### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Feb. 8, 2016 vs. Orlando Magic (8:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM/105.3 FM**

The Hawks host Orlando in the second of two consecutive contests against the Magic, and the fourth-and-final game between the teams ... Atlanta leads the series 2-1 ... The Hawks won the first two games: a 103-100 road victory on 12/20 and a 98-81 home win on 1/18, while the Magic won the last meeting, 96-94, on 2/7 at the Amway Center ... Jeff Teague is averaging 17.3 points, 2.7 assists, 2.3 rebounds and 1.0 steals against the Magic this season ... Nikola Vucevic is averaging 17.3 points, 10.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.3 steals against the Hawks this year ... The Hawks have recorded three consecutive victories at Philips Arena against Orlando, with the Magic's most recent win in Atlanta coming on 11/26/13 (109-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 54-49 (34-16 home mark).



**Wednesday, Feb. 10, 2016 at Chicago Bulls (8:00 p.m.)**

**TV: FOX Sports Southeast HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks visit Chicago for the first time this season in the second-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams will matchup again in Atlanta on 2/26, and once more in Chicago on 3/28 ... The Hawks lead the series 1-0, after defeating the Bulls 120-105 in Atlanta on 1/9 ... Al Horford recorded a double-double (33 points/10 rebounds), and finished the evening with six assists, four blocks and one steal for Atlanta ... Jimmy Butler posted 27 points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and one block for Chicago ... The Bulls won the last meeting in Chicago (91-85) on 4/15/15, while Atlanta's last road victory in the series came on 1/17/14 (107-99) ... The Bulls lead the all-time series 123-105 and are 71-40 at home.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Paul Millsap has been selected by the Eastern Conference coaches to the All-Star team, and will compete in the 2016 All-Star game on 2/14 at Air Canada Centre in Toronto. This is the third straight year in which Millsap has been named to the All-Star team. He joins Joe Johnson, Dominique Wilkins, Lenny Wilkens, Lou Hudson, Bob Pettit and Slater Martin as the only players in franchise history to earn all-star honors in three consecutive seasons.

\* Atlanta won 124-86 at Philadelphia (2/3), behind eight players scoring in double-figures (none over 13), including five Hawks off the bench, as the reserves combined for 80 points. According to the Elias Sports Bureau: The 124 points are the most in a game in NBA history by a team that did not have a player reach the 15-point mark; the 38-point margin of victory was the largest for the Hawks since a 141-97 win over Detroit (2/7/94) and the second-largest on the road in franchise history, behind the St. Louis Hawks' 129-87 triumph over the San Diego Rockets (11/30/67); five Hawks came off the bench to score 12 or more points, something that's been done once by any team over the last 25 years (the Spurs, in their next-to-last game of the 2009-10 season); the last time Atlanta had five players score in double-figures off the bench was on 12/4/87 vs. New Jersey, also the last time the bench combined for at least 80 points.

\* Mike Budenholzer (currently 128 victories) tied Larry Drew for eighth on the Hawks' all-time wins list after defeating Indiana on 2/5.

\* Jeff Teague (currently 582) passed Kevin Willis for eighth on the Hawks all-time steals list at Orlando (2/7).

\* In the victory against Dallas (2/1), Jeff Teague recorded 32 points (12-15 FGs, 5-6 3FGs, 3-3 FTs), eight assists, five rebounds and one steal in 28 minutes; setting a career-high in 3FGM and season-highs in points and FGM. Teague became the first Hawk since Ken Norman vs. Denver on 3/8/95 to score at least 30 points in 28-or-fewer minutes

\* In the win at Philadelphia (2/3), Tim Hardaway Jr. tied a career-high with seven rebounds and finished the night with 13 points (5-8 FGs, 1-3 3FGs, 2-2 FTs), four assists and one steal.

\* In the victory vs. Indiana (2/5), Kent Bazemore tied a career-high with eight assists, also finishing with 15 points (5-11 FGs, 2-5 3FGs, 3-4 FTs), three steals and one rebound.

\* During the game against the Pacers (2/5), former Hawk Kevin Willis was honored for his induction into the 2016 Class of the Atlanta Sports Hall of Fame. The induction ceremony will take place on 2/12 at The Buckhead Theatre (7:15 p.m.). Selected by the Hawks with the 11<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 1984 Draft, he is one-of-18 players in NBA history with more than 16,000 points and 11,000 rebounds. During his 21-year career (1984-1994, 2004-05 with Atlanta), Willis was an NBA All-Star, a member of the All-NBA Third Team in 1992, and won an NBA Championship in 2003 with San Antonio.
