sup>, Jeff Teague (1.3) is 35<sup>th</sup> and Kent Bazemore (1.3) is 37<sup>th</sup>.

\* Mike Budenholzer (currently 125 victories) passed Bob Weiss for eighth on the Hawks' all-time wins list after defeating Denver on 1/25.

\* Jeff Teague (currently 576 steals) passed Stacy Augmon for ninth in franchise history, after posting his third double-double of the season (12 points/10 assists), while adding three rebounds and three steals in the victory at Denver on 1/25.

\* Kent Bazemore set a new career-high with 10 rebounds at Miami (1/31) one game after tying his previous career-best of nine boards at Indiana (1/28).

\* On 1/27, the Hawks assigned Edy Tavares to Austin of the NBA Development League. Tavares has appeared in 10 D-League games this season (eight with Austin and two with Canton), averaging 9.8 points, 9.6 rebounds and 2.4 blocks in 21.4 minutes (.686 FG%, .800 FT%).
