Monday, Feb. 22, 2016 vs. Golden State Warriors (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts the Warriors the only time this season in the first-of-two contests between the clubs ... The teams will meet once more at Golden State on 3/1 ... The clubs split the 2014-15 series 1-1, with each team holding home court ... The Hawks defeated the Warriors 124-116 on 2/6/15 and Golden State responded with a 114-95 victory on 3/18/15 ... The last time the Warriors defeated the Hawks at Philips Arena was on 1/3/14 (101-100) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 142-140 and are 84-42 at home.



Friday, Feb. 26, 2016 vs. Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/ESPN ... Radio: 92.9 FM

The Hawks welcome Chicago for the final time this season in the third-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup once more in Chicago on 3/28 ... The Hawks lead the series 2-0, after posting a 120-105 home win on 1/9 and 113-90 road decision on 2/10 ... Al Horford is averaging 24.5 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 4.0 apg and 3.0 bpg against the Bulls this season ... Derrick Rose is averaging 15.5 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 4.0 apg and 1.5 spg against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has taken two straight home games against Chicago ... The Bulls' most recent victory against the Hawks was a 91-85 home triumph on 4/15/15, with the last win at Philips Arena coming on 4/2/14 (105-92) ... The Bulls lead the all-time series 123-106, with the Hawks holding a 63-49 advantage at home.



Sunday, Feb. 28, 2016 vs. Charlotte Hornets (3:30 p.m.)

TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM

Atlanta hosts Charlotte for the last time this season in the fourth-and-final contest between the clubs ... The Hawks lead the series 2-1 ... Atlanta won the first two games: a 97-94 home victory on 10/30 and 94-92 road triumph on 11/1, while the Hornets were victorious in the last meeting, 107-84, on 1/13 at the Time Warner Cable Arena ... Paul Millsap is averaging 18.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.7 blocks against the Hornets this season ... Kemba Walker is averaging 17.7 points, 5.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals against the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has won three consecutive games against the Hornets at Philips Arena, with Charlotte's last road victory coming on 4/14/14 (95-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 59-45 (35-18 home mark).

NEWS & NOTES

* In the double OT game vs. Milwaukee (2/20), Dennis Schröder came off the bench to record 25 points, 10 assists, eight rebounds, one steal and one block in 40 minutes (10-19 FGs, 3-8 3FGs, 2-2 FTs), setting or tying career-highs in points, rebounds, FGM, 3FGM and minutes. The last Hawk to have at least 25 points and 10 assists in a reserve role was Pete Maravich (42 points, 10 assists) on 11/28/73 vs. Buffalo.

* In the contest vs. Milwaukee (2/20) Jeff Teague (currently 588 steals) tied Jason Terry for seventh on the Hawks' all-time franchise list; Al Horford recorded his 1500th career assist (currently 1501); and Thabo Sefolosa grabbed his 2500th career rebound (currently 2501).

* Kyle Korver made his 700th three-pointer in Hawks uniform (currently 704) and Thabo Sefolosa grabbed his 2000th career defensive rebound (currently 2004) when Atlanta hosted Miami (2/19).

* On 2/18, the Hawks acquired Kirk Hinrich from Chicago as part of the a three team transaction with Shelvin Mack being traded to Utah and Justin Holiday and the Jazz's 2018 second round draft pick (Denver's selection) traded to Chicago. This season Hinrich has appeared in 35 games (seven starts) for the Bulls and is averaging 3.8 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 15.9 minutes (.398 FG%, .411 3FG%, .938 FT%). Hinrich previously played for Atlanta for parts of two seasons (2010-2012).

* Atlanta is tied for the single-game NBA high in FT% (minimum 10 FTM) this year after hitting 1.000 FT% (15-15) vs. Washington on 11/7 and again vs. Miami (13-13) on 2/19. The 1.000 FT% has been accomplished 17 times total in the league this season. The Hawks were also a perfect 6-6 from the charity stripe at Milwaukee on 1/15.

* The Hawks-Warriors game on 2/22 features the "FanDuel Fan Pack" promotion (buy four game tickets starting at \$99 and receive a \$10 concession or merchandise credit per ticket).
