### UPCOMING GAMES



**Friday, Feb. 19, 2016 vs. Miami Heat (8:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks host Miami in the fourth-and-final game this season between the teams ... The Heat lead the series 2-1, with Atlanta posting a 98-92 road win on 11/3 and Miami being victorious the next two games: in Atlanta on 12/14 (100-88) and a 105-87 home triumph on 1/31 ... Jeff Teague is averaging 16.0 points, 6.3 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.0 steals against the Heat this season ... Chris Bosh is averaging 17.0 points, 10.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.0 steals against the Hawks this year ... The last time Atlanta defeated the Heat at Philips Arena was 3/27/15 (99-86) ... Miami leads the all-time series 59-47, with the Hawks holding a 31-21 advantage at home.



**Saturday, Feb. 20, 2016 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks welcome Milwaukee for the first time this season in the second-of-three meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more at Philips Arena on 3/25 ... The Bucks lead the series 1-0, after notching a 108-101 home win on 1/15 ... Paul Millsap recorded a double-double (23 points/10 rebounds), while adding six assists, four blocks and two steals for Atlanta ... Giannis Antetokounmpo posted a double-double (28 points/16 rebounds), while finishing the night with three blocks and one steal for Milwaukee ... The Hawks took the last contest at Philips Arena between the clubs (101-88) on 3/30/15, while the Bucks' last triumph in Atlanta came on 12/26/14 (107-77). Atlanta leads the all-time series 106-101 (67-36 home mark).



**Monday, Feb. 22, 2016 vs. Golden State Warriors (8:00 p.m.)**  
**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**  
 Atlanta hosts the Warriors the only time this season in the first-of-two contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more in Golden State on 3/1 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 series 1-1, with each team holding home court ... The Hawks defeated the Warriors 124-116 on 2/6/15 and Golden State responded with a 114-95 victory on 3/18/15 ... The last time the Warriors defeated the Hawks in Atlanta was on 1/3/14 (101-100) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 142-140 and are 84-42 at home.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* On 2/12, Al Horford was named to the Eastern Conference All-Star team by NBA Commissioner Adam Silver, joining teammate Paul Millsap in competing in the 2016 All-Star Game on 2/14 in Toronto. Horford replaced Miami's Chris Bosh (out due to injury). Millsap, playing in his third All-Star Game (each of the last three years), finished with three points, three rebounds and one assist in 19 minutes (1-2 3FGs). Horford, making his fourth career appearance and second straight in the midseason classic, ended the night with seven points, three rebounds and two assists in nine minutes (3-3 FGs, 1-1 3FGs).

\* Mike Budenholzer (currently 129 victories) passed Larry Drew for seventh on the Hawks' all-time wins list after defeating Chicago (2/10).

\* Kyle Korver (currently 1832) moved passed Chauncey Billups for eighth in NBA/ABA history in 3FGM at Chicago (2/10).

\* Al Horford (currently 3590) passed Dominique Wilkins for fourth on the Hawks' franchise list in defensive rebounds at Chicago on 2/10.

\* In the victory vs. Indiana (2/5), Kent Bazemore tied a career-high with eight assists, also finishing with 15 points (5-11 FGs, 2-5 3FGs, 3-4 FTs), three steals and one rebound. Bazemore then set a new career-high with 13 rebounds, including a career-best 12 defensive boards, vs. Orlando on 2/8.

\* Dennis Schröder tied a career-best with three 3FGM at Chicago (2/10), ending the night with 18 points, four assists, two rebounds and one steal (6-10 FGs, 3-5 3FGs, 3-4 FTs).

\* On 2/12, Atlanta recalled Edy Tavares from Austin of the NBA Development League. He has seen action in 12 D-League games this season (10 with Austin and two with Canton), averaging 9.8 points, 9.4 rebounds and 2.3 blocks in 21.1 minutes (.672 FG%, .761 FT%).

\* Former Hawks star Kevin Willis was part of the 2016 class inducted into the Atlanta Sports Hall of Fame on 2/12 at The Buckhead Theatre.

\* On 2/9, the Atlanta Hawks teamed up with Live Nation, the new operator of the Verizon Wireless Amphitheater, to help negotiate the venue's sponsorship opportunities. Under the terms of these new deals, Live Nation will be responsible for operating the Amphitheater, including booking, scheduling and marketing events, and investing in customary maintenance. Corporate partnership agreements for the venue will now be handled exclusively by the Hawks.
